Day 1: Fri, Nov 21 - HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines.

Day 2: Sat, Nov 22 — TOKYO. Arrive in Tokyo. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to the hotel in Tokyo. A Welcome Buffet Dinner has been arranged at the hotel. GRAND NIKKO TOKYO DAIBA (3 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Sun, Nov 23 — TOKYO. After breakfast, begin our first full day in Japan, start with Senkyaku Banrai. A shopping complex that recreates an Edo period neighborhood, Senkyaku Banrai offers fresh food from the neighboring Toyosu Market and serves to showcase the best foods in Tokyo. Enjoy time for shopping and lunch (on your own), exploring the offerings at the numerous stalls. If you get tired, head up to the 8th floor and relax at the foot bath garden — which is free of charge to all visitors. After lunch, visit to **Asakusa**, the center of Tokyo's shitamachi (literally "low city"), one of Tokyo's districts, where an atmosphere of the Tokyo of past decades survives. Asakusa's main attraction is **Sensoji**, a very popular Buddhist temple built in the 7th century. The temple is approached via the **Nakamise**, a shopping street that has been providing temple visitors with a variety of traditional local snacks and tourist souvenirs for centuries. Then take in the view of the surrounding city from Tokyo Skytree. At just over 2,000 feet tall, it is the tallest tower in Tokyo. Rising 350 meters above the ground, the Tokyo Skytree Tembo Deck offers a 360° panoramic view of Tokyo. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 4: Mon, Nov 24 - TOKYO - KAMAKURA - TOKYO. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Kamakura. Our first stop today is the Kamakura Daibutsu (The Great Buddha of Kamakura), a bronze statue of Amida Buddha, which stands on the grounds of Kotokuin Temple. A bronze statue of Amida Buddha, the statue reaches a height of 11.4 meters and has long been the second tallest bronze Buddha statue in Japan, surpassed only by the statue in Nara's Todaiii Temple and some recent creations. Next visit **Tsurugaoka Hachimangu Shrine**, which is dedicated to Hachiman, the patron god of the Minamoto Family and of the samurai in general. Enjoy some free time for fun, shopping, and eating (on your own) at Komachi Dori **Shopping Street**, a 360 meter long shopping street full of restaurants and stores before returning to Tokyo for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 5: Tue, Nov 25 – TOKYO – YOKOHAMA – EMBARK DIAMOND PRINCESS. After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, depart the hotel for Yokohama. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **sushi making session**, which will yield your delicious lunch. Enjoy some free time for shopping at **Minato Mirai 21**, before transferring to the pier for embarkation on the Diamond Princess. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Thur, Nov 27 — OSAKA (FOR KYOTO), JAPAN. 8:00 am — 7:00 pm. (B, L, D)



Upon disembarkation at the Singapore Pier, join your Local Guide and visit Little India, Sultan Mosque, Arab Street, Merlion Park, Old Parliament House (outside), statues of Sir Stamford Raffles, and Esplanade (outside). After lunch, visit Sentosa Island and S.E.A. Aquarium. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel. PARK HOTEL ALEXANDRA or Similar (3 Nights) (B, L, D)

Day 18: Mon, Dec 08 — SINGAPORE. Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Start the day with a visit to the **Singapore Zoo**. After lunch, tour **Gardens by the Bay** (including entry into the Cool House). For dinner, explore a **local Hawker's Market** and have a "Crazy Rich Asians" experience of your own. Return to the hotel for the evening. (B, L)

Day 19: Tue, Dec 09 — SINGAPORE. Full day at leisure. Perfect day to visit friends and family, explore more of Singapore on your own, or shop 'till you drop! The Local Guide will be available to assist with your plans for the day. (B)

Day 20: Wed, Dec 10 – SINGAPORE – HONOLULU. After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the flight home. Depart Singapore. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
