Day 1: Tue, Apr 18 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Wed, Apr 19 – TOKYO, JAPAN. Arrive Tokyo. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to hotel in Tokyo. KEIO PLAZA HOTEL TOKYO (3 Nights)

Day 3: Thur, Apr 20 – TOKYO. Start the day with a visit to the visually stimulating **Harajuku Shopping District**. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **Sushi Making Session**, which will yield your delicious lunch. Next, visit **Ameyoko**, a busy market street along the Yamanote Line tracks between Okachimachi and Ueno Stations. The name "Ameyoko" is a short form for "Ameya Yokocho" (candy store alley), as candies were traditionally sold there. Alternatively, "Ame" also stands for "America," because a lot of American products used to be available there when the street was the site of a black market in the years following World War II. Today, various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, fresh fish, dried food, and spices are sold along Ameyoko. Then, you'll have the opportunity to experience a **traditional Japanese Tea Ceremony**. Later, take a tour of the **Edo-Tokyo Museum**, which vividly illustrates the past of Tokyo (known as Edo until 1869) through its exhibits. Visitors are able to experience and learn about various aspects of what life was like during the Edo period. Lastly, visit **Tokyo SkyTree** for a view of the surrounding city. At just over 2,000 feet tall, it is the tallest tower in Tokyo. Rising 350 meters above the ground, the Tokyo SkyTree Tembo Deck offers a 360° panoramic view of Tokyo. Return to the hotel in Tokyo for an evening of leisure. The local guide will have suggestions on various dining and shopping opportunities nearby. (B, L)

Day 4: Fri, Apr 21 – TOKYO. Day at Leisure. Enjoy shopping and dining in the bustling Shinjuku area. Your local guide will be available to assist as needed. Perfect day to relax and/or visit with family and friends in Tokyo. (B)

Day 5: Sat, Apr 22 – TOKYO – YOKOHAMA – EMBARK NAUTICA. After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, depart the hotel for Yokohama. We start our day visiting **Sankeien Garden** – a spacious Japanese-style garden in southern Yokohama which exhibits a number of historic buildings from across Japan. There is a pond, small rivers, flowers, and wonderful strolling trails that make you think you are in Kyoto rather than Yokohama. Next, explore the **Cup Noodle Museum** and learn about the history of this dorm room favorite of students worldwide. Have lunch in **Yokohama's Chinatown** before spending some time exploring "**Minato Mirai 21**," a seaside urban area in central Yokohama whose name means "harbor of the future." It has many large high rises, including Japan's tallest building, the Landmark Tower. Later, transfer to the pier for embarkation on the Oceania Nautica. Depart 7:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Sun, Apr 23 – SHIMIZU, JAPAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 2:00 pm. In the shadow of Mount Fuji, Shimizu is one of the most beautiful ports in Japan. Walk through the pine groves of Miho, home to a 650-year-old Japanese black pine, or enjoy spectacular views of Mount Fuji from the lush, forested hill of Nihondaira. Take in the seascapes on a bay cruise, or learn of undersea delights at Japan's first sushi museum. For a historic angle, get a glimpse at feudal life in Japan in 200 BC at the archaeological site of Toro. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Mon, Apr 24 – OSAKA, JAPAN. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 8:00 pm. Prior to the 8th century Nara period, the capital of Japan moved with each new emperor, and Osaka was one of those earliest capitals, then known as Naniwa. During the Edo period, Osaka grew into a commercial center of the rice trade and became known as "the nation's kitchen," a moniker now applied because of the city's reputation for cuisine so good that, as the saying goes, people go broke buying it. A vibrant arts culture also developed in the 17th century, including the famous kabuki and bunraku theaters that can still be seen today. Devastated during World War II, Osaka reemerged as a maze of bridges and skyscrapers flanking a moated castle that stands in the city center as a reminder of a regal past. The skyline gains further allure from the illumination of several Ferris wheels, unique status symbols of modern Japanese cities. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Tue, Apr 25 – HIROSHIMA, JAPAN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Visit the skeletal A-Bomb Dome, the Peace Memorial Park and Museum, and the statue dedicated to the children who died after the atomic bomb was dropped on this city in 1945. Stroll through beautifully landscaped Hiroshima Gardens, visit the rebuilt Hiroshima Castle or journey to the exquisite sacred island of Miyajima and see the extraordinary Itsukushima Shrine. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Wed, Apr 26 – CRUISING THE KANMON STRAITS. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Thur, Apr 27 – SHANGHAI, CHINA. Arrive 9:00 am. Overnight in Port. See the amazing contrasts of this burgeoning city, from the broad European-style Bund to the soaring ultra-modern buildings. Visit the magnificent art museum and the renowned 16th century Yu Yuan Gardens. Enjoy the city by night, see an acrobatic show, browse in local markets or take a trip to one of the famed garden cities of Suzhou or Wuxi. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Fri, Apr 28 – SHANGHAI, CHINA. Depart 5:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Sat, Apr 29 – CRUISING THE EAST CHINA SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Sun, Apr 30 – ISHIGAKI, JAPAN. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Discover this remote and picturesque island's lush mountains, beautiful beaches and magnificent coral reef from island viewpoints. See the native palm forest and the lavishly decorated Chinese tomb. Step back in time and travel to the tiny island of Taketomi-jima with its treasured red-tile-roofed town where rural island heritage, including ox carts, is vividly alive. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Mon, May 01 – TAIPEI (KEELUNG), TAIWAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. On this fascinating island visit the world's tallest building, the Chiang Kai Shek Memorial, the fabulous Palace Museum's vast collection of Chinese art and the lovely Lungshan Temple. Explore lovely Keelung's historic sites and Yeliu Park's astonishing rock formations. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Tue, May 02 – CRUISING THE SOUTH CHINA SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Wed, May 03 – HONG KONG, CHINA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 9:00 pm. Experience old and new Hong Kong with its ultra-modern high-rise buildings beside street markets and lovely temples. Visit the boat people in Aberdeen and shop in Stanley Market or stroll through the bustling Temple Street night market. Visit Hollywood Road with its temple and antique shops or take a junk cruise and explore the magnificent bay. Travel to the

