**Day 1: Sun, Sept 28** – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

**Day 2: Mon, Sept 29** – IN TRANSIT.

**Day 3: Tue, Sept 30** – ARRIVE IN MADRID, SPAIN. After completing arrival formalities, transfer by coach to the hotel in Madrid. The day is at your leisure – **start exploring the city on your own**. Your hotel rooms may not be available until the afternoon. At 6:00 pm, **meet your Tour Director and traveling companions** for a **Welcome Dinner** at your hotel. GRAN HOTEL CONDE DUQUE or similar (2 Nights) (D)

**Day 4: Wed, Oct 01** – MADRID. The capital of Spain since 1561, Madrid today is a strikingly modern city, the showcase of a country resolutely turned towards the future. Today's highlight will be a visit to the palatial **Prado Museum**, founded in 1819, and considered to have one of the finest collections of European art of the last eight centuries, with the works of Goya, El Greco, Rubens, Titian, and more. Your Local Guide will also take you to the **Cibeles Fountain** and elegant **Calle Alcalá**. (B)

**Day 5: Thur, Oct 02** – MADRID – SEGOVIA – ÁVILA – SALAMANCA. Cross the rugged **Sierra de Guadarrama mountain range** on the way to Segovia, famous for the **2,000-year-old Roman Aqueduct**. Enjoy a walk through the **walled town of Ávila**, where **St. Theresa founded the Order of Carmelites**. Arrive in Salamanca, and follow your Tour Director for an orientation walk to beautiful **Plaza Mayor**. Enjoy a **wine tasting with dinner** at Hacienda Zorita, which once hosted Christopher Columbus. HACIENDA ZORITA WINE AND SPA or similar (1 Night) (B, D)

**Day 6: Fri, Oct 03** – SALAMANCA – FÁTIMA, PORTUGAL – LISBON. The majestic scenery of the **Serra da Estrela mountain range** forms the backdrop of your morning drive into Portugal. Before heading for Lisbon, melt into the stream of pilgrims from all over the world as you visit the **Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary** in Fátima. You will have free time to explore and have lunch (on your own) before departing for Lisbon. MERCURE LISBOA or similar (2 Nights) (B)

**Day 7: Sat, Oct 04** – LISBON. Lisbon was the center of Europe's longest-lived overseas empire. Morning sightseeing with a Local Guide includes a visit to **Jeronimos Monastery and cloister**, a stop for pictures at **Belem Tower**, guarding the mouth of the Tagus, and the **Monument to the Discoveries**. Free time this afternoon and evening. (B)

**Day 8: Sun, Oct 05** – LISBON – AZARUJA – SEVILLE, SPAIN. On the way back to Spain, stop in Azaruja to visit a **cork factory** and learn about the many ways this material can be used. Enjoy the scenic drive into the Andalusia Region to Seville. MELIA SEVILLA or similar (2 Nights) (B, D)

**Day 9: Mon, Oct 06** – SEVILLE. During your **sightseeing tour** with a Local Guide, explore the **Plaza de España**, the 170 meter diameter plaza that "hugs" Seville's visitors. Also visit the magnificent **Casa de Pilatos**, a mixture of Moorish and Roman architecture with a splendid collection of Roman sculptures. Then, stroll through the narrow lanes of the charming **Santa Cruz Quarter**. (B)

**Day 10: Tue, Oct 07** – SEVILLE – TANGIER, MOROCCO. **Ferry crossing** to Morocco. Continue to Tangier, jumping-off point for the Moorish conquest of Spain and home town of legendary medieval traveler Ibn Batuta. Sightseeing with a Local Guide includes a spectacular panoramic drive to **Cap Spartel**. Marvel at the views and quench your thirst with a glass of **hot mint tea**



**with biscuits**. Join your travel companions for a **dinner with Moroccan entertainment** at your hotel. HILTON GARDEN INN CITY CENTER or similar (1 Night) (B, D)

**Day 11: Wed, Oct 08** – TANGIER – COSTA DEL SOL, SPAIN. An **orientation walking tour** this morning introduces you to Tangier's exciting and colorful **Grand Socco Square** with free time to explore the narrow streets of the kasbah before boarding a **ferry back to Spain**. MELIA COSTA DEL SOL or similar (2 Nights) (B)

**Day 12: Thur, Oct 09** – COSTA DEL SOL. Today is a day of leisure. Your chance to enjoy the sandy beaches, browse through the trendy boutiques, or just relax. (B)

**Day 13: Fri, Oct 10** – COSTA DEL SOL – GRANADA. Into the mountains to history-steeped Granada. A **guided walking tour** features its main attraction, the **Alhambra Complex**, an ancient palace, fortress and citadel, named for the reddish walls and towers that surround the citadel (entrance to Nasrid Palace is not guaranteed). Also admire the magnificent **Water Gardens of the Generalife**, the royal summer residence. After lunch at a local restaurant, enjoy an afternoon and evening of leisure. HOTEL SARAY or similar (1 Night) (B, L)

**Day 14: Sat, Oct 11** – GRANADA – TOLEDO – MADRID. Join a **walking tour** of Toledo with a Local Guide. Visit a **Damascene steel workshop** before returning to Madrid. Tonight, enjoy a **Farewell Dinner** at your hotel. GRAN HOTEL CONDE DUQUE or similar (1 Night) (B, D)

**Day 15: Sun, Oct 12** – MADRID – HONOLULU. Depart Madrid. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home!
