Day 1: Wed, July 01 – HONOLULU – SEATTLE, WASHINGTON. Depart Honolulu and arrive in Seattle. Transfer to the hotel for the evening. SEATTLE AIRPORT HOTEL (1 Night)

Day 2: Thur, July 02 – SEATTLE – EMBARK RIVIERA. Transfer to pier and embark Riviera. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 3: Fri, July 03 - AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Sat, July 04 – KETCHIKAN, ALASKA. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Totem poles are one of Ketchikan's chief attractions, and the best places to view them are Saxman Village and Totem Bight State Park. Drop by the Southeast Alaska Discovery Center to learn about the local cultures and ecosystems. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Sun, July 05 – JUNEAU, ALASKA. Arrive 12:00 pm. Depart 9:00 pm. For a state capital, Juneau maintains a surprising small-town charm, in part because it can only be reached by sea or air due to the surrounding wilderness. Collections from the indigenous people are displayed in the Alaska State Museum. Visit Mendenhall Glacier for an outdoor adventure. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Mon, July 06 – SKAGWAY, ALASKA. Arrive 6:00 am. Depart 8:30 pm. Skagway's spectacular natural setting encourages a walking tour of this well-preserved gold rush town. See the Moore House, built in 1897, a year before the gold rush, and the Gold Rush Cemetery, where famed Old West desperado Soapy Smith is buried. Visit the Trail of '98 Museum for a more in-depth look at Skagway's freewheeling history. Or take a ride on the White Pass and Yukon Route Railroad and see the trail the gold rushers etched into the high mountain pass. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Tue, July 07 – ICY STRAIT POINT (HOONAH), ALASKA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Hoonah means "where the north wind doesn't blow" in the language of the Tlingit Indians, who make up about 70% of the population of this village on the lee side of Chichagof Island. However, wildlife outnumbers everyone, so watch for bears, eagles, and humpback whales, which migrate here in the summer. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Wed, July 08 – CRUISING HUBBARD GLACIER. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Thur, July 09 – SITKA, ALASKA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Called "Shee Atika" by the Tlingit Indians, then "New Archangel" by the Russians who ousted them, Sitka boasts a multicultural heritage. Two dozen of its attractions are on the National Register of Historic Places, including Castle

Day 10: Fri, July 10 – WRANGELL, ALASKA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Once a Tlingit Indian stronghold, then a Russian outpost, and finally an American settlement in 1867, Wrangell has endured dramatic change and honors it. See a preserved tribal house on Chief Shakes Island. Learn about the three gold rushes that transformed the area in the Wrangell Museum. Behold the ancient petroglyphs carved into the rocks on the nearby beaches. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Sat, July 11 – KLAWOCK, ALASKA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. As a town of less than 1,000 residents, idyllic Klawock is emblematic of a true Alaska pioneer town and Oceania Cruises will be the very first cruise line to call on it. Untouched and full of wildlife, this is the Alaska seasoned travelers yearn to experience. Supported by logging, fishing and canning, Klawock is the site of the first cannery in Alaska. The town has also been a native Tlingit village for thousands of years and features one of the most extensive collections of totems in the world. Located on the west coast of Prince of Wales Island, Klawock is surrounded by the temperate rainforest typical of the Inside Passage and you'll be treated to scenic views of lush archipelagos and soaring mountains as you sail in and out of port. It is a natural sanctuary for marine birds and home to dense population of bears due to the abundance of salmon, all of which make it one of the premier birding and wildlife sites in North America. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Sun, July 12 - AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Mon, July 13 – VICTORIA, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA. Arrive 2:00 pm. Depart 11:00 pm. Western Canada's oldest city, Victoria proudly displays its British heritage. Explore lavish Craigdarroch Castle, built in the late 1800s for a Scottish coal baron. Trace the area's early British seafarers in the Marine Museum of British Columbia. There's even a Royal London Wax Museum with likenesses of King Henry VIII and Winston Churchill. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Tue, July 14 – DISEMBARK RIVIERA – SEATTLE, WASHINGTON – HONOLULU. Disembark Riviera. Depart Seattle. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
