**Day 1: Sun, Oct 30** – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

**Day 2: Mon, Oct 31** – IN TRANSIT.

**Day 3: Tue, Nov 01** – ATHENS, GREECE – EMBARK MARINA. Arrive Athens. Transfer to pier and embark Marina. Depart 7:00 pm. (D)

**Day 4: Wed, Nov 02** – EPHEBUS (KUŞADASI), TURKEY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Meander through the ruins of ancient Ephesus and marvel at the famed Library of Celsus, the huge amphitheater, the marble roads with their chariot marks, the amazing mosaic sidewalks and the superb, rarely opened Terrace Houses. Or journey to three monumental cities of antiquity – Priene, Miletus and Didyma – renowned for their majestic temples and impressive, beautifully preserved stadiums. (B, L, D)

**Day 5: Thur, Nov 03** – CHANIA (CRETE), GREECE. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 3:00 pm. Chania wears its past on its sleeve. Spend the day in museums, from those uncovering the ancient history buried beneath the rocky soil to those celebrating Greece’s magnificent maritime history and the region’s unique folklore. Visit the ruins of the city-state of Aptera, a powerhouse in Minoan and Hellenistic times and eventually a Roman stronghold. (B, L, D)

**Day 6: Fri, Nov 04** – CORFU, GREECE. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Immerse yourself in this island of glorious scenery and beaches, serene monasteries, beautiful palaces, traditional mountain towns and Corfu’s lovely old Venetian quarter. Or visit the ornate Achilleion Palace, built by Empress Sissi of Austria and filled with dramatic sculptures of the Greek hero Achilles. (B, L, D)

**Day 7: Sat, Nov 05** – DUBROVNIK, CROATIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Enjoy a walk through this famous walled medieval city and its exquisite Venetian monuments. See the Franciscan monastery and explore the Rector’s palace and the cathedral. Or explore the countryside with a visit to lovely Cavtat, an enchanting seaside resort that began life as a Greek and then Roman colony. Then visit a local family in a Konavle Valley village and enjoy their hospitality over a traditional welcome of brandy and figs with a serenade by local musicians. (B, L, D)

**Day 8: Sun, Nov 06** – SPLIT, CROATIA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Sometime around 300 A.D., Roman Emperor Diocletian built his retirement palace on one of the loveliest spots on the Adriatic Sea. Today his palace has become a UNESCO World Heritage Site in the heart of Split, the city that grew up around it. Split is now Croatia’s second largest city, and much of it sits on a beautiful peninsula on the island of Ciovo, a jewel on the Dalmatian Coast. Many intriguing relics from the Roman, Greek colonial and Medieval periods can be found in Split’s archaeological museum, which was founded in 1820, making it Croatia’s oldest museum. One of the top outdoor attractions is the green oasis of Marjan Forest Park with its Split Zoo. There are also plenty of fine beaches nearby.

**Day 9: Mon, Nov 07** – TRIESTE, ITALY. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Situated at the crossroads of Latin, Slavic and Germanic cultures, Trieste invites visitors to discover new palaces, piazzas and cathedrals around every corner. Along the canal, the gilded Serbian Orthodox Church

of San Spiridione is juxtaposed with the neoclassical Catholic Church of Sant’Antonio Nuovo. A walk along the harbor takes you to Trieste’s majestic main square, Piazza dell’Unità d’Italia, and on to the Museo Revoltella, the opulent palace of a wealthy baron. Not to be missed is the Castello di Miramare, Archduke Maximilian’s gleaming castle situated on a rocky promontory north of the city.

**Day 10: Tue, Nov 08** – CRUISING THE ADRIATIC SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 11: Wed, Nov 09** – CATANIA, ITALY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Destroyed by an earthquake in the 17<sup>th</sup> century, Catania has been beautifully restored and offers ancient churches, castles and amphitheatres, lush gardens and lovely palazzos to explore. Tour the 13<sup>th</sup> century Ursino Castle, which was situated along the coast until earthquakes and volcanic eruptions transformed the landscape. Drive inland through picturesque villages and explore Villa Romana del Casale, a 4<sup>th</sup> century villa and UNESCO World Heritage Site containing a complex collection of Roman mosaics considered one of the finest in the Roman world. (B, L, D)

**Day 12: Thur, Nov 10** – SALERNO, ITALY. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Experience the sublime atmosphere of the towns and villages that punctuate the Amalfi Coast, a UNESCO World Heritage site for its quintessentially Mediterranean scenery. Stroll along Salerno’s elegant lungomare, a shoreside promenade with far-reaching views of the sea and the mountains beyond. From Amalfi’s quaint Piazza Duomo, walk up ancient steps to the stunning Cathedral of Saint Andrew, while in kaleidoscopic Positano, take postcard-worthy photos of houses precariously perched on the shoreside cliffs. Behold the splendid Renaissance palazzi of Sorrento, float above the emerald green waters of a fabled sea cave and take in extraordinary panoramas of the ruggedly beautiful coastline from hilltop Ravello. (B, L, D)

**Day 13: Fri, Nov 11** – ROME, ITALY – DISEMBARK MARINA – HONOLULU. Disembark Marina. Return flight to Honolulu. Aloha and Welcome Home! (B)
