

HANDS-ON EXPERIENCES:

Hakone Yosegi-Zaiku Making & Sushi Making

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Day 1: Sun, Oct 04 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #71 at 4:05 pm.

Day 2: Mon, Oct 05 – HANEDA – TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 7:45 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Maihama. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner at the hotel. SHERATON GRANDE TOKYO BAY HOTEL (3 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Tue, Oct 06 – TOKYO DISNEYLAND. After a sumptuous Japanese/Western buffet breakfast, enjoy a full day at **Tokyo Disneyland!** Group members will transfer to the resort together. Group members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort line. (B)

Day 4: Wed, Oct 07 – TOKYO DISNEYSEA. After breakfast, transfer to **Tokyo DisneySea** for a full day of fun and wonder. A unique park that's only found in Japan, Tokyo DisneySea was inspired by the myths and legends of the sea. Group members will transfer to the resort together. Group members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort line. (B)

*Baggage will be sent from the Sheraton Grande Tokyo Bay Hotel to the Sunshine Prince Hotel, skipping Hakone. Prepare an overnight bag for one night.

Day 5: Thur, Oct 08 – TOKYO – OSHINO – HAKONE. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Hakone. Visit **Oshino Hakkai**, a set of eight ponds located in the Fuji Five Lake Region. The eight ponds are fed by melting snow from the nearby slopes of Mt. Fuji. The melted snow filtered down through porous layers of lava for 80 years creates a very clear spring water that is revered by the locals. Visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source. Continue to Hakone, where much of the area is considered an active volcanic zone since its creation from eruption of Mt. Hakone some 3,000 years ago. View the surrounding countryside from the **Hakone Ropeway**. Then, visit **Owakudani** ("Great Boiling Valley"), the source of the hot spring waters of Hakone. Transfer to the hotel for a buffet dinner. The **onsen hot springs**, which are divided for men and women, can be enjoyed indoors or outdoors. The high-quality service and facilities are sure to become some of your fondest memories of your visit to Japan. In addition, tour members are allowed to unlimited visits to the nearby **Hakone Kowakien Yunessun**, an all-weather onsen amusement park, at no additional cost! Get your wristband, which will give you entry to Yunessun, at the hotel's front desk. The wristband will allow you to enter without waiting in line, even when Yunessun is crowded! Walk a short three-minutes to Yunessun. Upon entrance, you can receive one complimentary face towel, body towel, and lounge wear (additional towels or lounge wear are at an additional cost). Enjoy food and beverages at Yunessun at your own expense. HAKONE KOWAKIEN HOTEL (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 6: Fri, Oct 09 – HAKONE – TOKYO. After breakfast, depart the hotel for a day of sightseeing and activities in Hakone. Begin the day with a **boat ride on the beautiful Lake Ashi**. After lunch, try your hand at **Hakone yosegi-zaiku**, inlaid and mosaic woodwork unique to this area. A great souvenir of this trip! Depart Hakone for Tokyo. Upon arrival in Tokyo, explore **teamLab Borderless: MORI Building DIGITAL ART MUSEUM**, a world of artworks without boundaries. Artworks move out of rooms, relate to other works, influence each other, and at times intermingle, without boundaries, creating one continuous world without boundaries – wander, explore with intention, discover, and create a world with others in this immersive experience. Transfer to the hotel for an evening of leisure. The Sunshine Prince Hotel is directly connected to Sunshine City and its host of shopping, dining, and entertainment offerings. It also has a Family Mart (open 24 hours) conveniently located on the first floor, perfect for those late night egg-sando (egg salad sandwich) or musubi and fried chicken cravings. A self-service coin laundry facility is also available (open 24 hours) if needed. SUNSHINE CITY PRINCE HOTEL (2 Nights) (B, L)

Yunessun Area (Swimwear Area)

- Open until 6:00 pm on weekdays and 7:00 pm on weekends and holidays. Hours may vary depending on the season. Last entry is one hour before closing time.
- Tattoos are allowed as long as they are covered by a rash guard, band-aid, or tattoo cover-up.
- Experience the thrill of our big, exciting water slide and splash in the waterfall while staying warm and comfortable all year round. And enjoy various themed pools in the large domed area that provides all-weather enjoyment. Or simply relax in the 40-meter outdoor onsen hot spring surrounded by nature and soak up the beautiful scenery.



Mori no Yu Area (No Clothing Area)

- Open until 8:00 pm daily. Hours may vary depending on the season. Last entry is 30 minutes before closing time.
- Tattoos are not allowed.
- Soak up the traditional atmosphere of the onsen hot spring baths, including open-air baths with picturesque views of nature or traditional Japanese ceramics. Lounges and a massage salon are also available. Both male and female areas include open-air baths, indoor bath, jacuzzi, lie down baths, and traditional Shigaraki stoneware pottery baths.
 - Male area only: Waterfall Shoulder Massage and Dry Sauna that invokes heavy sweating.
 - Female area only: Cypress Bath Collagen Bath, and Mist Sauna that moisturizes skin and hair.

- Open until 8:00 pm every day. Hours may vary depending on the season. Reservations are required. Additional fees apply.
- Tattoos are allowed.

Day 7: Sat, Oct 10 – TOKYO. After breakfast, start the day with a **Warner Bros. Studio Tour of The Making of Harry Potter**. Walk in the footsteps of Harry Potter and explore the wonders of the wizarding world. Explore the sets for Platform 9¾, Diagon Alley, The Great Hall, Ministry of Magic, and the Forbidden Forest. Learn about the creature effects, costumes, SFX, VFX, and props that brought these books to life. In the afternoon, take in the view of the surrounding city from the observation deck of the **Tokyo Skytree**. At just over 2,000 feet tall, it is the tallest tower in Tokyo. Rising 350 meters above the ground, the Tokyo Skytree Tembo Deck offers a 360-degree panoramic view of Tokyo. Plus spend some free time at **Tokyo Solamachi**, a large shopping, dining, and entertainment complex at the base of the Tokyo Skytree. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 8: Sun, Oct 11 – TOKYO – NARITA – HONOLULU. After breakfast, depart the hotel for the last day of touring. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, embark on another full day of discovery! First visit the **Meiji Shrine**, a Shinto shrine dedicated to the deified spirits of the Emperor Meiji and his wife, Empress Shoken. Next, tour the visually stimulating **Harajuku shopping district**. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **sushi making session**, which will yield your delicious lunch. Then visit **Ameyoko**, a busy market street between Okachimachi Station and Ueno Station. The name "Ameyoko" is a short form for "Ameya Yokocho" ("Candy Store Alley"), as candies were traditionally sold there. Alternatively, "ame" also stands for "America," because a lot of American products used to be available there when the street was the site of a black market in the years following WWII. Today, various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, fresh fish, dried food, and spices are sold along Ameyoko. Transfer to the Narita International Airport for the return flight home. Depart Tokyo via Japan Airlines flt #786 at 8:40 pm and in Honolulu at 9:00 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B, L)
