Day 1: Mon, June 08 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Tue, June 09 - IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Wed, June 10 – LONDON, UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive in London. Meet your Tour Director at the airport. Enjoy free time at Hyde Park. Hyde Park is the 350 acre park that was established by King Henry VIII in 1536, when he took the land from Westminster Abbey to use as a hunting ground. It quickly became popular when it was opened to the public in 1637. Ideal for your arrival day, this is a great opportunity to combine a traditional dining experience with a relaxed, night-time river cruise, viewing some of the capital's most beautiful illuminated sights. Enjoy a three-course dinner with several local menu choices. Following dinner, you will enjoy scenic views from the comfort of your private cruiser. Highlights include Tower Bridge, St. Paul's, and the Houses of Parliament, with commentary from your Guide as you cruise along the River Thames. PARK PLAZA WESTMINSTER BRIDGE or Similar (2 Nights) (D)

Day 4: Thur, June 11 – LONDON. Morning sightseeing with a Local Guide includes sights of the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Whitehall's Mounted Horse Guards, Prime Minister's Downing Street Residence, Piccadilly Circus, Buckingham Palace, Trafalgar Square, and a visit to St. Paul's Cathedral. Visit Borough Market including time for lunch (at your own cost). In the afternoon, visit the Tower of London, one of the most famous historic buildings in the world. Built by William the Conqueror in 1066–1067, it has been guarded by Yeoman Warders (popularly known as the Beefeaters) since the 14th century. It has been a fortress, a royal palace, a prison, a place of execution, and an armory. It is most famously known as the home to the priceless Crown Jewels, including the solid gold crown used at Coronations, the Imperial State Crown, and Sovereigns Sceptre and the incredible Cullinan diamonds. Dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 5: Fri, June 12 – LONDON (SOUTHAMPTON) – EMBARK MARINA. Morning at leisure. Transfer to pier and embark Marina. Depart 4:00 pm. (B, D)

Day 6: Sat, June 13 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Sun, June 14 — COPENHAGEN, DENMARK. Arrive 4:00 pm. Depart 11:59 pm. See another side of this lovely city with a cruise along its charming canals. Visit the quaint old harbor at Nyhavn and beautiful Rosenborg Castle and, of course, the famed statue of the Little Mermaid. Or venture into the countryside and enjoy its panoramic vistas, fairy tale castles, and the village of Fredensborg. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Mon, June 15 — BERLIN (WARNEMÜNDE), GERMANY. Arrive 9:00 am. Overnight in Port. Enjoy a scenic drive to the German capital and savor landmarks like the Brandenburg Gate and the glorious Charlottenburg Palace. Stroll down Unter den Linden, see the site of the Berlin Wall, and take a boat ride along the city's canals. Explore on your own and visit one of the many museums. Or discover charming Warnemünde and its lovely Gothic church, market square, and seaside promenade. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Tue, June 16 – BERLIN (WARNEMÜNDE), GERMANY. Depart 9:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Wed, June 17 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Thur, June 18 – TALLINN, ESTONIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Step back in time as you walk through this beautifully preserved medieval town and discover its upper and lower levels, the guild houses, the churches and squares, the famous apothecary shop, and the exquisite town hall. See delightful parks, Baroque palaces, and a ruined 15th century convent. Or visit a lovely recreated rural Estonian village by the sea. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Fri, June 19 – STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN. Arrive 8:00 am. Overnight in Port. Spend a marvelous day discovering this lovely city and its beautiful buildings. Visit the charming Old Town, medieval Gamla Stan, the elegant royal palace, the wonderful parks, and the impressive Vasa, the magnificently restored 17th century warship that sank in the harbor on her maiden voyage. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Sat, June 20 — STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN. Depart 1:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Sun, June 21 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Mon, June 22 — FREDRIKSTAD, NORWAY. Arrive 5:00 pm. Overnight in Port. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Tue, June 23 — FREDRIKSTAD, NORWAY. Depart 7:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Wed, June 24 - AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Thur, June 25 — BRUGES (ZEEBRUGGE), BELGIUM. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Step back in time to the 14^{th} century as you meander along the narrow streets of this medieval gem past gabled buildings and through the bustling market. Take a boat ride along the city's canals. Or spend the day exploring Brussels and its famed Grand Place or Antwerp, home of Rubens and Bruegel, seeing the verdant countryside along the way. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Fri, June 26 — DISEMBARK MARINA — LONDON (SOUTHAMPTON), UNITED KINGDOM. Meet your Globus Tour Director as you disembark from the Oceania Marina. In the afternoon, visit **Windsor Castle**, the oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world. It has been the family home of British kings and queens for almost 1,000 years and is today one of the official residences of His Majesty The King. The Castle's State Apartments are furnished with some of the finest works from the Royal Collection, reflecting the changing tastes of the Castle's royal occupants, particularly those of Charles II and George IV. Among the masterpieces on display are paintings by Holbein, Rubens, and Van Dyck, Sèvres porcelain, and exquisite English and French furniture. Many of the works of art are still in the historic settings for which they were first collected or commissioned by the kings and queens who have lived at Windsor. Return to London for dinner at your hotel. PARK PLAZA WESTMINSTER BRIDGE or Similar (2 Nights) (B, D)

Day 20: Sat, June 27 – LONDON – EXCURSION TO STONEHENGE. Visit the most famous prehistoric monument in the world, **Stonehenge** stands alone in the vast empty tract of Salisbury plain. Next, head to Bath. Following our scenic drive into the heart of the city, there will be plenty of time to explore at your leisure. Also includes entrance to the **Roman Baths** that were built nearly 2,000 years ago. Special Farewell Dinner this evening at a local restaurant. (B, D)
