Day 1: HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines.

- Tour #2: Japan Airlines flt #71 at 4:05 pm.
- Tour #4: Japan Airlines flt #73 at 12:15 pm.

Day 2: HANEDA — TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner at the hotel. SHERATON GRANDE TOKYO BAY HOTEL (3 Nights) (D)

- Tour #2: Arrives at the Haneda International Airport at 7:45 pm.
- Tour #4: Arrives at the Haneda International Airport at 3:55 pm.

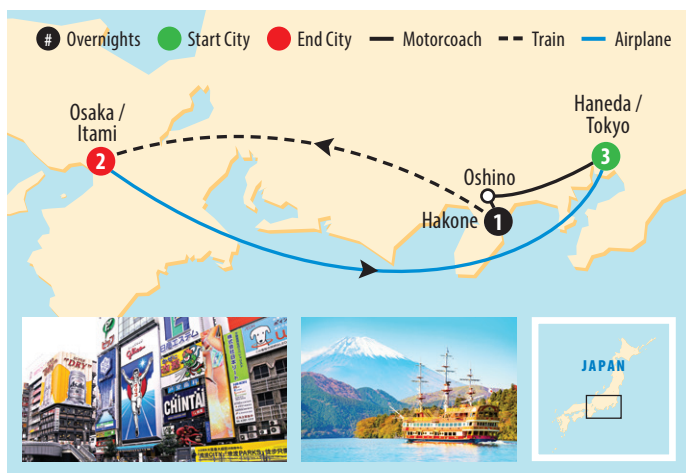
Day 3: TOKYO DISNEYLAND. After a sumptuous Japanese/Western buffet breakfast, enjoy a full day at **Tokyo Disneyland!** Group members will transfer to the resort together. Group members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort line. (B)

Day 4: TOKYO DISNEYSEA. After breakfast, transfer to **Tokyo DisneySea** for a full day of fun and wonder. A unique park that's only found in Japan, Tokyo DisneySea was inspired by the myths and legends of the sea. Group members will transfer to the resort together. Group members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort line. (B)

*Baggage will be sent from Tokyo to Osaka, skipping Hakone. Prepare an overnight bag for one night.

Day 5: TOKYO — OSHINO — HAKONE. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Hakone. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Then, visit **Oshino Hakkaï**, a set of eight ponds located in the Fuji Five Lake Region. The eight ponds are fed by melting snow from the nearby slopes of Mt. Fuji. The melted snow filtered down through porous layers of lava for 80 years creates a very clear spring water that is revered by the locals. Visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source. Continue to Hakone, where much of the area is considered an active volcanic zone since its creation from eruption of Mt. Hakone some 3,000 years ago. Enjoy a **boat ride on the beautiful Lake Ashi**. Transfer to the hotel for a buffet dinner. Don't miss out on the chance to soak in the hotel's **onsen hot springs** tonight! The onsens, which are divided for men and women, can be enjoyed indoors or outdoors. The high-quality service and facilities are sure to become some of your fondest memories of your visit to Japan. HAKONE KOWAKIEN HOTEL (1 Night) (B, L, D)

Day 6: HAKONE — OSAKA. After breakfast, board your waiting coach and travel to the Odawara Station. Board your **JR Super Express Train** for your ride to Shin-Osaka Train Station. Enjoy a bento lunch onboard. Upon arrival in Osaka, visit Dotonbori and Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade, a couple of Osaka's most popular tourist destinations. **Dotonbori** is a popular shopping and entertainment district that runs parallel to the Dotonbori Canal, and is also known as a food



destination. Approximately 600 meters long, **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** and the surrounding area is Osaka's premier shopping center. The area is unique as it combines chain retail stores and trendy boutiques with department stores and top designer fashion labels. Transfer to the hotel. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure. The Local Guide will have suggestions for dinner and shopping nearby. HOTEL UNIVERSAL PORT VITA (2 Nights) (B, L)

Day 7: UNIVERSAL STUDIOS JAPAN. After breakfast, walk to **Universal Studios Japan** (approximately four minutes). Enjoy a full day of attractions and entertainment including *The Wizarding World of Harry Potter* and *Super Nintendo World!* With the hotel located conveniently near the park, you can maximize your time and stay the entire day if you wish. You can check the waiting time for attractions before entering the park to make the most of your time there. Or spend some time at Universal CityWalk Osaka, an entertainment and shopping complex jam-packed with unique and fascinating restaurants and stores, located outside Universal Studios Japan. Return to the hotel at your leisure. (B)

Day 8: OSAKA — ITAMI — HANEDA — HONOLULU. After breakfast, depart the hotel for an **AEON MALL**. You'll have ample time here for shopping and lunch (on your own), before departing for the Osaka Itami Airport for the return flight home. Depart Osaka Itami via Japan Airlines flt #128 at 5:00 pm and arrive at the Haneda Domestic Airport at 6:15 pm. Depart the Haneda International Airport via Japan Airlines flt #72 at 9:55 pm and in Honolulu at 10:20 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
