Day 1: Fri, Jan 26 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Sat, Jan 27 — IN TRANSIT.

**Day 3: Sun, Jan 28** — SINGAPORE, SINGAPORE — EMBARK RIVIERA. Arrive Singapore. Transfer to pier and embark Riviera. Depart 6:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Mon, Jan 29 - CRUISING THE SOUTH CHINA SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 5: Tue, Jan 30** — MUARA, BRUNEI. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 9:00 pm. Enjoy a drive through this fascinating city past the beautiful mosques with their glittering domes and minarets and the Sultan's palace, the largest in the world. Visit the Brunei Museum, a repository of Malay culture and priceless Islamic art. Or take a riverboat through the city's canals and experience its daily life. Travel into the primitive Borneo countryside to a Dayak village where warriors dance in the longhouse. (B, L, D)

**Day 6: Wed, Jan 31** — KOTA KINABALU (BORNEO), MALAYSIA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Enjoy the sights in this bustling, ethnically diverse city as you see the gold-domed mosque, unique high-rise architecture and the Heritage Village. Or venture into the interior and astonishing Kinabalu Park. Stroll past rare plants along a nature trail and through a garden of rare orchids. Or ride Borneo's last train into the lush countryside of farms, water buffalo, and villages. Spend time on the glorious beaches. (B, L, D)

**Day 7: Thur, Feb 01** — PUERTO PRINCESA, PHILIPPINES. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Founded as a Spanish naval hub in 1872, Puerto Princesa is developing a new identity as the ecotourism center of the Philippines. Marvel at the sights of the popular underground river, located in a nearby national park, or go zip-lining at Ugong Rock. In town, learn about the Palawan massacre of Allied soldiers during World War II, and then reflect at the Immaculate Conception Cathedral. (B, L, D)

**Day 8: Fri, Feb 02** — CORON, PHILIPPINES. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Situated in the northern region of the island province of Palawan — often billed as one of the best island destinations in the world — Coron is blessed with towering limestone karsts, gorgeous beaches, and incredible coral reefs. You can explore old-growth rainforests, snorkel in picturesque lagoons and even dive World War II wrecks. Kayangan Lake offers sweeping views of limestone towers draped in lush vegetation, and visitors are welcome to swim and snorkel in the crystal-clear waters. You'll quickly understand why this mountain lake is among the most photographed places in the Philippines. Just a short drive from the port, the mangrove-shrouded Maquinit Hot Springs is one of the few saltwater hot springs in the world and is the perfect location to take a restorative dip. (B, L, D)

**Day 9: Sat, Feb 03** — MANILA, PHILIPPINES. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Dynamic Manila never slows down, so go with the flow by delving headlong into the attractions, including the elegant Malacanang Palace, the National Museum of the Philippines, verdant Rizal Park, and the poignant American Cemetery and Memorial. The walled medieval district of Intramuros is also well worth exploring. (B, L, D)



Day 10: Sun, Feb 04 — CRUISING THE SOUTH CHINA SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 11: Mon, Feb 05** – HUÉ (CHAN MAY), VIETNAM. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Hue, the former imperial capital on the Perfume River, beckons with its lovely temples, pagodas and imposing citadel protected by a moat. Explore its many attractions, including tombs of Nguyen dynasty emperors, by boat. Visit the iconic Trang Tien Bridge, which connects the ancient citadel area with Hue across the river, and stroll among the town's colonial-style buildings and outdoor cafés. In nearby Da Nang, visit famed China Beach and the intriguing Cham Museum, filled with fascinating artifacts of the Cham culture. (B, L, D)

**Day 12: Tue, Feb 06** – NHA TRANG, VIETNAM. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Discover this bustling resort town, renowned for its turquoise waters and yellow sand beaches. See its grand colonial buildings and stroll across a bridge to a fishing village alive with trawlers and junks. Visit the celebrated Cham Towers of Po Nagar, a spot revered by Buddhists. In the countryside, experience rural life in Vietnam today. (B, L, D)

**Day 13: Wed, Feb 07** – SAIGON (HO CHI MINH CITY), VIETNAM. Arrive 11:00 am. Overnight in Port. Discover the rich heritage of Saigon and the rural Mekong Delta. See the city's lovely pagodas, colonial architecture and broad boulevards. Ride a local pedicab through the bustling streets; visit the vibrant markets, Chinatown, and the fascinating Ců Chi tunnels. Explore the lush countryside of farms, rice paddies, and villages with a cruise on the Mekong. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Thur, Feb 08 – SAIGON (HO CHI MINH CITY), VIETNAM. Depart 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Fri, Feb 09 — CRUISING THE GULF OF THAILAND. (B, L, D)

**Day 16: Sat, Feb 10** — SIHANOUKVILLE, CAMBODIA. Arrive 6:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Think beaches and snorkeling, as Sihanoukville sits on the beautiful island-studded Bay of Thailand. Wats, or Buddhist temples, are abundant and often modest architecturally, as seen at Wat Otres behind Otres Beach. There are even two wats in Ream National Park, a birdwatcher's paradise. (B, L, D)

**Day 17: Sun, Feb 11** – BANGKOK (LAEM CHABANG), THAILAND. Arrive 10:00 am. Overnight in Port. Awaken your senses as you tour the city's fabulous golden temples and palaces, the royal barges and the Emerald Buddha. Explore the hidden city of teak mansions and lovely gardens or learn about Thai culture. The Royal Palace, familiar to many as the scene of the true story of Anna and the King of Siam, is a massive complex of carved and gilded buildings still used by the Thai royal family. Visit the home of Jim Thompson, former spy and promoter of the local silk industry who disappeared mysteriously. (B, L, D)

**Day 18: Mon, Feb 12** — BANGKOK (LAEM CHABANG), THAILAND — DISEMBARK RIVIERA — IN TRANSIT. Disembark Riviera. Depart Thailand. Return flight to Honolulu. (B)

**Day 19: Tue, Feb 13** — HONOLULU. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and Welcome Home!
