Day 1: HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: TORONTO, CANADA. Arrive Toronto. Welcome to Toronto! After entry formalities, transfer by coach to the hotel in Toronto. The day is at your leisure – start exploring the city on your own. Your hotel rooms will not be available until the afternoon. At 6:00 pm, **meet your Tour Director and traveling companions** for a **welcome drink**. WESTIN HARBOUR CASTLE TORONTO or Similar (2 Nights)

Day 3: TORONTO – EXCURSION TO NIAGARA FALLS – TORONTO. Scenic drive along the shores of Lake Ontario en route to **Niagara Falls**. Enjoy a Niagara Falls **sightseeing cruise** below the falls. Return to Toronto. This evening, enjoy dinner atop the **1,815-foot-tall CN Tower**. (B, D)

NOTE: Operation of the Niagara Falls sightseeing cruise is subject to favorable weather and/or river conditions. Favorable conditions usually exist from May to mid-October. When weather is unfavorable, a walking tour through the scenic tunnels will be substituted.

Day 4: TORONTO – VIA RAIL® THE CANADIAN – ONTARIO. After breakfast, take an **orientation drive** around Toronto before **embarking aboard VIA Rail's The Canadian** – premier transcontinental train service through Canada's heartland. Experience classic, comfortable train service with Sleeper Plus class rail cars, refurbished from 1950s art-deco cars. Enjoy freshly prepared meals, featuring Canadian cuisine and regional specialties, with live local entertainment. Domed observation cars provide unfettered views of the Canadian countryside as you roll past Ontario's landscapes. THE CANADIAN (3 Nights) (B, L, D)

NOTE: VIA Rail® double cabins offer armchairs, toilet, sink, and a picture window by day. By night, your furnishings transform into upper and lower beds. It is required to climb a ladder to reach the upper berth in a double cabin. Single cabins feature small couch-style seating, toilet, sink, and a large picture window by day. By night, a pull-down bed fills the space (obstructing the seating area and bathroom facilities). Public restrooms remain available in each coach. Train travel is subject to unforeseen delays. One carry-on overnight bag, not to exceed 21.5" x 15.5" x 9" and 25 lbs will be allowed onboard VIA Rail. Larger bags will be checked through and passengers will not have access to it while on the train.

Day 5: VIA RAIL® THE CANADIAN – ONTARIO – WINNIPEG, MANITOBA. **Watch the scenic countryside from your windows** as you relax in first-class rail accommodations. Travel past the sparkling lakes and sun-dappled forests of Ontario. Try the **observation dome** for unparalleled views or enjoy quiet conversation in one of the **comfortable lounges**. Enter Manitoba with its endless golden prairies and vast cultivated fields. In the late evening, arrive in Manitoba's capital city of Winnipeg for a brief stop. (B, L, D)

Day 6: VIA RAIL® THE CANADIAN – THROUGH MANITOBA AND SASKATCHEWAN. Continue through the prairies and winding rivers of Manitoba and Saskatchewan. View the ever-changing landscape with ease and comfort as you meet and mingle with fellow passengers or enjoy freshly prepared meals that showcase Canadian cuisine and regional specialties. (B, L, D)

Day 7: VIA RAIL® THE CANADIAN – THROUGH SASKATCHEWAN – ALBERTA – JASPER. Travel from Saskatchewan to Jasper along Alberta's famed **Yellowhead Route**, Canada's historic trail of westward expansion. Arrive in Jasper and **disembark The Canadian**. Receive an **orientation drive** of **Jasper National Park** before an evening of leisure. CHATEAU JASPER or Similar (2 Nights) (B)

Day 8: JASPER – EXCURSION TO MALIGNE LAKE. This morning is free at leisure. Later, enjoy an **excursion to Maligne Lake** for a narrated **cruise to Spirit Island**. (B)

Day 9: JASPER – COLUMBIA ICEFIELD – LAKE LOUISE – BANFF. This morning, enjoy the scenic drive on **Icefields Parkway** en route to the **Columbia Icefield**. Take the **Ice Explorer ride** on **Athabasca Glacier** with a Glaciologist guide followed by a **scenic drive over Sunwapta Pass**. Next, stop at **Lake Louise**, whose green-blue waters form a perfect mirror reflection of **Mount Victoria**, en route to **Banff National Park**. BANFF PARK LODGE or Similar (2 Nights) (B, D)

Day 10: BANFF. Today, the morning's sightseeing includes the **Bow River and Falls**. The rest of the day is at leisure. (B)

Day 11: BANFF – KAMLOOPS. Enjoy the scenic drive through Glacier, Yoho, and Mt. Revelstoke National Parks. This morning, travel through the spectacular beauty of **Yoho National Park**, one of Canada's most popular recreational areas and **site of pre-Cambrian fossil finds**. On to **Canada's Glacier National Park**, where the motorcoach climbs **4,379-foot-high Rogers Pass**, a perfect spot for photos of the surrounding

mountain cliffs and glaciers. After a drive through **Revelstoke National Park**, continue to your riverside resort. Tonight, enjoy a **riverside BBQ with s'mores**. SOUTH THOMPSON INN GUEST RANCH & CONFERENCE CENTRE or Similar (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 12: KAMLOOPS – VICTORIA. Catch a **BC Ferry to Vancouver Island** and the very British "Garden City" of Victoria. Upon arrival, get an **orientation tour of Victoria** includes the gardens of **Beacon Hill Park**, the **Fairmont Empress Hotel**, **Bastion Square**, and **Thunderbird Park**. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to explore Victoria on your own. DELTA VICTORIA OCEAN POINTE RESORT or Similar (2 Nights) (B)

Day 13: VICTORIA. This morning and afternoon is at **leisure for independent sightseeing and shopping**. For shoppers, Government Street's elegant shops and Market Square's collection of specialty stores are good places to start. History buffs should be sure to visit the Royal British Columbia Museum. Visit the world-famous **Butchart Gardens**, listed as a National Historic site, this botanical oasis made of millions of flowering beds and over 900 varieties of plants in exquisitely landscaped gardens brings fairytales to life. Enjoy the gardens and a **special farewell dinner** in the original, now restored, greenhouse. (B, D)

Day 14: VICTORIA – VANCOUVER. This morning, take the **BC Ferry** and sail through the **Gulf Islands**, an archipelago known for its **Mediterranean-type climate**. Arrive in **Vancouver** for a **guided sightseeing tour**. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. DELTA BY MARRIOTT VANCOUVER SUITES or Similar (1 Night) (B)

Day 15: VANCOUVER – HONOLULU. Depart Vancouver. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and Welcome Home! (B)
