Day 2: Wed, Apr 08 — IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Thur, Apr 09 — SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA — EMBARK VISTA. Arrive in Sydney. Transfer to the pier and embark on the Oceania Vista. Depart 8:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Fri, Apr 10 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Sat, Apr 11 — MOOLOOLABA, AUSTRALIA. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Blessed by one of the Australia's top-rated beaches, the golden sands of laid-back Mooloolaba are lined with a tempting assortment of fashionable shops, juice bars and alfresco dining spots. Known for some of the Sunshine Coast's best dining, Mooloolaba takes particular pride in its namesake prawns, a sought-after specialty. Day 7: Mon, Apr 13 — WHITSUNDAY ISLAND (AIRLIE BEACH), AUSTRALIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Enjoy spectacular beaches, snorkel in crystalline waters, or dive and explore the exquisite underwater world of fish and coral. Visit the nearby Great Barrier Reef and enjoy its breathtaking wonders. While in Airlie Beach, take in the laid-back atmosphere at the picturesque lagoon and tropical garden. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Sat, Apr 18 — DARWIN, AUSTRALIA. Arrive 12:00 pm. Depart 11:00 pm. Discover Aboriginal culture and art at the Fine Arts Museum, see the city and its wonderful gardens, or venture into the outback to fabulous Territory Wildlife Park and its many wonders. Or head for the incredible waterfalls at Litchfield National Park. Watch crocodiles at a research station, or take a cruise along the Adelaide River and watch the saltwater crocs leap from the water to catch their prey. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Sun, Apr 19 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Mon, Apr 20 — KUPANG WEST TIMOR, INDONESIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. As Indonesia is known as the land of laughs and smiles, the people of West Timor will delight you with their welcoming nature. In Kupang, the capital of West Timor, you're likely to notice influences from the Dutch and Portuguese colonial eras when Kupang was an important trading post. Visit the Museum of Nusa Tenggara Timur to discover artifacts from the province and insights on the city's legacy and historical occasions in the region. Natural wonders are plentiful too. Crystal Cave is a stunning attraction named after its clear water, and jungle-shrouded Oenesu Waterfall is a favorite among locals and travelers alike. Lovely beaches are nearby as well — try Lasiana for its white sand and calm waves or Pantai Tedis to watch the sun set and enjoy local Indonesian fare. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Tue, Apr 21 — KOMODO, INDONESIA. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Komodo is one of the 17,508 islands of Indonesia and one of three major islands making up Komodo National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. In addition to being a popular destination for diving, it is the

only natural habitat of the Komodo dragon. The island of Komodo includes approximately 60 square miles of craggy mountains, deep canyons, savannas, and monsoon rainforests. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Wed, Apr 22 — BALI (BENOA), INDONESIA. Arrive 12:00 pm. Overnight in Port. Experience this exquisite island and its gentle people as you explore the lush countryside of terraced rice fields and mountains dotted with temples. Visit a royal palace, watch an entrancing dance performance, or see carvers at work. Enjoy villages filled with beautiful arts and crafts and the daily festivals with villagers parading in their finery to local temples. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Thur, Apr 23 — BALI (BENOA), INDONESIA. Depart 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Fri, Apr 24 — SURABAYA, INDONESIA. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Showcasing a dizzying array of cultural influences, this second-largest city in Indonesia was once the most important port of the Dutch East Indies. A prime example is the stately 19th century House of Sampoerna, a colonial-style cigarette factory that houses a fascinating museum. Discover a vast selection of wares at Pasar Pabean, a lively market that links Chinatown and the Arab Quarter. At the Grand Mosque of Surabaya, one of Indonesia's largest, climb the soaring minaret for better views of the gleaming blue and green tiles adorning the sanctuary's domes. As a tranquil respite, settle in for high tea at the elegant Majapahit Hotel, a highlight of Surabaya's complex and absorbing historical legacy. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Sat, Apr 25 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Sun, Apr 26 — SINGAPORE, SINGAPORE. Arrive 3:00 pm. Overnight in Port. Discover a delightful city of contrasts, from its old Chinese quarter and colorful Hindu temples to its modern skyscrapers, famous Tiger Balm Gardens and magnificent National Orchid Garden. Stroll along the Esplanade. Take a short cruise along the Singapore River and a tri-shaw ride through town. Visit the Kranji Memorial and Changi Chapel and Memorial, dedicated to those who lost their lives here during WWII. (B, L, D)
