Day 1: Thur, Sept 17 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Fri, Sept 18 — IN TRANSIT.

**Day 3: Sat, Sept 19** — BARCELONA, SPAIN. Welcome to Spain! After completing arrival formalities, transfer by coach to the hotel in Barcelona. The hotel room will be available in the afternoon. The rest of the day is free for you to explore Barcelona on your own. At 6:00 pm, **meet your Tour Director and travel companions** for a **Welcome Dinner** at your hotel. NH SANTS BARCELONA or Similar (2 Nights) (D)

**Day 4: Sun, Sept 20** — BARCELONA. Guided sightseeing includes the **Palau de la Música** and panoramic views of the city and harbor from **Montjuïc Hill**. Stop at **Sagrada Família Basilica**, **Columbus Monument**, **Plaza de Cataluna**, and **Paseo de Gràcia**. (B)

**Day 5: Mon, Sept 21** — BARCELONA — MADRID. Take a scenic drive through the Catalonian and Aragonian countryside en route to Madrid. NOVOTEL MADRID CENTER or Similar (2 Nights) (B)

**Day 6: Tue, Sept 22** — MADRID. Guided sightseeing includes the **Prado Museum** and sights of the **Cibeles Fountain** and **Calle Alcalá**. (B)

**Day 7: Wed, Sept 23** — MADRID — CORDOBA — SEVILLE. Guided walking tour includes the **Mosque of the Caliphs**. Free time to browse before departing for Seville. SEVILLA CENTER or Similar (2 Nights) (B)

**Day 8: Thur, Sept 24** — SEVILLE. Visit **Plaza de España**. Guided sightseeing includes the **Casa de Pilatos** and a walk through the **Santa Cruz Quarter**. Enjoy dinner with local specialties at El Palacio Andaluz restaurant with **flamenco entertainment**. (B. D)

**Day 9: Fri, Sept 25** — SEVILLE — SETUBAL — AZEITÃO, PORTUGAL — LISBON. Free time for lunch in the vibrant **food market** in Setubal. Visit a **traditional tile workshop** in Azeitão. Enjoy free



time this afternoon and evening in Lisbon. THE EDITORY RIVERSIDE DE SANTA APOLONIA or Similar (2 Nights) (B)

**Day 10: Sat, Sept 26** — LISBON. Guided sightseeing includes a photo stop at **Belem Tower** and the **Monument to the Discoveries**. Explore more of Lisbon with your choice of included Globus Choice Excursions. Join a Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

**Day 11: Sun, Sept 27** — LISBON. Transfer to the next Lisbon hotel. Rooms will not be available until the afternoon. Enjoy a day of leisure in Lisbon. TIVOLI AVENIDA LIBERDADE LISBOA or Similar (3 Nights) (B)

Day 12: Mon, Sept 28 - LISBON.

Afterwards, drive to Cabo da Roca and enjoy some free time in the Western most point of continental Europe. In the morning you might join an optional excursion to learn how to bake the most well-known Portuguese tart, known as pastel de nata. (B)

Day 14: Wed, Sept 30 - LISBON - COIMBRA - PORTO - EMBARK AVALON ALEGRIA.

- ACTIVE EXCURSION: Enjoy the wharfs of the Douro River and the coastal magnificence of Porto and Vila Nova de Gaia, on a guided bike tour, OR
- DISCOVERY EXCURSION: Enjoy a guided visit to one of the many port wine cellars, where a Guide will accompany you through the cellar's facilities, explaining where the grapes



are harvested and how the wines are made. At the end of your explorations, taste some of the wines. OR

cLASSIC EXCURSION: Join a guided sightseeing tour of Porto, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Continue your experience with a ride to the riverside city of Matosinhos and up Avenida da Boavista to admire some of the modern charms of Porto — from ancient avenues to avant-garde graffiti street art.

Later, feel the passion of Portugal's soulful and stirring fado music during a visit with local musicians on board. The ship will be docked in Porto Antigo overnight. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Fri, Oct 02 — PORTO ANTIGO — PESO DA RÉGUA — PINHÃO.

