

Day 1: Wed, May 21 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Thur, May 22 — IN TRANSIT.

**Day 3: Fri, May 23** — LONDON, ENGLAND — EMBARK VISTA. Arrive in London, England. Transfer to the pier in Southampton, and embark the Vista. Depart 6:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Sat, May 24 — CRUISING THE NORTH SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 5: Sun, May 25** — EDINBURGH (NEWHAVEN), SCOTLAND. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Savor the old town's marvelous Georgian and Victorian architecture and impressive Edinburgh Castle, high on its volcanic crag with a fabulous view. Stroll along the medieval Royal Mile to the Palace of Holyroodhouse to see the abbey and Queen Mary's chambers. Visit St. Giles' Cathedral where John Knox once preached. (B, L, D)

**Day 6: Mon, May 26** – KIRKWALL (ORKNEY ISLANDS), SCOTLAND. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. This starkly beautiful island holds many ancient treasures like the enigmatic Standing Stones of Stenness and the 5,000-year-old village of Skara Brae, amazingly discovered with furniture and indoor drains preserved. Visit the imposing trio of St. Magnus Cathedral, the nearby ruins of the Earl's Palace, and the earlier Bishop's Palace. (B, L, D)

**Day 7: Tue, May 27** — STORNOWAY (HEBRIDES), SCOTLAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. The unspoiled Outer Hebrides is a world of its own, separated from mainland Scotland by more than water. The language is Gaelic, the attitude heavily self-sufficient and the wildlife uncommon. The capital of the Outer Hebrides, Stornoway is tucked into a beautiful natural harbor on Lewis Island, which the Vikings repeatedly invaded. While renowned as a center for Harris Tweed, Stornoway is also home to the Neo-Gothic Lews Castle, the An Lanntair arts center and a multitude of northern birds such as the Arctic skua, golden eagle, and corncrake. (B, L, D)

**Day 8: Wed, May 28** — KILLYBEGS, IRELAND. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Donegal's scenic fishing village, Killybegs is situated in a region marked by natural beauty and rich in Celtic heritage. Discover thatched Irish cottages and picturesque Gaeltacht villages, not to mention super fresh seafood and beautiful stretches of coastline with Blue Flag beaches. Get a sense of the town's history and see the world's largest hand-knotted loom at the former factory of Donegal Carpets, now known as Killybegs International Carpet Making and Fishing Centre. Nature lovers will want to head to hiking trails of dramatic Slieve League Mountains just west of Killybegs — those up for the adventure will be rewarded with stunning views of Donegal Bay, local wildlife and some of the highest sea cliffs in Europe. (B, L, D)

**Day 9: Thur, May 29** — BELFAST, IRELAND. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 9:00 pm. Delight in this vibrant city of ornate Victorian and Edwardian architecture, gracious gardens and friendly pubs. Thrill to the natural phenomenon of the Giants' Causeway, a stunning geological anomaly of tightly packed, uneven basalt columns disappearing into the sea, and the enigmatic ruins of Grey Abbey. (B, L, D)

**Day 10: Fri, May 30** — DUBLIN (DÚN LAOGHAIRE), IRELAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Considering it's the birthplace of some of the world's greatest literary figures — Beckett, Joyce, Shaw, Wilde, Yeats — you can't help but wonder what it is about Dublin that so inspires. Exploring the city, you find answers. It's the strong sense of community embodied in its pub culture, in the stunning churches seemingly on every corner, and in the sprawling parks where residents gather to commune with nature. It's also the history preserved in the ancient books of Trinity College's Old Library and in the story of Guinness and his iconic beer. Meanwhile, the charming seaside town of Dún Laoghaire possesses its own sense of timeless appeal, from the James Joyce Tower and Museum to the National Maritime Museum of Ireland. (B, L, D)

**Day 11: Sat, May 31** — HOLYHEAD, WALES. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Enjoy the beautiful Welsh countryside with its charming towns and farms and visit the imposing Caernarfon Castle begun by Edward I in 1283. This mighty fortress was a residence and seat of government as well as a military stronghold. The current Prince of Wales received his title here in 1969. (B, L, D)

**Day 12: Sun, June 01** — CORK (COBH), IRELAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Cheerful Cork sprawls about the River Lee in one of Ireland's most stunning settings. Bridges crisscross the city leading to landmarks like St. Anne's Church and the Old City Gaol, where you'll see the 19<sup>th</sup> century prisoners' graffiti. Make time to kiss the Blarney Stone in Blarney Castle. (B, L, D)

**Day 13: Mon, June 02** – ST. PETER PORT (GUERNSEY), CHANNEL ISLANDS. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Enjoy this charming port, its beautiful harbor, architecture and imposing castle. See the rugged countryside and take a walk along the extraordinary cliffs and down to the sea, where Renoir once admired the view. Or savor the landscape in a drive around the island past grazing Guernsey cows in rich pastures. Then visit artisans working with silver and gold. Learn about the German occupation during WWII, or tour Victor Hugo's house and absorb the spectacular view. Stroll through the lovely Candie Gardens on this island known for its flowers. (B, L, D)

**Day 14: Tue, June 03** — LONDON (SOUTHAMPTON), ENGLAND — DISEMBARK VISTA — HONOLULU. Arrive 7:00 am. Disembark Vista. Depart London. Return to Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
