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Day 1: Mon, Oct 06 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 12:15 pm.

Day 2: Tue, Oct 07 — TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 3:55 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Maihama. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner at the hotel. SHERATON GRANDE TOKYO BAY HOTEL (3 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Wed, Oct 08 — TOKYO DISNEYLAND. After a sumptuous Japanese/Western buffet breakfast, enjoy a full day at **Tokyo Disneyland!** Group Members will transfer to the resort together. Group Members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort Line. (B)

Day 4: Thur, Oct 09 — TOKYO DISNEYSEA. After breakfast, transfer to DisneySea. **Tokyo DisneySea** opened on September 4, 2001 as the only Disney Park themed to the sea. Group Members will transfer to the resort together. Group Members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort Line. (B)

*Baggage will be sent from the Sheraton Grande Tokyo Bay Hotel to the Sunshine City Prince Hotel, skipping Hakone. Prepare an overnight bag for one night.

Day 5: Fri, Oct 10 — TOKYO — HAKONE. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Hakone. Visit **Oshino** Hakkai, a set of eight ponds located in the Fuji Five Lake Region. The eight ponds are fed by melting snow from the nearby slopes of Mt. Fuji. The melted snow filtered down through porous layers of lava for 80 years, resulting in a very clear spring water that is revered by the locals. Next to one pond, visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source. Free time to enjoy lunch (on your own) here. Continue to Hakone where much of the area is considered an active volcanic zone since its creation from eruption of Mt. Hakone some 3,000 years ago. Transfer to the hotel for dinner. The **onsen hot springs** — which are divided for men and women — allow you to enjoy the hot springs whether indoors or outdoors. The high-quality service and facilities are sure to become some of your fondest memories of your visit to Japan. In addition, tour members are allowed to unlimited visits to nearby Hakone Kowakien Yunessun, an all-weather onsen amusement park, at no additional cost! Get your wristband, which will give you entry to Yunessun, at the hotel's front desk. Walk a short distance (three minutes) to Yunessun. The hotel wristband will allow you to enter without waiting in line, even when Yunessun is crowded! Get your one complimentary face and body towel and lounge wear (additional towels or lounge wear are at an additional cost). Enjoy food and beverages at Yunessun at your own expense. HAKONE HOTEL KOWAKIEN (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 6: Sat, Oct 11 – HAKONE – TOKYO. After breakfast, depart the hotel for a day of sightseeing and activities in Hakone. Begin the day with a visit to **Owakudani** ("Great Boiling Valley"), the source of the onsen waters of Hakone. View the surrounding countryside from the **Hakone Ropeway**. Next, enjoy a **boat ride on the beautiful Lake Ashi**. After lunch, try your hand at **Hakone yosegi-zaiku**, inlaid and mosaic woodwork unique to this area. A great souvenir of this trip! Depart Hakone for Tokyo. Upon arrival in Tokyo, explore the all-new **TeamLab Art Museum** - Azabudai Hills. "TeamLab Borderless is a world of artworks without boundaries, a museum without a map created by art collective TeamLab. Artworks move out of rooms, relate to other works, influence each other, and at times intermingle, without boundaries. Through this group of works, one continuous world without boundaries is created. Immerse your body in borderless art. Wander, explore with intention, discover, and create a world with others." Transfer to the hotel for an evening of leisure. The Sunshine City Prince Hotel is directly connected to Sunshine City and its host of shopping, dining, and entertainment offerings. It also has a FamilyMart (open 24 hours) conveniently located on the first floor, perfect for those late night egg-sando (egg sandwich), musubi, and fried chicken cravings. HAKONE KOWAKIEN YUNESSUN — AN ALL-WEATHER ONSEN AMUSEMENT PARK

Yunessun Area (Swimwear Area)

- Open until 6:00 pm on weekdays. Tattoos are allowed as long as they are covered by a rash guard, band-aid, or tattoo cover-up.
- Outdoor Onsen Hot Spring with a Scenic View Relax in 40 meter long onsens.
- Rodeo Mountain Water Slides Experience the thrill of river rapids on three different exciting slides.
- BOXAPPY's Jungle Gym Perfect for kids and families to play together outdoors.
- BOXAPPY's Splish Splash Pool Young kids love playing in this shallow pool with squirting fountains.
- Cave Baths, Dragon's Waterfall, The Flowing Pool, Aegean Sea of Gods, Wine Bath, Coffee Bath, Dr. Fish Foot Bath, Green Tea Bath, Japanese Sake Bath, Green Terrace, and Finnish Sauna.

Mori no Yu Area (No Clothing Area)

- Open until 8:00 pm on weekdays. Tattoos are not allowed.
- Open-Air Baths Indulge in the open-air atmosphere and mountain scenery. Both male and female areas include a jacuzzi, shallow bath for lying down, and roofed area. A waterfall shoulder massage can be found in the male area, while a collagen bath is found in the female area.
- Indoor Bath Relax in any weather as you view the surrounding mountains through the large windows.
- Cypress Bath Savor the refreshing fragrance of a tub and room lavishly crafted from aromatic cypress (female area only).
- Pottery Bath Warm your body in an outside onsen tub made of traditional Japanese Shigaraki stoneware pottery.
- Saunas Dry sauna invokes heavy sweating (male area only) and mist sauna that comfortably moisturizes skin and hair (female area only).
- Lie Down Bath Lie down in the shallow water for the ultimate in relaxation.

Day 7: Sun, Oct 12 – TOKYO. After breakfast start the day with a **Warner Bros Studio Tour Tokyo** of *The Making of Harry Potter*. Walk in the footsteps of Harry Potter and explore the wonders of the wizarding world. Explore the sets for Platform 9 ¾, Diagon Alley, The Great Hall, Ministry of Magic, and the Forbidden Forest. Learn about the creature effects, costumes, SFX and VFX, and props that brought these books to life. In the afternoon, take in the view of the surrounding city from the observation deck of the **Tokyo Skytree**. At just over 2,000 feet tall, it is the tallest tower in Tokyo. Rising 350 meters above the ground, the Tokyo Skytree Tembo Deck offers a 360° panoramic view of Tokyo. Next spend some free time at Tokyo **Solamachi**, a large shopping, dining, and entertainment complex at the base of the Tokyo Skytree. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 8: Mon, Oct 13 — TOKYO — HONOLULU. After breakfast, depart the hotel for the last day of touring. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, embark on another full day of discovery! First visit **Meiji Shrine**, the Shinto shrine dedicated to the deified spirits of the Emperor Meiji and his wife, Empress Shoken. Next, tour the visually stimulating **Harajuku Shopping District**. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **sushi making session**, which will yield your delicious lunch. Then visit **Ameyoko**, a busy market street along the Yamanote Line tracks between Okachimachi and Ueno Stations. The name "Ameyoko" is a short form for "ameya yokocho" ("candy store alley"), as candies were traditionally sold there. Alternatively, "ame" also stands for "America," because a lot of American products used to be available there when the street was the site of a black market in the years following WWII. Today, various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, fresh fish, dried food, and spices are sold along Ameyoko. Transfer to the Haneda International Airport for the return flight home. Depart Tokyo via Japan Airlines flt #74 at 9:05 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 9:35 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
