Day 1: Wed, Sept 09 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Thur, Sept 10 - IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Fri, Sept 11 – ROME, ITALY. Welcome to "the Eternal City" – Rome! Your Globus Tour Director will meet you at the airport. Guided **orientation drive of the city**, to familiarize you with some of the Roman icons including the Colosseum (Note: Entrance to the Colosseum is not included). **"Welcome to Rome Experience"** is a multimedia dive into 2,700 year of Rome's history. The context will enrich your next few days as you discover Rome three-dimensionally. Check in to your hotel, followed by dinner at a local authentic restaurant. Day 4: Sat, Sept 12 — ROME. Guided sightseeing includes the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's ceiling paintings and *The Last Judgment*. Visit St. Peter's Square and Basilica to see Michelangelo's *Pietà*. After lunch (at your own cost) you will visit the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Arch of Constantine and Roman Forum, Mamertine Prison, and Palatine Hill. Dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 5: Sun, Sept 13 — ROME. Drive along the ancient Via Tiburtina to the hilltop town of Tivoli for a visit to the **Villa d'Este**, one of the most beautiful residences of the Renaissance. Its countless fountains, set in the heart of magnificent Italian-style gardens, create a delightfully graceful symphony of carved stone, shade, sunlight, and water. Enjoy lunch in countryside before returning to Rome. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

Day 6: Mon, Sept 14 — ROME — EMBARK ALLURA. Transfer to the pier and embark the Allura. Depart 8:00 pm. (B. D)

Day 7: Tue, Sept 15 — AMALFI/POSITANO, ITALY. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 9:00 pm. Visit enchanting Amalfi to admire the 12th century Capuchin monastery and see the beautiful 11th century cathedral and cloister. Then discover chic Positano with its relaxed, sophisticated air, and white Moorish-style houses clinging to steep slopes around a sparkling bay filled with colorful fishing boats. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Wed, Sept 16 – NAPLES/POMPEII, ITALY. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Spend a day exploring the fabulous ruins of ancient Pompeii or Herculaneum with their stunning temples, frescoes, and mosaics. Explore fascinating Naples and its famed museums, visit charming Sorrento or take a boat trip to the beautiful Isle of Capri. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Thur, Sept 17 — CAGLIARI (SARDINIA), ITALY. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Savor this delightful old city spread over seven hills and its many attractions reflecting the influence of its numerous rulers. Climb to the citadel and visit the fabulous archaeological museum, Roman ruins and Pisan towers, early Byzantine churches, the cathedral, or the botanic gardens. Enjoy the nearby beach or discover the remains of Sardinia's ancient, enigmatic Nuraghic culture and their stone towers built in scenic locations all over Sardinia. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Fri, Sept 18 – TRAPANI (SICILY), ITALY. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Perched on a low-lying, palazzi-dotted promontory on Sicily's western coast, Trapani reveals a hint of its medieval past in its historic core's tightly knit maze of narrow streets. The rebuilt 14th century Cathedral of St. Lawrence and the grand Sanctuary of the Annunciation, which holds a fascinating regional museum, are nuggets well worth a visit. Wandering the Villa Margherita public gardens makes for a relaxing afternoon. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Sat, Sept 19 — VALLETTA, MALTA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Discover the myriad of cultural layers of Malta, from its amazing prehistoric temples at Tarxien to beautiful walled medieval Mdina, nearby Rabat, and Marsaxlokk, a colorful fishing village. Admire the stunning scenery and wander through imposing churches and down the streets of fortified towns where the Knights of St. John once held sway. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Sun, Sept 20 - AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Mon, Sept 21 — AGIOS NIKOLAOS (CRETE), GREECE. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 10:00 pm. Explore this charming town, discover fascinating ancient Minoan and Byzantine villages, and see the panorama of lovely windmills irrigating meticulously cultivated fields on the Lasithi Plateau. Visit a monastery or head across the island to see the reconstituted Palace of Knossos. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Tue, Sept 22 – SANTORINI, GREECE. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Visit the beautiful whitewashed hilltop towns of 0ia and Fira and their breathtaking views of the caldera below. See the stunning artifacts in Fira's museum, including recent finds from the excavation of Akrotiri, thought by many to be the legendary city of Atlantis, or visit a winery. Stroll through the winding streets with fantastic views around every corner. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Wed, Sept 23 — EPHESUS (KUSADASI), TURKEY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Meander through the ruins of ancient Ephesus and marvel at the famed Library of Celsus, the huge amphitheater, the marble roads with their chariot marks, the amazing mosaic sidewalks and the superb, rarely opened Terrace Houses. Or journey to three monumental cities of antiquity — Priene, Miletus, and Didyma — renowned for their majestic temples and impressive, beautifully preserved stadiums. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Thur, Sept 24 – SKIATHOS, GREECE. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Surrounded by the azure waters of the Aegean, the small island of Skiathos sits off the eastern coast of Greece. Explore the island's inlets, capes and peninsulas by boat, or relax on the legendary beaches. Meander through the old port with its pedestrian streets and distinctive whitewashed buildings and red rooftops. Visit the 18th century Monastery of Evangelistrias, built into the hillside during the Byzantine era. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Fri, Sept 25 — ISTANBUL, TURKEY. Arrive 1:00 pm. Overnight in Port. Indulge your eyes and senses in this magnificent city astride two continents. Visit beautiful Topkapi Palace, the awesome Hagia Sophia and the impressive Blue Mosque. Cruise the Bosphorus to see the city and its surroundings from another perspective. Visit one of the many museums or stroll through the spice market and the famous Grand Bazaar. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Sat, Sept 26 — DISEMBARK ALLURA — ISTANBUL. Meet your Globus Tour Director as you disembark the Oceania Allura. A full day guided sightseeing includes visits to the **Roman Hippodrome**, **Blue Mosque**, **Hagia Sophia**, **Topkapi Palace**, and a visit to the underground **Basilica Cistern**. Dinner at a local restaurant. ARTISAN ISTANBUL MGALLERY or Similar (2 Nights) (B, D)

Day 19: Sun, Sept 27 — ISTANBUL. Begin the day with a visit to the **Grand Bazaar** where you will find bargains and treasures. Enjoy a **Turkish Delight Tasting**. Continue to the **Spice Bazaar** for a "true taste" of culture mosaics in Istanbul! Originally devoted to spices and herbs, it now sells a great variety of goods in 88 vaulted rooms. Followed by time at the **Ozdilek and Kanyon Shopping Malls**. Istanbul takes on a different light as night approaches. After a drive through the **illuminated streets of the city** you will be taken to a well-known show-restaurant for a dinner with **Turkish specialities and wine**. Then after dinner sit back and relax and **enjoy a show** with **singers, belly dancers, and folk groups** from various regions of Anatolia. (B,D)
