

Day 1: Sat, Feb 03 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Hawaiian Airlines.

Day 2: Sun, Feb 04 – SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA. Arrive Sydney. Welcome to Sydney, Australia. Meet you Tour Director at the airport for a transfer to your hotel. A welcome dinner is included tonight at the hotel. SWISSOTEL or Similar (4 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Mon, Feb 05 — SYDNEY — EXCURSION TO BLUE MOUNTAINS. Experience spectacular scenery, wildlife, plant life and fresh mountain air. You will spend a full day exploring the **Blue Mountains** region on an all-inclusive tour. Enjoy a unique and relaxing environment — the best that nature has to offer. Travel to **Mrs. Macquarie's Chair** in the city's **BOTANIC GARDENS** for a great photo opportunity and sweeping views of the harbor, Opera House and Harbour Bridge. Step aboard your luxury catamaran for a sumptuous lunch and relaxing **CRUISE around Sydney Harbour**. Sit back and take in the harbour's iconic sights including the Opera House and Harbour Bridge from water level. Return to the hotel — where the remainder of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

Day 6: Thur, Feb 08 – SYDNEY – EMBARK REGATTA. Enjoy your morning at leisure prior to transferring to the Sydney pier for embarkation on the Oceania Regatta. Depart 5:00 pm. (B, D)

Day 8: Sat, Feb 10 — MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Overnight in Port. Head into the scenic Dandenong Mountains and ride the Puffing Billy steam train through the forest. Meet the koalas, wallabies and more at a wildlife park or explore local wineries. Take a walk and discover the city's marvelous architecture, chic galleries and boutiques. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Sun, Feb 11 — MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA. Depart 5:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Mon, Feb 12 — BURNIE (TASMANIA), AUSTRALIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Nestled in the northwest corner of Tasmania, this energetic and creative seaside town offers a unique perspective on the world of industry. Once dependent on paper manufacturing, the inventive community has transformed its industry into a compelling art culture. Visit Makers' Workshop, part museum and part arts center, for an introduction to the inspired spirit of Burnie, along with a tour of the process of papermaking and a glimpse of local artisans at work on their handicrafts. Discover Burnie's natural gems on the many trails at Fern Glade Reserve or the picturesque Emu Valley Rhododendron Garden. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Tue, Feb 13 - CRUISING THE TASMAN SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Wed, Feb 14 — CRUISING THE TASMAN SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Thur, Feb 15 — CRUISING THE FJORDS OF MILFORD SOUND, DOUBTFUL SOUND & DUSKY SOUND. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Fri, Feb 16 – DUNEDIN, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Discover the rugged, beautiful Otago Peninsula, filled with geological wonders, and gaze in awe at the great albatross with its 10-foot wingspan. Keep an eye out for fur seals and yellow-eyed penguins sunbathing on the rocks. Enjoy the amazing views and the enchanting gardens that surround the historic 19th century Larnach Castle. Splendid Victorian and Edwardian stone buildings are a highlight of a tour of Dunedin. (B. L. D.)

Day 15: Sat, Feb 17 — CHRISTCHURCH (LYTTELTON), NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Enjoy the scenic drive past quaint towns into Christchurch. Stroll through Cathedral Square and nearby gardens and savor the English atmosphere. Watch a sheep-shearing display or sample fine wines. Explore the Banks Peninsula and its dramatic landscape. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Sun, Feb 18 – PICTON, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Built around a sheltered harbor, Picton boasts a picturesque seafront lined with cafés, restaurants and galleries. Popular attractions include a floating maritime museum and an aquarium. Local operators offer cruising tours, fishing, dolphin watching and sea kayaking. A beautiful local attraction, the Queen Charlotte Track is navigable on foot or bike. From Picton guests can also explore the scenic Marlborough Sounds. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Mon, Feb 19 — WELLINGTON, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Stroll past Victorian Gothic buildings, visit the exquisite botanic gardens, take the cable car up the mountain for a fantastic view, or head for the city beach. Journey around the spectacular harbor with its amazing views and visit a sheep or cattle station. See some of the sites where the Lord of the Rings trilogy was filmed. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Tue, Feb 20 – GISBORNE, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Named in honor of the crew member on Captain James Cook's ship Endeavour who first sighted land in the area in 1769, this thriving seaside community is wedded to the sea and its vibrant Maori heritage and culture. Often called the "Chardonnay Capital of New Zealand," Gisborne has a splendid array of boutique wineries. For a taste of Gisborne's history and art, the Tairawhiti Museum is an essential destination in this city of warm smiles and even warmer hearts. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Wed, Feb 21 — ROTORUA (TAURANGA), NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Discover Tauranga's lovely parks and history or head to Rotorua with its fabulous geysers, hot springs and Maori culture. Explore the Rangitaiki River and its amazing scenery. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Thur, Feb 22 — WHANGAREI, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Tantalizingly close to New Zealand's northernmost point, an exquisite landscape revered by the Maori people, subtropical Whangarei beckons with its countless natural attractions, including breathtaking Whangarei Falls and the pristine beaches of Waipu Cove. A bit farther north, the magnificent Bay of Islands evokes a cluster of emeralds that has been cast into the shimmering sea. In the Abbey Caves, feel childlike wonder while exploring passages draped with otherworldly bioluminescent glow worms, and as a quirky diversion, examine over 1,600 historic timepieces at Claphams National Clock Museum. Gaze at the yachts docked next to the splendid Town Basin Marina Village, where you might pick up a memento of this enchanting port of call. (B, L, D)

