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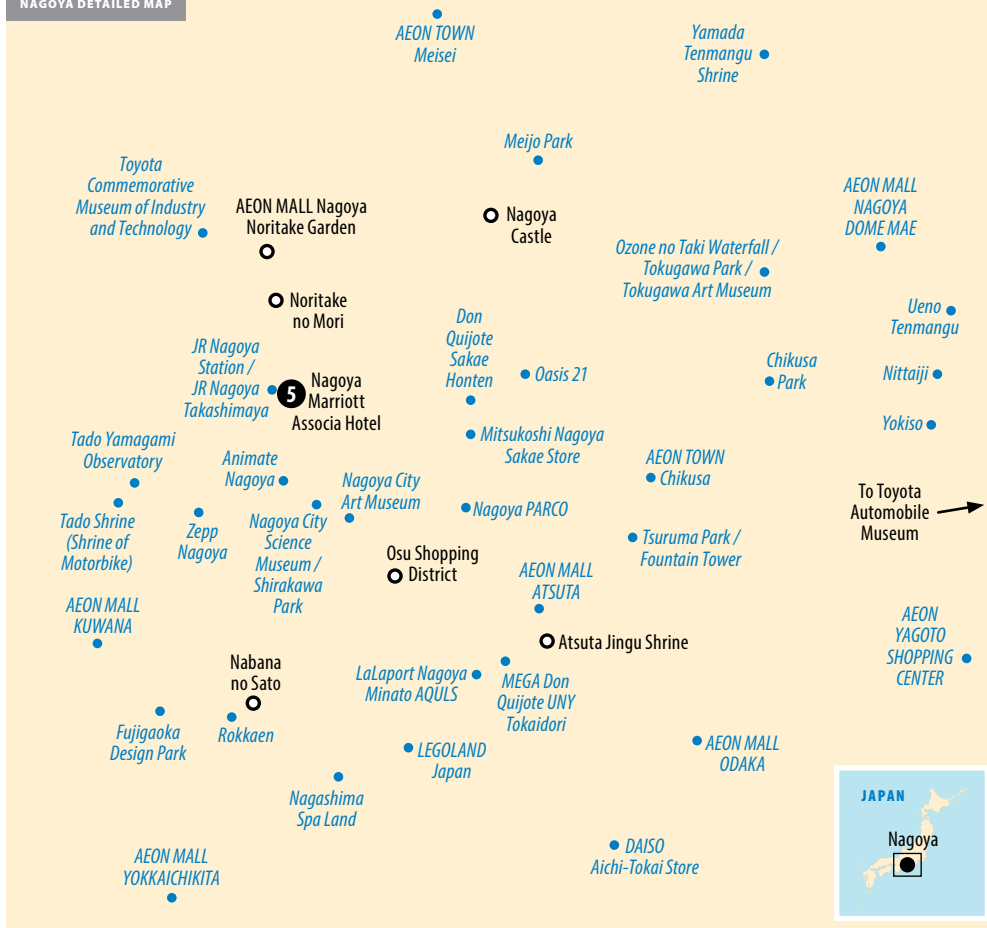
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NAGOYA DETAILED MAP



NAGOYA MARRIOTT ASSOCIA HOTEL – 4-STAR

(5 NIGHTS): Based in the heart of the city, the Nagoya Marriott Associa Hotel is conveniently located directly above JR Nagoya Station – with 11 floors of JR Nagoya Takashimaya (a department store) and two floors of gourmet outlets. The hotel features panoramic views from all of its rooms, a fitness center, indoor pool, sauna, and nine dining options.



Day 1: Thur, Dec 03 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #797 at 1:25 pm.

Day 2: Fri, Dec 04 – NAGOYA. Arrive in the Chubu Centrair International Airport at 6:00 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Nagoya. The evening is at your leisure. The Local Guide will have recommendations for nearby dining and shopping options. NAGOYA MARRIOTT ASSOCIA HOTEL (5 Nights)

Day 3: Sat, Dec 05 – NAGOYA. After a breakfast buffet, begin the exploration of Nagoya at the **Nagoya Castle**, which was completed in 1615 by the famed Shogun, Tokugawa Ieyasu. Although Nagoya Castle was partially destroyed in 1945, it was deemed a historically important site and designated a National Historic Site, with reconstruction, restoration, and repair continually being done. For lunch, enjoy hitsumabushi, a dish that is particularly popular in Nagoya, featuring thinly sliced, grilled unagi (eel) served over rice. After lunch, explore the **Toyota Automobile Museum**, a large museum showcasing the history of Toyota as an automobile manufacturer. In addition to displaying its own vehicles that Toyota has manufactured over the years, numerous vehicles from other manufacturers of various makes are also displayed. Next, explore the **Osu Shopping District**, which is home to over 1,200 shops and restaurants. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B, L)

Day 4: Sun, Dec 06 – NAGOYA. Start the day at **Atsuta Jingu Shrine**, Japan's second most revered Shinto shrine after the Great Shrine of Ise, and dates back over 1900 years. The shrine is home to the sacred Kusanagi-no-Tsurugi sword, likened to the legendary *Excalibur*, it is one of the Three Imperial Regalia of Japan. Next, learn about Noritake, a leading ceramics company with over 100+ years of history, at **Noritake no Mori**. Built on the grounds of the Noritake's former factory grounds, Noritake no Mori includes a craft center, where visitors can observe how porcelain is created, and a museum, where examples of the items produced by the company throughout the years are displayed, a gardens, shop, café, and restaurant. You'll then have free time to explore

the nearby **AEON MALL Nagoya Noritake Garden**, which features a wide variety of shopping, dining, and entertainment options, including a planetarium. Enjoy lunch here (on your own). Lastly, visit one of the most popular **winter illuminations** in Japan at **Nabana no Sato**. The illuminations have become a yearly event for the past 20 years, growing in popularity each year. You'll have ample time to view the display of lights, walk through the "Tunnel of Light," and enjoy dinner with the group while here. A relaxing outdoor hot springs foot bath is available for free for visitors to enjoy as well. For those that wish to indulge, multiple indoor and outdoor baths are available as well (for a fee). Return to the hotel for the evening. (B, D)

Day 5: Mon, Dec 07 – NAGOYA. Full day at leisure. The perfect day to explore more of Nagoya on your own, or fulfill your shopping list. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 6: Tue, Dec 08 – NAGOYA. Another full day at leisure. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 7: Wed, Dec 09 – NAGOYA – HONOLULU. After breakfast, learn the traditional Japanese tie-dye technique, known as shibori. The Arimatsu and Narumi areas around Nagoya became renowned for their distinctive shibori techniques, which were once favored by samurai and merchants. The craft has been passed down through generations, and the tie-dyed products are designated as a traditional national craft. The tie-dye technique is known for the contrast in shading that is created when the fabric is tied and the distinctive texture of the pattern. Currently, there are more than a hundred kinds of tie dyeing methods available. Unleash your creativity by designing your own **shibori handkerchief** in a **hands-on workshop** with a skilled local artisan. Then, transfer to the Chubu Centrair International Airport for the flight home. Depart Nagoya via Japan Airlines flt #798 at 8:25 pm and arrive Honolulu at 8:15 am the same day.
