

Travel to the New Territories to see family shrines, the wishing tree and the preserved wetlands. Or visit Lantau Island and the Po Lin Monastery with its giant Buddha statue. (D)

Day 12: Wed, Apr 29 – TAIPEI (KEELUNG), TAIWAN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 2:00 pm. On this fascinating island visit the world's tallest building, the Chiang Kai Shek Memorial, the fabulous Palace Museum's vast collection of Chinese art and the lovely Lungshan Temple. Explore lovely Keelung's historic sites and Yeliu Park's astonishing rock formations. (B, L, D)

the capital and the largest city in the Okinawa Prefecture, which is made up of more than 150 islands. This part of Japan was once an independent entity — the Ryukyu Kingdom. Learn about its fascinating history at the Okinawa Prefectural Museum and discover traditional Okinawan crafts at locations in the city like Naha City Traditional Arts and Crafts Center. If you're up for a day trip, visit the ruins of Nakijin Castle less than 60 miles north — you'll find much to explore on a trek through the grounds of this beautiful UNESCO World Heritage site. Also nearby is the Churaumi Aquarium, where two huge whale sharks and a delightful dolphin show are among the highlights. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Fri, May 01 — AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Sat, May 02 — KOCHI, JAPAN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Not the typical Japanese city, small and compact Kochi has gained a well-deserved reputation for its exuberant, easygoing spirit and vibrant food scene. The city is the birthplace of the legendary samurai Sakamoto Ryoma, who created an alliance that eventually brought down the Tokugawa shogunate and is now commemorated in a memorial museum. In the city center, don't miss the well-preserved hilltop Kochi Castle to explore the grounds where the city was established in 1601. You might continue your downtown explorations at one of the many pedestrian shopping arcades or at a restaurant to try Kochi's most famous dish — katsuo-no-tataki, a savory dish of grilled, ponzumarinated skipjack tuna or bonito fish. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Sun, May 03 — KYOTO (KOBE), JAPAN. Arrive 2:00 pm. Overnight in Port. Visit the breathtaking temples and shrines of Japan's old imperial capital, Kyoto, or explore ancient Nara, the cradle of Japanese arts, literature and crafts, with its magnificent shrines and temples that predate Kyoto's. Stroll through Nara Park, famed for its deer and impressive Kasuga Grand Shrine. Then travel on to Osaka and its famed castle. In Kobe, visit historic Himeji Castle, a huge edifice built entirely of wood and tile. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Mon, May 04 – KYOTO (KOBE), JAPAN. Depart 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Tue, May 05 — TOKYO, JAPAN. Arrive 4:00 pm. Overnight in Port. Dazzling cityscapes await your exploration; visit Asakusa for the bright lights, street fairs and Sensoji Temple; the Tsukiji Market, the largest open-air fish market in the world with on-the-spot sushi; and the Imperial Palace's East Garden for some calm. Spend the evening in the bright, active Ginza District, where the night comes alive. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Wed, May 06 — TOKYO, JAPAN — DISEMBARK RIVIERA — HONOLULU. Disembark Riviera. Depart Tokyo. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
