In Como, an included guided walking tour features the charming historic district, the Gothic Town Hall, the impressive Duomo, and a boat ride on the lake. In Lucerne, your guided walking tour includes the Lion Monument, the Chapel Bridge and a special highlight excursion to Swiss Alps.

Embark on your Rhine River cruise through France, Germany, and the Netherlands. Board your Avalon Suite Ship® in Basel, Switzerland, then head for Breisach, Germany, at the foot of the Kaiserstuhl Mountain on the French–German border. Here you'll find the gateway to Germany's Black Forest, an area of unrivaled natural beauty, best known for Black Forest ham, cherry cake, and the cuckoo clock. Last stop in Germany is Cologne — a 2,000-year-old city known for its Gothic-style architecture and famous twin-spired cathedral.

At the conclusion of your Rhine River cruise, you'll spend time in colorful Amsterdam. See the treasures of this 700-year-old city on an included canal cruise along the elegant grachten lined with homes dating back to the city's "Golden Age." Spend free time discovering world-famous museums, and an abundance of restaurants in the vibrant, modern capital of the Netherlands.

Day 1: Sun, Oct 05 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Mon, Oct 06 — IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Tue, Oct 07 – FLORENCE – MONTECATINI, ITALY. Welcome to Italy! After completing arrival formalities, meet your Globus Representative and transfer by coach to the hotel in Montecatini. The rest of the day is free for you to explore the city on your own. Tonight, meet your Tour Director and Travel Companions for a special Welcome Dinner. Day 4: Wed, Oct 08 — MONTECATINI. EXCURSION TO VINCI. This morning, head out into the lush, rolling landscape of the Montalbano Hills. Pass terraced grape vineyards, olive groves, and chestnut trees on your way to the quaint village of Vinci, **birthplace of Leonardo da Vinci**. Here, learn all about the Renaissance master at the **museum** dedicated to his life and many areas of interest from painting, sculpting, and inventing, to anatomy, music, and cartography! Round up the morning with the **visit of a local bakery**. Learn **how bread is made** and enjoy a light lunch with an opportunity to **sample local products** such as focaccia bread, sandwiches, wine, cheese, cold cuts, and olive oil. (B, L)

Day 5: Thur, Oct 09 — MONTECATINI. EXCURSION TO THE CHIANTI VALLEY. Cradled between the provinces of Florence and Siena, the Chianti Valley is the heart of Tuscany, and has been hailed for its exceptional wines since the 13th century. Your journey today takes you to Greve, with time to visit the village and to enjoy **lunch at a charming wine shop**. Complete the day with the visit of a **historic Tuscan estate** known for its **Chianti wine production**. (B, L)

Day 6: Fri, Oct 10 — MONTECATINI. Enjoy a leisurely morning in Montecatini. Maybe go for a walk in the Parco delle Terme with its tall shady trees. Most of the afternoon is dedicated to the **Italian cooking lesson at a rustic farmhouse** in the Tuscan countryside. Once you arrive at the farm, enjoy a Welcome Drink, explore the orchard to pick some fresh ingredients, learn about Italy's most famous delicacies, and then roll up your sleeves for a fun, hands-on cooking experience. This evening, relax with your Traveling Companions and taste the delectable dinner you prepared — maybe your team will win the Master Chef prize! (B, D)



Day 7: Sat, Oct 11 — MONTECATINI. EXCURSION TO LUCCA. Visit Lucca, a stunning showcase of medieval architecture and layer upon layer of rich history and culture. Marvel at the beautiful art and tapestry collections at the baroque **Palazzo Mansi National Museum**, then take a guided walking tour around the **Old Town** with its fine, intact Renaissance-era wall, cobblestone streets, and café-lined piazzas. A lively café-crawl snack brunch is included, followed by a main course at a local restaurant. Then, your Local Guide will introduce you to the stunning ornamental gardens and grand arched ceilings of **Palazzo Pfanner**. (B, L)

Day 8: Sun, Oct 12 — MONTECATINI. EXCURSION TO BOLGHERI. Travel through the vineyard-dotted countryside and along cypress tree-lined Viale dei Cipressi for your grand entrance into enchanting Bolgheri. With its red-brick castle and atmospheric Old Town, it's not hard to imagine that Bolgheri jumped right off the pages of a storybook. There's time here to **visit one of the wine cellars** and **taste Bolgheri's celebrated Super Tuscan reds**. First created in the 1980s, many wine experts believe these now rival French Bordeaux. Later, stop at nearby **Castagneto Carducci**, known for its splendid panoramic views of the Etruscan Coast. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and the chance to sample the **local liqueur**. (B, L)

Day 9: Mon, Oct 13 — MONTECATINI. This morning is yours to do as you please. You could choose to explore more of the city on your own, to relax and shop for souvenirs, or to join an exciting optional excursion. This afternoon is dedicated to a **baking class** at your hotel, focusing on the **creation of cakes and desserts**. (B, D)

Day 10: Tue, Oct 14 — MONTECATINI — LAKE COMO. Transfer from Montecatini to Lake Como. Exploring this delightful town on the Lake Como. This gorgeous city offers you plenty of opportunities to get the most out of your three nights stay. BARCHETTA EXCELSIOR or Similar (3 Nights) (B)

Day 11: Wed, Oct 15 – LAKE COMO.

CLASSIC EXCURSION: Join a guided walking tour which includes the charming historic center, the Broletto (Town Hall) with its fascinating gothic façade, and the imposing, marble-clad Duomo.

Day 13: Fri, Oct 17 — LAKE COMO — LUCERNE, SWITZERLAND. Travel to Lucerne.

CLASSIC EXCURSION: Enjoy a guided walking tour to explore beautiful Lucerne which includes Thorvaldsen's poignant Lion Monument and the famous Chapel Bridge.

Day 14: Sat, Oct 18 - LUCERNE - MOUNT PILATUS - BASEL - EMBARK AVALON PANORAMA.

CLASSIC EXCURSION: This morning enjoy a special highlight excursion to Mount Pilatus. Journey almost 7,000 feet (2,132 meters) up for spectacular views over central Switzerland (in case of bad weather, visit the Swiss Transport Museum instead).

Transfer to Basel to board the Avalon Panorama. The ship will cruise this evening to Breisach. (B, D)

Day 15: Sun, Oct 19 – BREISACH, GERMANY. EXCURSION TO BLACK FOREST. Visit the Adventure Center for today's activities with your Adventure Host.

Day 16: Mon, Oct 20 — STRASBOURG, FRANCE.

- CLASSIC EXCURSION: Join a city sightseeing tour, including Strasbourg's Gothic, stained-glass cathedral with its celebrated ancient murals and astronomical clock, as well as the magical La Petite France District.

Enjoy live entertainment onboard your ship this evening. The ship will dock overnight in Rüdesheim. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Wed, Oct 22 — RÜDESHEIM-RHINE GORGE — KOBLENZ.

- ACTIVE EXCURSION: Enjoy a hike with your Avalon Adventure Host through the picturesque vineyards of Rüdesheim, OR:
- DISCOVERY EXCURSION: Take a guided tour of the incredible Mechanical Music Museum for a one-of-a-kind instrumental experience; enjoy a tasting of the authentic Rüdesheimer coffee.

En route to Koblenz, sail through the **Rhine Gorge** (a UNESCO World Heritage site). Enjoy free time in Koblenz before a relaxing evening onboard with dinner and live entertainment. The ship will dock overnight in Koblenz. (B, L, D)