- **DISCOVERY EXCURSION:** Experience life on one of the oldest farms in the Douro Valley with a personal tour by the owner of the house, including a wine tasting, OR
- **DISCOVERY EXCURSION:** Join a wine painting class with the guidance of a resident artist for a unique and new experience to portray an image linked to the culture of wine through an innovative process, OR
- **CLASSIC EXCURSION:** Take a guided walking tour of the charming town of Lamego. Enjoy a taste of the local Bôla de Lamego with sparkling wine and stroll past iconic landmarks like the majestic Lamego Cathedral.

Enjoy a short sailing to Pinhão. Don't miss the opportunity to enjoy free time in Pinhão to browse the artisanal markets for woven textiles, terra cotta creations, and culinary delights, or consider joining an optional excursion to learn about the Douro Valley's "liquid gold" as a traditional olive-oil mill or to visit Casa de Mateus. The ship will be docked in Pinhão overnight. (B, L, D)

**Day 17: Sat, Oct 03** — PINHÃO — POCINHO — BARCA D'ALVA. Join your Adventure Host for today's special activities. Enjoy a relaxing cruise to Pocinho for a day in the Terra Quente Region.

- **DISCOVERY EXCURSION:** Join a workshop conducted by a professional painter to discover the process of azulejos (traditional Portuguese tile).
- ACTIVE EXCURSION: Discover the Douro River by bike on a guided adventure through Portugal's stunning valley. Enjoy breathtaking views and unforgettable moments, OR
- **DISCOVERY EXCURSION:** Experience the charm of the Douro Region with a visit to a historic vineyard estate. Enjoy a tasting of exquisite red, white, and port wines soaking in stunning views and uncovering the rich heritage of this renowned wine making region.
- **DISCOVERY EXCURSION:** Join us for an on board workshop to learn Portuguese language and culture. Discover essential words, charming stories, and clever tricks that bring this centuries-old language to life in an interactive and memorable way.

This evening, enjoy an on board flamenco show with local artists. The ship will be docked in Barca d'Alva overnight. (B, L, D)

**Day 18: Sun, Oct 04** — BARCA D'ALVA — EXCURSION TO SALAMANCA — FOZ DO SABOR. Join your Adventure Host for today's special activities.



- CLASSIC EXCURSION: Join our Guide for a guided tour this morning to one of the most remote villages of the country, Freixo de Espada à Cinta village in the Douro International Nature Park, home to majestic birds of prey, OR
- CLASSIC EXCURSION: Enjoy a guided tour of the historic village of Castelo Rodrigo, which from the top of a hill, dominates the plateau that stretches from Spain in the east to the deep valley of the Douro in the north. Stroll through its medieval streets and discover the small details that give it color such as the Hebrew inscriptions and crosses carves on the doorposts and voussoirs, OR
- **CLASSIC EXCURSION:** Get a taste of Spain with a full-day excursion to Salamanca. This Spanish city will take your breath away with its stunning streets and squares, featuring a feast for the eyes with Romanesque, Gothic, Baroque, and "Plateresque" architecture.

This evening, enjoy live entertainment on board. The ship will be docked in Foz Do Sabor overnight. (B, L, D)

**Day 19: Mon, Oct 05** — FOZ DO SABOR — PORTO ANTIGO — EXCURSION TO AMARANTE. This morning, enjoy a leisurely sailing through the Douro River.

- **DISCOVERY EXCURSION:** Join us on a visit to a wine-producing property, and taste the freshness and lightness of iconic Vinho Verde wine, considered one of the world's unique white wines, OR

**Day 20: Tue, Oct 06** – PORTO ANTIGO – PORTO – EXCURSION BRAGA AND GUIMARÃES. Enjoy a leisurely sailing morning to Porto or join an included excursion to Braga and Guimarães.

CLASSIC EXCURSION: Enter a world of Celtic history and the reign of Cesar Augustus where five roads diverged to form an empire with a full-day guided tour of Braga. Marvel at the magnificent castle and San Miguel Church in Guimarães, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

This afternoon, you may choose to join an optional guided excursion such as a visit to a family-owned factory to witness the Portuguese art of cork and barrel production or a culinary tour experience. Perhaps simply spend time strolling through Porto's cobblestone lanes, lovely shops, and tempting tapas bars before experiencing the energy of Porto's buzzing nightlife. The ship will be docked in Porto overnight. (B, L, D)
