Day 1: Mon, June 22 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Tue, June 23 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Wed, June 24 – LONDON, UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive in London. Meet your Tour Director at the airport. Enjoy free time at **Hyde Park**. Hyde Park is the 350 acre park that was established by King Henry VIII in 1536, when he took the land from Westminster Abbey to use as a hunting ground. It quickly became popular when it was opened to the public in 1637. Ideal for your arrival day, this is a great opportunity to combine a traditional dining experience with a **relaxed, night-time river cruise**, viewing some of the capital's most beautiful illuminated sights. Enjoy a three-course dinner with several local menu choices. Following dinner, you will enjoy scenic views from the comfort of your private cruiser. Highlights include **Tower Bridge, St. Paul's**, and the **Houses of Parliament**, with commentary from your Guide as you **cruise along the River Thames**. PARK PLAZA WESTMINSTER BRIDGE or Similar (2 Nights) (D)

Day 4: Thur, June 25 – LONDON. Morning sightseeing with a Local Guide includes sights of the **Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Whitehall's Mounted Horse Guards, Prime Minister's Downing Street Residence, Piccadilly Circus, Buckingham Palace, Trafalgar Square**, and a visit to **St. Paul's Cathedral**. Visit Borough Market including time for lunch (at your own cost). In the afternoon, visit **Windsor Castle**, the oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world. It has been the family home of British kings and queens for almost 1,000 years and is today one of the official residences of His Majesty The King. The Castle's State Apartments are furnished with some of the finest works from the Royal Collection, reflecting the changing tastes of the Castle's royal occupants, particularly those of Charles II and George IV. Among the masterpieces on display are paintings by Holbein, Rubens, and Van Dyck, Sevres porcelain and exquisite English and French furniture. Many of the works of art are still in the historic settings for which they were first collected or commissioned by the kings and queens who have lived at Windsor. Dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 5: Fri, June 26 – LONDON (SOUTHAMPTON) – EMBARK MARINA. Morning at leisure. Transfer to pier and embark Marina. Depart 5:00 pm. (B, D)

Day 6: Sat, June 27 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Sun, June 28 – BELFAST, IRELAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Delight in this vibrant city of ornate Victorian and Edwardian architecture, gracious gardens, and friendly pubs. Thrill to the natural phenomenon of the Giants' Causeway, a stunning geological anomaly of tightly packed, uneven basalt columns disappearing into the sea, and the enigmatic ruins of Grey Abbey. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Mon, June 29 – KILLYBEGS, IRELAND. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Donegal's scenic fishing village, Killybegs is situated in a region marked by natural beauty and rich in Celtic heritage. Discover thatched Irish cottages and picturesque Gaeltacht villages, not to mention super fresh seafood and beautiful stretches of coastline with Blue Flag beaches. Get a sense of the town's history and see the world's largest hand-knotted loom at the former factory of Donegal Carpets, now



