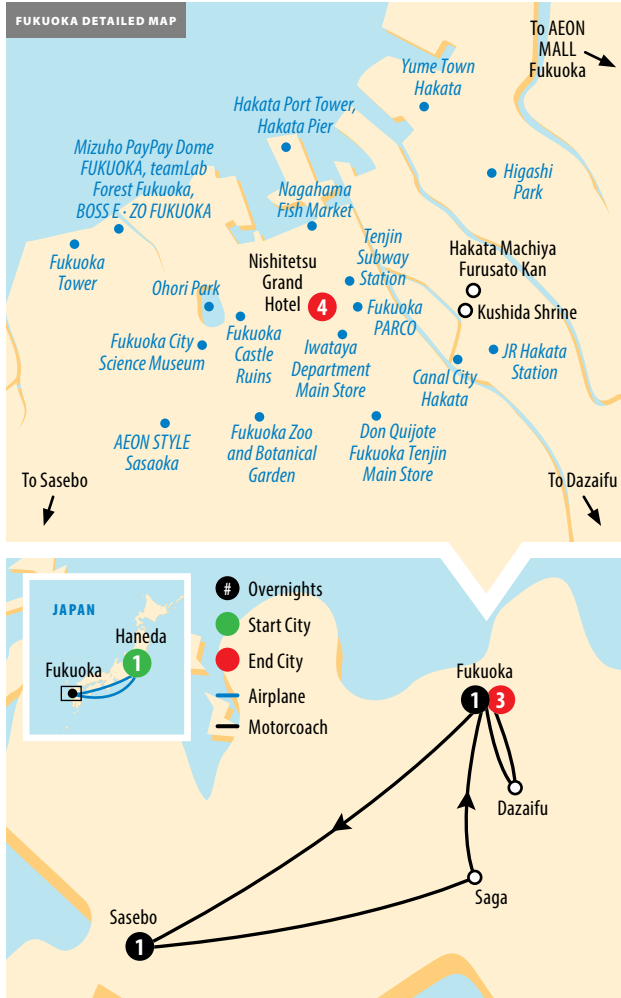

### HOTEL VILLA FONTAINE GRAND HANEDA AIRPORT – 4-STARS (1 NIGHT):

The hotel is conveniently located a short walk from Terminal 3. Shake off the weariness of the 9½ hour flight as you relax in the onsen hot spring (for the nominal fee of 2,000 yen). Or get an introduction to Japanese convenience stores at Lawson (open 24 hours) on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.



### NISHITETSU GRAND HOTEL – 4-STARS (1 NIGHT + 3 NIGHTS = 4 NIGHTS TOTAL):

Conveniently located in the heart of Fukuoka, this upscale hotel near Kushida Shrine is perfect for those seeking comfort and connection. The Iwataya Department Main Store is located about a three-minute walk from the hotel, while the Tenjin Subway Station is approximately a five-minute walk away.



### HOTEL NIKKO HUIS TEN BOSCH – 3-STARS (1 NIGHT):

Located right next to Huis Ten Bosch, the hotel is located just a three-minute walk from the private hotel entrance gate of the amusement park and a one-minute walk from the reentry entrance. It features large public baths and elegantly decorated guest rooms.



**Day 1: Mon, Dec 07** – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 11:40 am.

**Day 2: Tue, Dec 08** – HANEDA. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 4:05 pm. After entry formalities, walk to your hotel connected to the airport terminal. Enjoy a buffet dinner at the hotel. HOTEL VILLA FONTAINE GRAND HANEDA AIRPORT (1 Night) (D)

**Day 3: Wed, Dec 09** – HANEDA – FUKUOKA. After a breakfast buffet at your hotel, transfer back to the Haneda Airport terminal. Enjoy a bento box at the domestic departure gate. Depart Haneda Domestic Airport via Japan Airlines flt #315 at 10:55 am and arrive at the Fukuoka Domestic Airport at 1:00 pm. Welcome to Fukuoka! Stop at **LaLaport Fukuoka**, where you'll have some time to explore over 200 stores, dining options, and entertainment facilities. For anime fans, a 24.8m-tall moving Gundam statue can be found here. After, transfer to the hotel and walk to a nearby restaurant for dinner. NISHITETSU GRAND HOTEL (1 Night) (B, L, D)

\*Prepare overnight bag for one night. Baggage will be kept at the hotel in Fukuoka.

