On a hilltop at the site of the 8th century temple of Wat Hanchey, take in the stunning views before walking through the rural village of Angkor Ban to visit with welcoming schoolchildren. In Siem Reap, you'll see the phenomenal Temples of Angkor with an intricacy and architectural grandeur unmatched in the world. Visit famous Angkor Wat, Angkor Thom, and the grandeur of the Bayon temple featuring some 200 mysterious faces carved in its many towers.

Your Southeast Asia adventure concludes in enchanting Bangkok, Thailand, where you'll visit its most renowned temples, including the Temple of the Reclining Buddha — the oldest and largest of its kind. You'll also have plenty of leisure time to explore the "Venice of the East" — a perfect ending to this remarkable journey!

Day 1: Thur, Jan 29 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Fri, Jan 30 — HANOI, VIETNAM. Welcome to Vietnam! After completing arrival formalities meet the transfer to the hotel. Your hotel rooms will not be available until the afternoon. Take free time today to explore Hanoi on your own. LOTTE HOTEL HANOI or Similar (2 Nights).

Day 3: Sat, Jan 31 — HANOI. This morning, your Guided Sightseeing takes a look at the life of Ho Chi Minh, the father of modern Vietnam. First, visit the mausoleum and the humble cottage from which "Uncle Ho" ruled Vietnam until his death in 1969. Next on the agenda: One Pillar Pagoda, the Presidential Palace, and the infamous "Hanoi Hilton." Also visit the ancient Temple of Literature, over 900 years old and Hanoi's first university. Lunch is at Koto, a non-profit restaurant and hospitality program that teaches local street children restaurant skills for more stable employment opportunities. After lunch, enjoy an electric-cart ride through the fascinating Old Quarter, with 36 ancient streets where merchants trade as they have for centuries. An early dinner this evening is followed by a fascinating performance of Hanoi's renowned water puppets, a traditional art form dating back to the 11th century. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Sun, Feb 01 — HANOI — HA LONG BAY. Travel from Hanoi through the fertile countryside to Hon Gai, gateway to **Ha Long Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Located in the Gulf of Tonkin, the bay is dotted with **more than 3,000 limestone islands** carved into fanciful shapes by the action of the water. Tunnels, caves, and weirdly shaped outcroppings with imaginative names can be found on many of the small islets sprinkled across the bay. Board a **Cruise Excursion** to explore the caves, and admire the beauty and scale of this bay before stopping at one of the many secluded islands. Enjoy dinner at the hotel this evening. VINPEARL RESORT & SPA HALONG or Similar (1 Night). (B, L, D)

Day 5: Mon, Feb 02 — HA LONG BAY — HANOI — HO CHI MINH CITY. This morning, drive to Hanoi and **board your flight to Ho Chi Minh City**. PARK HYATT SAIGON or Similar (3 Nights). (B)

Day 6: Tue, Feb 03 — HO CHI MINH CITY.

CLASSIC EXCURSION: Take a Walking Tour of Ho Chi Minh City's historic landmarks,



including a stop at the **Rex Hotel** for a **refreshing drink** at the rooftop bar where the U.S. Military held the infamous **"Five O'Clock Follies"** during the war. Then visit the **War Remnants Museum** and bustling **Ben Thanh Market**.

DISCOVERY EXCURSION: For lunch, participate in a hands-on Vietnamese Cooking Class. Learn to prepare several local dishes and how to recreate them at home. Last, but not least, sample your delicious creations!

Explore the city further during free time this afternoon. This evening join your traveling companions for a special welcome dinner at a local restaurant. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Wed, Feb 04 — HO CHI MINH CITY. EXCURSION TO CU CHI TUNNELS.

cLASSIC EXCURSION: Drive out of the city for a Guided Visit to the Cu Chi Tunnels — an extraordinary network of tunnels more than 120 miles in length — used as a hideout and secret village by the Viet Cong. Explore these tunnels and learn what life was like living in these cramped spaces.

Enjoy free time this afternoon and evening. Consider stopping for a drink at the famous rooftop bar at the Caravelle Hotel. (B)

Day 8: Thur, Feb 05 – HO CHI MINH CITY – EMBARK AVALON SAIGON – CRUISE TO VINH LONG. Transfer to the port in the heart of Ho Chi Minh on the Saigon River for embarkation. Get acquainted with the ship and relax before your **Welcome Reception** this evening. Cruise to Vinh Long. (B, L, D)


Day 9: Fri, Feb 06 - VINH LONG - CU LAO GIENG - CRUISE TO CHAU DOC.

- DISCOVERY EXCURSION: Board a sampan this morning to visit a local workshop in Vinh Long where you will see how rice paper, rice wine, and traditional candies are made.
- Gieng Island via sampan and local motor cart. Your Guided Excursion starts at a local workshop, where a skilled family hand-crafts sampan boats. Then, visit the home of a local family that makes Vietnamese conical hats, or "non la," from materials available to them such as palm leaves and bamboo. These iconic hats are primarily used as protection from the sun and rain but you may also see them used as a basket to carry home goods from the market. Lastly, stop at one of Vietnam's oldest Catholic churches.

Cruise to Chau Doc. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Sat, Feb 07 — CHAU DOC — LONG KHANH A — BORDER CROSSING, CAMBODIA — CRUISE TO PHNOM PENH.

