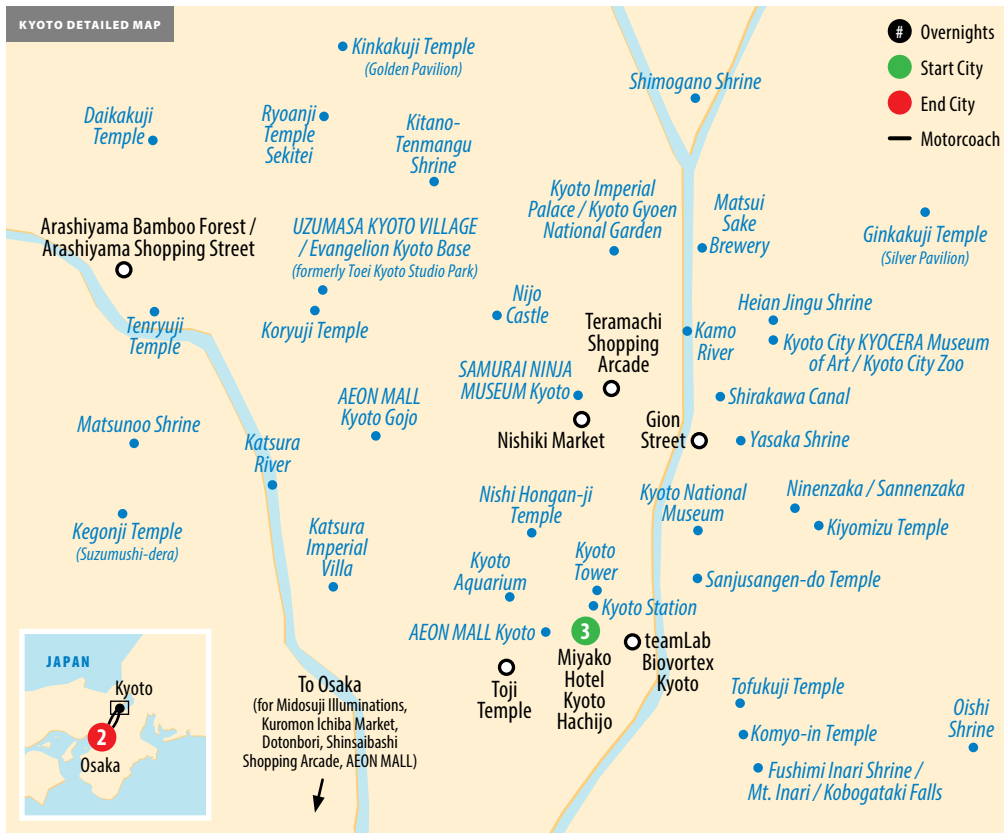

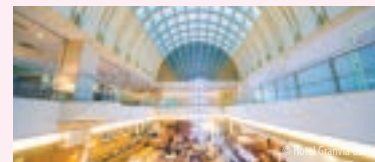

MIYAKO HOTEL KYOTO HACHIO – 4-STARS (3 NIGHTS): One of the largest hotels in Kansai, with an excellent location in front of the Kintetsu Kyoto, JR, and Shinkansen Stations.



HOTEL GRANVIA OSAKA – 4-STARS (2 NIGHTS): Located in the center of the spirited and historic city of Osaka, the hotel is directly connected to the JR Osaka train lines.



Day 1: Sat, Dec 05 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #799 at 10:55 am.

Day 2: Sun, Dec 06 – KANSAI – KYOTO. Arrive in the Kansai International Airport at 3:55 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Kyoto. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure. MIYAKO HOTEL KYOTO HACHIO (3 Nights)

Day 3: Mon, Dec 07 – KYOTO. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, embark on a full day of discovery! First, enjoy some shopping time around **Gion Street**, Kyoto's most famous geisha district, located around Shijo Avenue between Yasaka Shrine in the east and the Kamo River in the west. It is filled with shops, restaurants and ochaya (teahouses), where geiko (Kyoto dialect for geisha) and maiko (geiko apprentices) entertain. Then, visit **Nishiki Market**, also known as "Kyoto's Kitchen." It is a narrow, five block long shopping street lined by more than 100 shops and restaurants. Nishiki Market specializes in all things food related, like fresh seafood, produce, knives and cookware, and is a great place to find seasonal items and Kyoto specialties. Enjoy lunch here (on your own). After, visit one of the most popular shopping streets in all of Kyoto: **Teramachi Shopping Arcade**, located right in the middle of downtown Kyoto. Teramachi Shopping Arcade is an altogether more refined place, with a variety of art galleries, bookshops, and clothing shops. Next, explore the wonders of **teamLab Biovortex Kyoto**, a new concept by the team behind the international art collective teamLab. This venue focuses on a high-dimensional thinking athletics space based on the concept of perceiving the world with your body and thinking about it high-dimensionally. Before returning to the hotel, **view the illuminations** at the 8th century **Toji Temple**, and sees its elegant grounds transformed by an array of traditional bamboo lanterns and artistic installations. Highlights include the illumination around the temple's iconic five-story wooden pagoda – the tallest of its kind in Japan – as well as the adjacent pond. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 4: Tue, Dec 08 – KYOTO. Full day at leisure. Your hotel is surrounded by department stores, specialty stores, and restaurants. A perfect day to fulfill your shopping list. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 5: Wed, Dec 09 – KYOTO – ARASHIYAMA – OSAKA. After breakfast, depart Kyoto. Upon arrival in Arashiyama, explore the famous **Arashiyama Bamboo Forest**. Then, spend some time shopping at **Arashiyama Shopping Street** for some of the world-famous bamboo products while enjoying lunch (on your own). Today's hands-on experience is **yuzen dyeing** (surikomi yuzen), which is one of Kyoto's traditional craft dyeing techniques. Since the patterns are dyed by placing a paper stencil over a piece of fabric, such as a tote bag, you can make an authentic piece, even if this is your first time. A great souvenir of this tour! Continue to the hotel in Osaka. En route, view the **Midosuji Illumination** – a spectacular 4km light display along Osaka's main thoroughfare from Umeda to Namba. Recognized for its scale, it features themed lighting zones, interactive displays, and illuminated trees. In 2015, it was recognized as holding the world record for the most street tree illuminations. After arriving at the hotel, the remainder of the evening is at your leisure. HOTEL GRANVIA OSAKA (2 Nights) (B)

Day 6: Thur, Dec 10 – OSAKA. Full day at leisure. The perfect day to relax and/or fulfill your shopping list. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 7: Fri, Dec 11 – OSAKA – KANSAI – HONOLULU. After breakfast and hotel checkout, start the day with a visit to **Kuromon Ichiba Market**, a lively covered market which stretches for 580m in Osaka's Chuo Ward. The market is famous for its fresh seafood, fruits and vegetables, meats, dried fish, pickles, and confectionery. Many stalls will prepare, cook and serve their food to you right on the spot! Next, visit Dotonbori and Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade, a couple of Osaka's most popular tourist destinations. **Dotonbori** is a popular shopping and entertainment district that runs parallel to Dotonbori Canal, and is also known as a food destination. At approximately 600m long, **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** and the surrounding area is Osaka's premier shopping center. The unique area combines chain retail stores and trendy boutiques with department stores and top designer fashion labels. Enjoy lunch in the area (on your own). A final shopping stop will be made at an **AEON MALL** before transferring to the Kansai International Airport for our return flight home. Depart Kansai via Japan Airlines flt #790 at 10:10 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 10:15 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
