

KEIO PLAZA HOTEL TOKYO – **4-star** (5 Nights) "Luxury in the heart of Tokyo." The hotel is at the perfect location to explore the delights of the city of Tokyo. Just outside Tochomae Station or only a five minute walk from Shinjuku Station, with some of the most popular shopping and entertainment spots.



Day 1: Mon, Dec 08 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines.

Day 2: Tue, Dec 09 – TOKYO. Arrive in Tokyo. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Tokyo. Enjoy a dinner buffet on arrival. KEIO PLAZA HOTEL TOKYO (5 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Wed, Dec 10 – TOKYO. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, embark on a full day of discovery! Begin the day exploring **Asakusa**, the center of Tokyo's shitamachi (literally "low city") districts, where an atmosphere of the Tokyo of past decades survives. Asakusa's main attraction is **Sensoji**, a very popular Buddhist temple built in the 7th century. The temple is approached via the **Nakamise**, a shopping street that has been providing temple visitors with a variety of traditional local snacks and tourist souvenirs for centuries. Next, take in the view of the surrounding city from the observation deck of the **Tokyo Skytree**. At just over 2,000 feet tall, it is the tallest tower in Tokyo. Rising 350 meters above the ground, the Tokyo Skytree Tembo Deck offers a 360 degree panoramic view of Tokyo. Enjoy lunch (on your own) at **Tokyo Solamachi** – located at the base of the Tokyo Skytree – where a variety of restaurant and food choices are available. After lunch, take on a fun-filled, hands-on activity, as you learn how to **make your own furin** (Japanese wind chime). Start by blowing glass into a round and finish by hand painting your personal treasure. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 4: Thur, Dec 11 – TOKYO. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, embark on another full day of discovery! First visit **Meiji Shrine**, the Shinto shrine dedicated to the deified spirits of the Emperor Meiji and his wife, Empress Shoken. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **sushi making session**, which will yield your delicious lunch. After lunch, stop at **LaLaport Toyosu**, a mall located on Tokyo Bay that has 180 shops, including UNIQLO, 100 yen shop, THE DAISO, and more. You'll have ample time to explore all that this mall has to offer. Visit **Oi Racecourse** for the **Tokyo Mega Illumination**.⁶ It's the biggest illumination event in Tokyo and themed around "the past, present, and future." Get your photo taken with an adorable miniature pony, travel back in time and enjoy light displays modeled on the Edo, Meiji, Taisho, and Showa periods in Japanese history, enjoy a delicious matcha green tea flavored tiramisu, and watch an amazing projection mapping display. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B, L)

Day 5: Fri, Dec 12 – TOKYO. Day at leisure. Enjoy shopping and dining in the bustling Shinjuku Area. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 6: Sat, Dec 13 – TOKYO. Day at leisure. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. Perfect day to relax and/or visit with family and friends in Tokyo. (B)

Day 7: Sun, Dec 14 – TOKYO – HONOLULU. Start the day at **Toyosu Senkyaku Banrai**, a shopping complex that recreates an Edo period neighborhood. Toyosu Senkyaku Banrai offers fresh food from the neighboring Toyosu Market and serves to showcase the best foods in Tokyo. Enjoy time for shopping and lunch (on your own), exploring the offerings at the numerous stalls. If you get tired, head up to the 8th floor and relax at the foot bath garden – which is free of charge to all visitors. Then visit **Ameyoko**, a busy market street along the Yamanote Line tracks between Okachimachi and Ueno Stations. The name "Ameyoko" is a short form for "ameya yokocho" ("candy store alley"), as candies were traditionally sold there. Alternatively, "ame" also stands for "America," because a lot of American products used to be available there when the street was the site of a black market in the years following WWII. Today, various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, fresh fish, dried food, and spices are sold along Ameyoko. Transfer to the airport for the return flight home. Depart Tokyo and arrive in Honolulu the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
