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Day 1: Wed, Nov 18—HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 12:05 pm.

Day 2: Thur, Nov 19—HANEDA — TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 4:05 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure. GRAND NIKKO TOKYO DAIBA (6 Nights)

Day 3: Fri, Nov 20—TOKYO — NIKKO — TOKYO. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, we head north of Tokyo to Nikko. Nikko is a town at the entrance to Nikko National Park, most famous for **Toshogu Shrine**, Japan's most lavishly decorated shrine and the mausoleum of Tokugawa Ieyasu, the founder of the Tokugawa shogunate. Explore the historic theme park, **Nikko Edo Wonderland**, that recreates a 17th century Edo period Japanese village. Explore the beauty, culture and interesting characters of the Edo period with fun activities and a variety of entertaining performances. Enjoy a BBQ lunch while here. Return to Tokyo, where the remainder of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

Day 4: Sat, Nov 21—TOKYO. Start your day with a tour of the **Edo-Tokyo Museum**, which vividly illustrates the past of Tokyo (known as Edo until 1869) through its exhibits. Visitors are able to experience and learn about various aspects of what life was like during the Edo period. Next, take in the view of the surrounding city from the observation deck of the **Tokyo Skytree**. At just over 2,000ft tall, it is the tallest tower in Tokyo. Rising 350m above the ground, the Tokyo Skytree Tembo Deck offers a 360-degree panoramic view of Tokyo. You will have free time to have lunch (on your own) at Tokyo SkyTree or to explore Solamachi, a large shopping, dining, and entertainment complex at the base of the Tokyo Skytree. After lunch, enjoy a fun-filled, hands-on activity, as you **paint your own furin (Japanese wind chime)**. A wonderful souvenir of this trip! Return to the hotel for a buffet dinner. (B, D)

Day 5: Sun, Nov 22—TOKYO — KAWAGOE — TOKYO. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Kawagoe. Enjoy free time at a **shopping arcade** (that is sometimes called "small Kyoto") and at the **Kawagoe Festival Float Museum**. Next, visit the **Kinbue Shoyu Park**, for a tour of the facilities and learn how a staple of Japanese cooking is made. Return to Tokyo and explore **teamLab Borderless: MORI Building DIGITAL ART MUSEUM**, a world of



artworks without boundaries. Artworks move out of rooms, relate to other works, influence each other, and at times intermingle, without boundaries, creating one continuous world without boundaries – wander, explore with intention, discover, and create a world with others in this immersive experience. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 6: Mon, Nov 23—TOKYO. Day at leisure. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. Perfect day to relax and/or visit with family and friends in Tokyo. (B)

Day 7: Tue, Nov 24—TOKYO. Day at leisure. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. Perfect day to relax and/or "shop 'til you drop." (B)

Day 8: Wed, Nov 25—TOKYO — HANEDA — HONOLULU. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **sushi making session**, which will yield your delicious lunch. After lunch, visit **Asakusa**, the center of Tokyo's shitamachi (literally "low city"), one of Tokyo's districts, where an atmosphere of the Tokyo of past decades survives. Asakusa's main attraction is **Sensoji**, a very popular Buddhist temple built in the 7th century. The temple is approached via the **Nakamise**, a shopping street that has been providing temple visitors with a variety of traditional local snacks and tourist souvenirs for centuries. Next is **Ameyoko**, a busy market street between Okachimachi and Ueno Stations. The name "Ameyoko" is a short form for "Ameya Yokochō" ("candy store alley"), as candies were traditionally sold there. Alternatively, "Ame" also stands for "America", because a lot of American products used to be available there when the street was the site of a black market in the years following WWII. Today, various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, fresh fish, dried food, and spices are sold along Ameyoko. Transfer to the Haneda International Airport for the flight home. Depart Haneda via Japan Airlines flt #74 at 9:00 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 9:00 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B, L)
