Day 1: Tue, Nov 04 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Wed, Nov 05 - IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Thur, Nov 06 — BANGKOK (LAEM CHABANG), THAILAND — EMBARK RIVIERA. Arrive Bangkok. Transfer to pier and embark Riviera. Overnight in Port. Awaken your senses as you tour the city's fabulous golden temples and palaces, the royal barges and the Emerald Buddha. Explore the hidden city of teak mansions and lovely gardens or learn about Thai culture. The Royal Palace, familiar to many as the scene of the true story of Anna and the King of Siam, is a massive complex of carved and gilded buildings still used by the Thai Royal Family. Visit the home of Jim Thompson, former spy and promoter of the local silk industry who disappeared mysteriously. (D)

Day 4: Fri, Nov 07 — BANGKOK (LAEM CHABANG), THAILAND. Depart 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Sat, Nov 08 – KO SAMUI, THAILAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 2:00 pm. Explore this idyllic, forested island and its pristine beaches. Visit the giant Buddha at Wat Phra Yai, the elephant camp where these intelligent animals display their work skills and a plantation where monkeys harvest coconuts. Head to the interior and see majestic cascading waterfalls and how rubber trees are tapped. Enjoy the gorgeous beaches. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Sun, Nov 09 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Mon, Nov 10 – MELAKA, MALAYSIA. Arrive 12:00 pm. Depart 8:00 pm. One of the world's veritable melting pots, the UNESCO World Heritage city of Melaka wears its diverse heritage proudly, with buildings ranging in style from colorful Dutch colonial and ornate Chinese to ultramodern Islamic. Take in the captivating sights from a touring vessel as you glide along the meandering Melaka River, or gain a bird's-eye view of the skyline from the Taming Sari Tower's revolving observation deck. The recreated village of Mini Malaysia immerses you in the country's domestic sphere, with Malaysia's 13 regions represented in faithfully rendered homes, while a replica of the 16th century Portuguese galleon Flor de la Mar whispers tales of bygone seafaring odysseys. Day 8: Tue, Nov 11 — KUALA LUMPUR (PORT KLANG), MALAYSIA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 8:00 pm. Spend the day discovering this cosmopolitan city and its diversity of cultures, from the soaring Petronas Towers and the royal palace to Gothic churches, colonial remnants and a restored Malay timber house in a lovely heritage center. Experience everyday life as you browse the bustling markets and shops. Shopping: Shop for crafts, fine pewter, jewelry, and batik. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Wed, Nov 12 — PENANG, MALAYSIA. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 8:00 pm. Visit a batik factory, a butterfly farm, a mosque, church and Indian temple, or just laze around on the beach.

Day 10: Thur, Nov 13 – LANGKAWI, MALAYSIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Langkawi is the main island in the archipelago of the same name in the Andaman Sea. Stunning natural beauty and unique wildlife will surround you as you snorkel, horseback ride, hike, golf, or simply relax on the powdery sands of the island beaches. Experience Langkawi's wildlife up close on a boat tour of the amazing mangrove forest. Travel by cable car over ancient rainforests to the top of Mt. Machincang. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Fri, Nov 14 — PHUKET, THAILAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Overnight in Port. Experience the many aspects of beautiful Phuket, from its lush landscape and gorgeous beaches to its 19^{th} century Chinese and Western architecture and stunning temples. Visit the fascinating Sea Shell Museum, see the ornate Wat Chalong, watch elephants go through their paces at the elephant camp, and explore the unique and breathtaking Phang Nga National Park. Or just play on one of the island's fabulous beaches. (B, L, D)
