

HOTEL INTERGATE HIROSHIMA – 3-STAR (5 NIGHTS): Ideally located near a train station and just three minute walk from a tram stop, the hotel is also situated a short distance from the Hiroshima National Peace Memorial Hall and Children's Peace Museum.





Day 1: Wed, Dec 10 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines.

Day 2: Thur, Dec 11 – TOKYO – HIROSHIMA. Arrive in the Tokyo International Airport. After entry formalities, enjoy a bento box at the domestic departure gate. Depart the Tokyo Domestic Airport and arrive in Hiroshima. Transfer by coach to your hotel in Hiroshima. HOTEL INTERGATE HIROSHIMA (5 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Fri, Dec 12 – HIROSHIMA – MIYAJIMA – HIROSHIMA. After breakfast, take a short ferry ride and arrive on the island of Miyajima, considered sacred by many. Visit the Itsukushima Shrine. At high tide, the vermilion torii gate of Itsukushima Shrine looks like it's floating in the middle of the sea. The shrine complex has been selected as one of Japan's three most scenic places (nihon sankei). Enjoy excellent shopping and numerous choices for lunch (on your own) down Omotesando Street, the main street of Miyajima Island. After lunch, learn how to make Momiji Manju, a specialty of the area. Return to Hiroshima via a short ferry ride. Transfer back to the hotel via Heiwa Odori (the main street of Hiroshima, known as "Peace Boulevard") for an Illumination show.⁹ Lights are turned on every night along the boulevard from 5:30 pm to 10:30 pm. Thousands of people wander along the main road, walking through lit-up tunnels and under colorful lights. (B)

Day 4: Sat, Dec 13 – HIROSHIMA. A free day at leisure. Explore Hiroshima on your own. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. Perfect day to relax and/or visit with family and friends in Hiroshima. Or perhaps do more shopping! (B)

Day 5: Sun, Dec 14 – HIROSHIMA – IWAKUNI – SUO OSHIMA – HIROSHIMA. After breakfast, depart Hiroshima for Iwakuni. **Kintaikyo Bridge** is a wooden bridge consisting of five arches built on stone pillars, crosses Nishiki River. Plans for the Kintaikyo

Bridge were first drawn up by Kikkawa Hiroyoshi, the third feudal lord of Iwakuni, when strong current had destroyed the bridge that originally crossed Nishiki River. The bridge stood from its completion in 1673 until 1950 when Iwakuni was struck by a typhoon. Determined residents completed reconstructing the bridge in 1953. Explore the nearby **Iwakuni Castle**. The original castle was built in 1608, at the beginning of the Edo Period. The original castle was reconstructed in 1962 and has stood since. After lunch, visit the **Museum of Japanese Emigration to Hawaii**. Explore and learn something new. Return to Hiroshima for an evening of leisure. (B, L)

Day 6: Mon, Dec 15 – HIROSHIMA. Another free day at leisure. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 7: Tue, Dec 16 – HIROSHIMA – TOKYO – HONOLULU. Spend the morning at leisure before transferring to the Hiroshima Airport for the flight home. Depart Hiroshima and arrive at Tokyo Domestic Airport. Depart Tokyo International Airport and arrive in Honolulu the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
