FARGO SERIOUS INJURY CRASH

NARRATIVE: On Sunday, January 18, 2026, at approximately 6:41 a.m., a Honda Pilot was traveling from a residence in south Fargo toward Sanford Hospital. While traveling northbound, the Honda Pilot entered the intersection and struck a Chevrolet Impala.

Two passengers seated in the back seat of the Honda Pilot were unrestrained at the time of the crash and sustained serious injuries. Both were transported by ambulance to Sanford Hospital. The driver of the Chevrolet Impala sustained serious injuries and was transported by ambulance to Sanford Hospital. The driver of the Pilot was not injured.

The name of the juvenile will not be released. The crash remains under investigation by the North Dakota Highway Patrol.
