Day 1: Sun, Nov 22 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Mon, Nov 23 — MIAMI, FLORIDA. Arrive in Miami. Half-day city tour. Overnight hotel stay. (1 Night)

Day 3: Tue, Nov 24 — MIAMI — EMBARK INSIGNIA. Transfer to pier and embark Insignia. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Wed, Nov 25 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Thur, Nov 26 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Fri, Nov 27 – TORTOLA, BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Spend a glorious day swimming at famed Cane Garden Bay Beach, hiking in the rainforest or enjoying a scenic drive around this lush island. Swim with dolphins, go sea kayaking, or head over to Virgin Gorda and climb down to the famous Baths for a day of swimming and exploring this natural phenomenon. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Sat, Nov 28 – ST. JOHN'S, ANTIGUA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Take a scenic drive, enjoy panoramic island views and visit famed Nelson's Dockyard. Go deep-sea fishing or off road to interesting seaside villages and see the fragile mangrove ecosystem. Day 8: Sun, Nov 29 — CASTRIES, ST. LUCIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Explore this lush, beautiful island and its bustling capital. Visit the historic La Toc Battery, see banana plantations, and watch silk screening at Bagshaws. Venture south to Soufriere at the base of the Piton peaks and see the unique gingerbread architecture of the marketplace. Take a bike ride through the rain forest to a lovely waterfall, kayak in the deep blue Caribbean, snorkel or dive to spectacular reefs. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Mon, Nov 30 — SCARBOROUGH, TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Explore the wonderful Buccoo Reef by glass-bottom boat and gasp at its colorful fish and coral. Enjoy the thrill of sailing on a catamaran to the sounds of calypso music and then snorkel in a beautiful bay. Discover the island and its Fort King George, famed botanical garden, market and Tobago Museum. Or take a walk through the island's tropical rainforest and see the breathtaking cascading Gold and Silver Falls. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Tue, Dec 01 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Wed, Dec 02 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Thur, Dec 03 — CRUISING THE AMAZON RIVER. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 11:00 am. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Fri, Dec 04 — SANTAREM (AMAZON RIVER), BRAZIL. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. See the bustling waterfront, the cathedral, the museum and the famed "Meeting of the Waters" at the confluence of the Tapajos and Amazon Rivers. Or see the rivers converge from a boat on the way to Maica Lake, while looking for rare Amazon pink dolphins. Travel into the nearby countryside and take a walk along a fascinating Amazon jungle trail. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Sat, Dec 05 – BOCA DA VALERIA (AMAZON RIVER), BRAZIL. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 3:00 pm. Go ashore and wander on your own through this tiny settlement at the mouth of the Valeria River. Listen to the screeching of parrots and watch the riots of color they display as they take to the air. Observe Amazonian life up close. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Sun, Dec 06 — MANAUS (AMAZON RIVER), BRAZIL. Arrive 10:00 am. Overnight in Port. Visit the famed Manaus Opera House. See the old mansions and the Indian Museum, featuring artifacts that chronicle the heritage of the region's tribes. Journey into the jungle and trek along a rainforest trail. Take a riverboat to the "Meeting of the Waters," where the dark, clear Rio Negro and the muddy, yellow Rio Solimoes join to form the mighty Amazon. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Mon, Dec 07 — MANAUS (AMAZON RIVER), BRAZIL. Depart 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Tue, Dec 08 – PARINTINS (AMAZON RIVER), BRAZIL. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Visit this isolated island town, steeped in Indian culture, in the middle of the Amazon River. Its stadium has become the focus of the Boi Bumba Festival, an annual event similar to Carnival. Witness an exclusive performance of this Amazonian folklore story. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Wed, Dec 09 — ALTER DO CHAO (AMAZON RIVER), BRAZIL. Arrive 7:30 am. Depart 3:00 pm. Home to Ilha do Amor, one of the most photographed white sand islands in the entire world, Alter Do Chao is a charming riverside village. Explore Lago Verde, a grand lagoon that can be viewed from rented canoes, or take a boat tour along the Rio Tapajós or the Amazon. You'll see a number of bird species and might even spot a crocodile or a sloth. Try Serra Pelada if you seek the perfect place for a short but breathtaking hike. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Thur, Dec 10 — CRUISING THE AMAZON RIVER. Arrive 1:00 pm. Depart 2:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Fri, Dec 11 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 21: Sat, Dec 12 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 22: Sun, Dec 13 — BRIDGETOWN, BARBADOS. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Discover the many beautiful aspects of this island, from its rugged Atlantic coastline to its beautiful Great Houses, cane fields, exquisite gardens and glorious beaches. See the island's spectacular underwater treasures on your own snorkeling expedition. (B, L, D)

Day 23: Mon, Dec 14 — ROSEAU, DOMINICA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Experience the natural wonders of this lush, unspoiled island, from the beautiful Emerald Pool and dense rainforest to spectacular vistas and rare plants and birds. Spend some time snorkeling or try ocean kayaking. Take an aerial tram through the tree canopy near Boiling Lake. Or go on a search for whales and dolphins. (B, L, D)

Day 24: Tue, Dec 15 – PHILIPSBURG, ST. MAARTEN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Snorkel amidst the exotic fish and majestic coral reefs in the undersea world of Shipwreck Cove. Egrets, plovers, pelicans and herons are among the wildlife found via kayak tours of the beautiful saltwater lagoons. Discover the dazzling colors of hundreds of butterflies on the ever-popular Butterfly Farm. With a little training from local sailing professionals, you can even navigate a race on an America's Cup course onboard the world-renowned sailboat, Stars and Stripes. (B, L, D)

Day 25: Wed, Dec 16 – SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 1:00 pm. Begin in Old San Juan, a walled enclave of hundreds of restored 16th and 17th century Spanish colonial buildings. Notice the blue-tinged cobblestone streets; they were once ballast on Spanish ships. Elsewhere, tour the medieval Saint John the Baptist Cathedral, the Museum of Art, and Casa del Libro, a repository of priceless documents. (B, L, D)

Day 26: Thur, Dec 17 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 27: Fri, Dec 18 – NASSAU, BAHAMAS. Arrive 11:30 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Nassau is the capital of the Bahamas and has been the centerpiece of this island nation since the days of Blackbeard. The history has been wonderfully preserved in stately cathedrals and in Victorian mansions displaying elegant, noble architecture. (B, L, D)

Day 28: Sat, Dec 19 — MIAMI, FLORIDA — DISEMBARK INSIGNIA — HONOLULU. Disembark Insignia. Transfer to the airport. Depart Florida. Return flight to Honolulu. (B)