known as Killybegs International Carpet Making and Fishing Centre. Nature lovers will want to head to hiking trails of dramatic Slieve League Mountains just west of Killybegs – those up for the adventure will be rewarded with stunning views of Donegal Bay, local wildlife, and some of the highest sea cliffs in Europe. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Tue, June 30 – PORTREE (ISLE OF SKYE), UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Known for its beautiful natural harbor and quaint, brightly painted shops and homes, Loch Dunvegan is a lovely setting for a scenic getaway. As is true for the rest of the Isle of Skye, the town of Dunvegan holds strong to its ancestral roots, celebrating Nordic traditions and family lineage. The reverent grandeur of Dunvegan Castle tells the tale of more than 800 years of MacLeod family history. Diverse populations of seals may also be found just a boat ride away on the loch itself. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Wed, July 01 – LERWICK (SHETLAND ISLANDS), UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Enjoy a taste of the Highlands here in the rugged landscape and heathered moors, the ruined castles, steep cliffs, and sea air. Drive through beautiful valleys and flower-filled meadows with romping Shetland ponies to quaint villages like Scalloway with its ruined castle, or explore the fascinating Jarlshof prehistoric site, occupied for more than 4,000 years. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Thur, July 02 – MÅLØY, NORWAY. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Situated on the southeastern coast of the island of Vågsøy, Måløy is a fetching coastal village graced by silvery beaches, lighthouses, and a long history in fishing. A major port for exporting Norway's prized seafood, Måløy is an ideal place to sample the local cod and chips, fish soup, crab-stuffed sandwiches and other fruits of the sea. History buffs will enjoy the Måløy Raid Center, which focuses on an allied full-scale operation that went on to become an important and strategic victory for the Allies during WWII. Also of note is the 10-foot-tall Kannesteinen rock, which has been carved by the sea over thousands of years and now resembles the tail of a whale. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Fri, July 03 – ÅLESUND, NORWAY. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. In 1904 much of Ålesund was destroyed by fire, but the town was quickly rebuilt in the period's popular Art Nouveau style. Soaring turrets, spires and beautiful ornamentation adorn the buildings throughout Ålesund, giving it a distinctive flair and earning the town a revered architectural reputation. An evening departure allows you plenty of time to explore its many attractions, such as the spectacular Art Nouveau Centre Museum, scenic Town Park, and Atlantic Sea Park, one of Europe's largest aquariums. For a look at modern Norwegian woodworking, visit the impressive Gallery Cylindra. Many of Ålesund's squares feature sculptures commemorating significant events, including the town's rich fishing history and Norway's contribution to WWII. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Sat, July 04 – SKJOLDEN, NORWAY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Sun, July 05 – NORDFJORDEID, NORWAY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Situated between one of the largest glaciers in Europe and the rugged Stad Peninsula, Nordfjordeid is your jumping off point

The UNESCO-listed Geirangerfjord awaits you to the northeast, while icy glaciers flow into spectacular valleys to the southeast – you won't have a moment to put down your camera. Something as simple as visiting a deer farm takes on a whole new meaning when you are surrounded by towering mountain ranges, and taking a leisurely hike will be the most memorable experience of your life when you are embraced by sheer rocky cliffs over which roaring waterfalls cascade. Day 15: Mon, July 06 – ULVIK, NORWAY. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Tue, July 07 – MANDAL, NORWAY. Arrive 11:30 am. Depart 8:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Wed, July 08 – FREDRIKSTAD, NORWAY. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Thur, July 09 – COPENHAGEN, DENMARK. Arrive 12:00 pm. Overnight in Port. See another side of this lovely city with a cruise along its charming canals. Visit the quaint old harbor at Nyhavn and beautiful Rosenborg Castle and, of course, the famed statue of the Little Mermaid. Or venture into the countryside and enjoy its panoramic vistas, fairy tale castles and the village of Fredensborg. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Fri, July 10 – DISEMBARK MARINA – COPENHAGEN. Meet your Globus Tour Director as you disembark the Oceania Marina. Guided sightseeing includes the royal reception rooms in **Christiansborg Palace** and **The Little Mermaid Statue**. Dinner at a local restaurant. RADISSON BLU SCANDINAVIA or Similar (2 Nights) (B, D)

Day 20: Sat, July 11 – COPENHAGEN. Discover one of the most impressive castles in North Zealand on this enriching half-day excursion. Drive along the scenic Danish Riviera and join an expert guide to explore fairytale **Frederiksborg Castle**, built for King Christian IV of Denmark-Norway in the early 17th century and the largest Renaissance castle in Scandinavia. Encounter 500 years of Danish history in its outstanding Museum of National History, and marvel at its impressive Neptune Fountain, Chapel of the Royal Orders of Knighthood, Knights Hall, and more. Special Farewell Dinner this evening at a local Danish restaurant. (B, D)

Day 21: Sun, July 12 – COPENHAGEN – HONOLULU. Depart Copenhagen. Return flight to Honolulu. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