**Day 4: Thur, Dec 10** – FUKUOKA – SASEBO. After breakfast, travel to Sasebo and visit **Huis Ten Bosch**, an amusement park that recreates a Dutch town. This spacious park is suffused with a European atmosphere with its picturesque canals, iconic windmills, stunning architecture, and numerous beautiful seasonal gardens. Attractions include the Sky Carousel, Japan's first three-story sky merry-go-round; Fishing Adventure, where you compete to catch fish in the world's largest digital game; Mission Deep Sea Xsense Ride, where you go on an exciting rescue mission using cutting-edge special effects and intense 4D motion to create a sense of realism; and much more! Enjoy lunch here (on your own). After checking into the hotel, walk back to Huis Ten Bosch to **view the illuminations**. As dusk sets in, Huis Ten Bosch transforms into a "Kingdom of Lights." HOTEL NIKKO HUIS TEN BOSCH (1 Night) (B)

**Day 5: Fri, Dec 11** – SASEBO – SAGA – FUKUOKA. After breakfast, travel to **Okawachiyama Village**, a small, isolated village in the mountains. Alongside Arita (in the neighboring valley), it was the first place in Japan to produce porcelain after kaolin – the mineral essential to making porcelain – was discovered in

the area. Today, Okawachiyama Village consists mostly of pottery workshops and stores. Enjoy some time to stroll the area and shop for beautiful Imari Yaki porcelain ware. After lunch, **pick fruit** at the peak of ripeness! Upon return to Fukuoka, the remainder of the evening is at your leisure. The Local Guide will have suggestions for dining and shopping opportunities nearby. NISHITETSU GRAND HOTEL (3 Nights) (B, L)

**Day 6: Sat, Dec 12** – FUKUOKA – DAZAIFU – FUKUOKA. This morning visit **Dazaifu**, which was established in the late 7<sup>th</sup> century and served as the administration center of Kyushu for over 500 years. Nowadays, Dazaifu is a small, quiet city on the outskirts of the large, bustling city of Fukuoka. A number of temples and shrines can be found here, the most famous of which is the **Dazaifu Tenmangu Shrine**. You'll have free time here to explore the area and enjoy lunch (on your own). After, visit **Kobayashi Sake Brewery**, where you will **tour the facilities** and have a chance to **sample some of their tasty products**. Back in Fukuoka, head to **Kushida Shrine**, a Shinto shrine affectionately referred to as "Okushi-san" by local. This shrine is deeply loved by the citizens of Fukuoka and is the starting location of two of Fukuoka's famous summer festivals: the Hakata Gion Yamasaka and Hakata Okunchi. Next, spend some time exploring **Hakata Machiya Furusato Kan**, a folk museum that showcases the lifestyle and culture of Hakata (now known as Fukuoka) during the Meiji and Taisho periods. Traditional crafts and local sweets are great souvenirs of your visit here. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

**Day 7: Sun, Dec 13** – FUKUOKA. A free day at leisure to explore Fukuoka on your own. The perfect day to relax and/or perhaps do more shopping! Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

**Day 8: Mon, Dec 14** – FUKUOKA – HANEDA – HONOLULU. Begin the day with a hands-on activity as you **paint a Hakata doll**. Hakata dolls are one of the major craft products of the Fukuoka prefecture and are known for their high-quality and realistic facial expressions. A great souvenir of your trip! Then, enjoy free time at **AEON Mall Fukuoka** for shopping and lunch (on your own), before transferring to Fukuoka Airport for the flight home. Depart Fukuoka via Japan Airlines flt #322 at 4:45 pm. Arrive at the Haneda Domestic Airport at 6:20 pm. Depart the Haneda International Airport via Japan Airlines flt #74 at 9:00 pm and arrive Honolulu at 8:45 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