DISCOVERY EXCURSION: In Chau Doc take a Guided Walk through the local market and absorb the atmosphere as locals are busy buying and selling fish, meat, and produce. Then embark on a River Excursion down the backwaters of the Mekong. Along the way,



see traditional floating homes, speedboat merchants, religious sites, a market selling dried goods, and more.

DISCOVERY EXCURSION: After lunch, a **sampan** brings you to the village of Long Khanh A for a **Cotton-Weaving Demonstration** of a well-preserved artisan's tradition.

Return to the ship to set sail for the Cambodian border. Cruise to Phnom Penh. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Sun, Feb 08 — PHNOM PENH.

CLASSIC EXCURSION: Take a City Tour by private cyclo to visit the Royal Palace with the spectacular Silver Pagoda, and the National Museum featuring an outstanding display of Khmer artifacts.

The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy the city at your leisure. Just before dinner, **children from a local orphanage** will **perform a show** featuring **local song and dance**. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Mon, Feb 09 — PHNOM PENH — CRUISE TO WAT HANCHEY.

- CLASSIC EXCURSION: This morning, a Guided Visit of the Tuol Sleng Genocide

 Museum and one of the Killing Fields offers a glimpse into the atrocities inflicted on
 the Cambodian people by the Khmer Rouge regime, OR
- DISCOVERY EXCURSION: Visit the lively Central Market by tuk-tuk to see its unique Art Deco design.

After lunch, depart Phnom Penh and enjoy some time at leisure on the ship. Cruise to Wat Hanchey. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Tue, Feb 10 – WAT HANCHEY – ANGKOR BAN – CRUISE TO KONPONG LOUANG.

- DISCOVERY EXCURSION: Visit Wat Hanchey, a hilltop temple dating back to the 8th century. Climb or be driven to the top where you will enjoy stunning views of the surrounding area and partake in a traditional water blessing given by local monks.
- DISCOVERY EXCURSION: After lunch, enjoy a Walking Tour through the rural village of Angkor Ban. Here, you will visit a traditional Khmer house and interact with children at a local school.

Cruise to Konpong Louang. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Wed, Feb 11 — KONPONG LOUANG — KAMPONG TRALACH — CRUISE ON TONLE RIVER — CRUISE TO PHNOM PENH.

DISCOVERY EXCURSION: Start your Guided Sightseeing at the silversmith village in Konpong Louang. Here, see talented craftsmen use age-old techniques to turn pure silver into works of art. In Kampong Tralach board an ox cart for a ride through the beautiful Cambodian countryside. Along the way, stop to meet a local farmer and learn about his daily life.

This afternoon, enjoy scenic cruising on the Tonle River. Cruise to Phnom Penh. (B, L, D)



Day 15: Thur, Feb 12 – PHNOM PENH – DISEMBARK AVALON SAIGON – SIEM REAP. Disembark the Avalon Saigon. **Fly to Siem Reap**, home to the Temples of Angkor, considered by many to be the most spectacular architectural ruins on Earth!

CLASSIC EXCURSION: After lunch, begin your Sightseeing Tour by tuk-tuk to explore the temples. Start at the best preserved and most famous of all the temples: Angkor Wat.

Featuring five trademark towers, it is the symbol of Cambodia. Then, visit Angkor Thom, where you will explore Bayon Temple with its 200 striking faces carved in 54 towers and impressive bas-relief sculptures.

The evening is yours to explore charming Siem Reap, stay to witness the sunset at Angkor Wat. PARK HYATT SIEM REAP or Similar (2 Nights). (B, L)

Day 16: Fri, Feb 13 — SIEM REAP.

Ta Prohm. Tree roots cover the ruin walls, allowing you to experience the temple with the same wonder as early explorers. Then visit **Banteay Srei**, a unique temple built on a small scale from red sandstone, which can be carved like wood. En route stop at a local village famous for making **Khmer noodles by hand**. Be sure to sample some of the freshly prepared noodles!

Spend the afternoon at your leisure.

DISCOVERY EXCURSION: This evening, enjoy dinner and a private Apsara Dance Performance brings ancient Khmer culture to life through music, song, and dance.

Day 17: Sat, Feb 14 — SIEM REAP — BANGKOK, THAILAND. This morning, **fly to Bangkok**. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. Your hotel rooms will not be available until the afternoon. Take free time today to explore Bangkok on your own. JW MARRIOTT HOTEL BANGKOK or Similar (3 Nights). (B)

Day 18: Sun, Feb 15 — BANGKOK. This morning, your Guided Sightseeing begins with a **boat ride on the klongs**, Bangkok's famous canals. Stop at the stunning **Grand Palace** featuring the **Temple of the Emerald Buddha**. Also visit the **Temple of the Reclining Buddha**, the oldest and largest Buddhist temple in Bangkok. It houses more than 1,000 Buddha images, including the 49-foot-high and 151-foot-long massive Reclining Buddha. The reminder of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

Day 19: Mon, Feb 16 — BANGKOK. Enjoy a full day at your leisure. (B)

Day 20: Tue, Feb 17 — BANGKOK — HONOLULU. Bid farewell to Bangkok as you prepare for your homeward flight. Depart Bangkok. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home!


