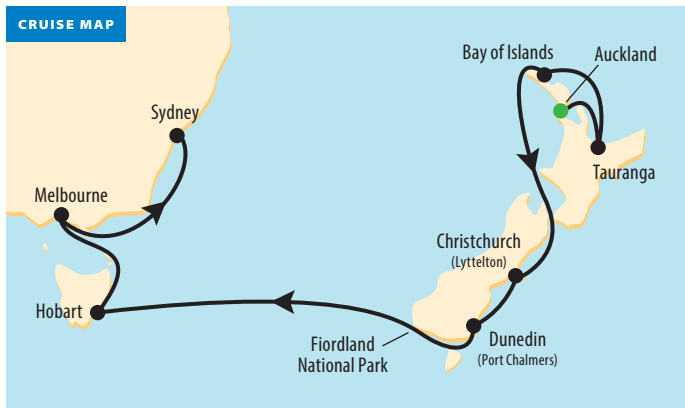

Day 1: Fri, Feb 21 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Hawaiian Airlines.

Day 2: Sat, Feb 22 – AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive in Auckland. Welcome to the land of the Long White Cloud, New Zealand. Meet your Tour Director at the airport for a transfer to your hotel. SKYCITY AUCKLAND or Similar (2 Nights)

Day 3: Sun, Feb 23 – AUCKLAND. Enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of Auckland. See bustling **Queen Street**, the city's oldest park, **Auckland Domain**, and historic **Parnell Village**. Pay your respects at the **Auckland War Memorial Museum** including the **Te Marae Maori Court**. After lunch, visit the **Kelly Tarlton's Sea Life Aquarium**. Set on the Auckland waterfront on Okahu Bay, Kelly Tarlton's Sea Life Aquarium is one of the city's top attractions. Explore 30 live animal exhibits in spectacular habitat displays, including the world's largest Antarctic penguin colony exhibit and amazing underwater viewing tunnels. Come within inches of huge sharks, rays, and penguins; step way back in time to the age of the dinosaurs at Jurassic Seas; and see a whole host of other incredible marine animals found in the oceans around New Zealand and beyond. Dinner this evening at **Orbit 360 at SkyCity**. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Mon, Feb 24 – AUCKLAND – WAITOMO – MATAMATA – ROTORUA. Depart Auckland and travel through the green pastoral region of Waikato to the famous **Waitomo Glowworm Caves**. Experience a guided tour through the limestone chambers and passages of the cavern. Take a silent boat trip through **Glowworm Grotto** as you glide quietly beneath the lights of thousands of glowworms suspended from the cave ceiling. Stop at a local restaurant for lunch. Continue to a picturesque farm near Matamata, which was transformed into the **Hobbiton Movie Set** of the *Lord of the Rings* films, for a guided tour. Continue to Rotorua for a two night stay. **DISTINCTION ROTORUA** or Similar (2 Nights) (B, L)

Day 5: Tue, Feb 25 – ROTORUA. This morning visit **Te Puia**, Rotorua's most prominent thermal area with New Zealand's largest geyser, boiling mud pools, and silica terraces. Lunch at a local restaurant. Next, visit **Agrodome** to experience New Zealand's sheep industry. There's time to watch a sheep shearing demonstration, visit the farmyard nursery, and see the remarkable farm dogs as they demonstrate their ability to respond to commands and keep the sheep in line. This evening, enjoy a **traditional Hangi concert and dinner**. Explore an ancient culture of the Maori. You'll learn the history of the area, hear storytelling, be captivated by songs and dance, and experience the famous haka (war dance). Afterward, sit down in the whareniui (ancestral meeting house) for an authentic Hangi Dinner (roasted meats and vegetables cooked underground with hot stones) and be entertained with music and dancing. Day 6: Wed, Feb 26 – ROTORUA – AUCKLAND. Visit the **Buried Village of Te Wairoa**. This award-winning heritage site shows life before the volcanic eruption. Continue to Auckland and enjoy **dinner whilst sailing on the harbour**. Enjoy a unique dining experience on Auckland's magnificent **Waitemata Harbour**. Set sail and take in Auckland's spectacular scenery as the sun lowers in the sky. Enjoy canapés and a welcome drink as you set sail onto the Waitemata Harbour. Your friendly and knowledgeable crew will talk you through Auckland's unique history as you sail past iconic landmarks. There is plenty of opportunity to capture the perfect picture or just sit back and enjoy the sights. Dinner is served above deck as you take in the sea air or optional dining below deck in the well-appointed cabin. Compliment your meal from a selection of local produced wine or beer from a fully licensed bar onboard. To finish the evening off, savor your dessert course as we leisurely sail back to Auckland's vibrant **Viaduct Harbour**. SKYCITY AUCKLAND or Similar (2 Nights) (B, D)

Guided tour of Sydney including the **Botanical Gardens** and a chance to see as well as learn the story behind **Mrs. Macquarie's Chair**. Lunch at a local pub or restaurant. Next, experience the inside the world's most recognizable sails, the **Sydney Opera House**. It is a miracle of architecture and engineering. A work of art that came into existence against impossible odds – to become one of the busiest performing arts centers in the world. Working with new, rich audio-visual components, where images are projected onto the fabric of the building – your knowledgeable guide will take you on an emotional journey, engrossing you in a story to rival any opera plot with its dramatic twists and turns. You will visit at least one of the venues – where there is a live performance every day. Some 1,500 performances, from opera to circus, rock, and cabaret, are staged each year to audiences of around 1.5 million. Audio headsets are included on this tour. Dinner in the Rock Area. AMORA JAMISON HOTEL or Similar (3 Nights) (B, L, D)

Day 22: Fri, Mar 14 – SYDNEY. EXCURSION TO THE BLUE MOUNTAINS. The **Blue Mountains** tour is a journey into the heart of a unique World Heritage Region. Your first stop of the day is at **Featherdale Park**, home to kangaroos, emus, wombats, and koalas. Enjoy time to wander at leisure. Enjoy lunch at the Boiler House Café with magnificent valley views at the historic Hydro Majestic Hotel. See the **Three Sisters Rock Formation**, remember your camera. The afternoon is spent visiting a selection of scenic lookouts. The view from **Govett's Leap** is one of the most famous lookouts in Australia. Here, the magnificent waterfall drops a whopping 180 meters (590 feet) to the base of the cliff. Experience the **Scenic Railway, Cableway, and Skyway**. (B, L)

Day 23: Sat, Mar 15 – SYDNEY. Day of leisure to explore. The vibrant Rocks Markets will be in full swing or perhaps spend time in China Town, the Hay Market, or a day trip outside of the city.