Day 21: Fri, Feb 23 — BAY OF ISLANDS, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Relish the opportunities in this natural playground as you observe flying dolphins, gannets and blue penguins. The diving is renowned as some of the best in the world. Visit the historic Waitangi Treaty House, where the founding document of New Zealand was signed. (B, L, D)

Day 22: Sat, Feb 24 — AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND — DISEMBARK REGATTA — WAITOMO — ROTORUA. Arrive 7:00 am. Disembark Regatta. Your Tour Director will greet you upon disembarkation at the Port of Auckland to travel through the green pastoral region of Waikato to the famous WAITOMO GLOWWORM CAVES. Experience a guided tour through the limestone chambers and passages of the cavern. Take a silent boat trip through Glowworm Grotto as you glide quietly beneath the lights of thousands of glowworms suspended from the cave ceiling. This evening, enjoy a traditional HANGI DINNER, followed by an authentic MAORI CULTURAL PERFORMANCE. DISTINCTION ROTORUA HOTEL or Similar (2 Nights) (D)

Day 23: Sun, Feb 25 — ROTORUA. The morning starts with a visit to the **AGRODOME** to learn more about one of the country's major industries — sheep! Continue on to **RAINBOW SPRINGS** to view native bush and wildlife, including a walk through the kiwi bird enclosure. Enjoy a **LAKELAND QUEEN LUNCH CRUISE**. Last stop is **TE PUIA**, Rotorua's most prominent thermal area with New Zealand's largest geyser, boiling mud pools, and silica terraces. Dinner is at a local restaurant tonight. (B, L, D)

Day 24: Mon, Feb 26 — ROTORUA — MATAMATA — AUCKLAND. This morning you will visit the TE WAIROA BURIED VILLAGE. Then depart for HELL'S GATE for historic New Zealand experience of Sulphur Spas. You'll leave feeling refreshed and rejuvenated. Enjoy a traditional GEOTHERMAL HANGI LUNCH before departing Rotorua. Stop today at a picturesque farm near Matamata that was transformed into the HOBBITON MOVIE SET from *The Lord of the Rings* and *The Hobbit* films. During your visit, see the hobbit holes, the *Green Dragon Inn*, and other structures built for the movies. Continue to Auckland. Evening is at your leisure. SKYCITY AUCKLAND or Similar (1 Night) (B, L)

Day 25: Tue, Feb 27 — AUCKLAND — HONOLULU. Start your day with a sightseeing tour of Auckland, the "City of Sails." Sightseeing includes a visit to the SKY TOWER, the tallest man-made structure in New Zealand. Here you will ascend to the observation deck for sweeping views of the "City of Sails," situated on an isthmus between two magnificent harbors. Also visit the AUCKLAND WAR MEMORIAL MUSEUM and MAORI COURT. Enjoy time for lunch at leisure at Parnell Village and the gardens of the AUCKLAND DOMAIN. Then visit KELLY TARLTON'S SEA LIFE AQUARIUM. Your South Pacific adventure comes to and end with your group transfer to the Auckland airport for your departure flight. Depart via Hawaiian Airlines and arrive in Honolulu the same day.