New Territories to see family shrines, the wishing tree and the preserved wetlands. Or visit Lantau Island and the Po Lin Monastery with its giant Buddha statue. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Thur, May 04 – CRUISING THE SOUTH CHINA SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Fri, May 05 – HUẾ (CHÂN MÂY), VIETNAM. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 3:00 pm. Huế, the former imperial capital on the Perfume River, beckons with its lovely temples, pagodas and imposing citadel protected by a moat. Explore its many attractions, including tombs of Nguyen dynasty emperors, by boat. Visit the iconic Trang Tien Bridge, which connects the ancient citadel area with Huế across the river, and stroll among the town's colonial-style buildings and outdoor cafés. In nearby Da Nang, visit famed China Beach and the intriguing Cham Museum, filled with fascinating artifacts of the Cham culture. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Sat, May 06 – NHA TRANG, VIETNAM. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Discover this bustling resort town, renowned for its turquoise waters and yellow sand beaches. See its grand colonial buildings and stroll across a bridge to a fishing village alive with trawlers and junks. Visit the celebrated Cham Towers of Po Nagar, a spot revered by Buddhists. In the countryside, experience rural life in Vietnam today. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Sun, May 07 – SAIGON (HO CHI MINH CITY), VIETNAM. Arrive 1:00 pm. Overnight in Port. Discover the rich heritage of Saigon and the rural Mekong Delta. See the city's lovely pagodas, colonial architecture and broad boulevards. Ride a local pedicab through the bustling streets; visit the vibrant markets, Chinatown, and the fascinating Củ Chi tunnels. Explore the lush countryside of farms, rice paddies, and villages with a cruise on the Mekong. (B, L, D)

Day 21: Mon, May 08 – SAIGON (HO CHI MINH CITY), VIETNAM. Depart 3:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 22: Tue, May 09 – CRUISING THE SOUTH CHINA SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 23: Wed, May 10 – SINGAPORE, SINGAPORE – DISEMBARK NAUTICA. Arrive 7:00 am. Disembark Nautica. Upon disembarkation at the Singapore pier, join your local guide and visit **Little India, Sultan Mosque, Arab Street, Merlion Park, Old Parliament House** (outside), **statues of Sir Stamford Raffle**, and **Esplanade** (outside). After lunch, visit **Sentosa Island** and **S.E.A. Aquarium**. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel. PARK HOTEL ALEXANDRA or Similar (2 Nights) (B, L, D)

Day 24: Thur, May 11 – SINGAPORE. Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Start the day with a visit to the **Singapore Zoo**. After lunch, tour **Gardens by the Bay** (including entry into the cool house). For dinner, explore a local **Hawker's Market** and have a "**Crazy Rich Asians**" experience of your own. Return to the hotel for the evening. (B, L)

Day 25: Fri, May 12 – SINGAPORE – HONOLULU. After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the flight home. Depart Singapore. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and Welcome Home! (B)
