

DAY 1: MONDAY, JANUARY 15: HONOLULU - Departure Flights to South America

DAY 2: TUESDAY, JANUAR 16: IN TRANSIT

DAY 3: WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 17: ARRIVE IN LIMA, PERU: Meet your GLOBUS representative at your hotel.

DAY 10: WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 24: SACRED VALLEY–MACHU PICCHU: SACRED VALLEY Visit: Inca fortress of Ollantaytambo + a local Peruvian home; Scenic ride on the Vistadome Train thru the Urubamba Valley. MACHU PICCHU First Guided sightseeing at Machu Picchu. Dinner at your nearby hotel. (B,D)



DAY 11: THURSDAY, JANUARY 25: MACHU PICCHU–CUSCO: MACHU PICCHU Entry to Machu Picchu-Sunrise; PM train Sacred Valley. Transfer to Cusco. (B,L)

DAY 12: FRIDAY, JANUARY 26: CUSCO: visit Cathedral & Santo Domingo Monastery; Traditional Pasacalle (Andean Parade) + Kenko Amphitheater + the Temple of Sacsayhuaman. Free PM; farewell dinner. (B,D)

Walk thru a cactus forest in search of the endemic Santa Fe land iguana, the largest in the islands; This island is home to a number of endemic species, including the Galápagos hawk, Galápagos snake, a variety of finches & one of the four species of Galápagos mockingbirds. (B,L,D)

DAY 18: THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 01: CRUISING: BACHAS BEACH-BALTRA (DISEMBARKATION) – GUAYAQUIL: BACHAS BEACH: Your final visit takes you to Bachas Beach named for some wrecked World War II barges whose ribs are still visible in the sand. This site offers great swimming, a lovely walk along the shore, and a visit to a lagoon with wading birds, marine iguanas, and sometimes flamingos. The area is also a frequent nesting site for green turtles; BALTRA – FLIGHT to Guayaquil. GUAYAQUIL Free time this evening. (B)



DAY 19: FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 02: GUAYAQUIL - HONOLULU: Your South America Adventure ends this morning. Return Flights to Honolulu. (B)
