Day 1: Mon, Sept 13 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Tue, Sept 14 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Wed, Sept 15 – LONDON (SOUTHAMPTON), UNITED KINGDOM – EMBARK OCEANIA SONATA. Arrive in London. Transfer to pier and embark the Sonata. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Thur, Sept 16 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Fri, Sept 17 – LA ROCHELLE, FRANCE. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Known for its white limestone cliffs, La Rochelle features a bustling Vieux Port (Old Harbor) with exceptional shops and restaurants. Three medieval towers once protected the port and are now symbols of the waterfront. The imposing Four Sergeants Tower was formerly a prison, and you can see where the corsairs scrawled graffiti on the walls. The city aquarium holds thousands of species living in re-creations of their natural habitats. You will also appreciate La Rochelle's pedestrian-friendly streets, especially in the city center, which is graced by 17th and 18th century architecture. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Sat, Sept 18 – PAULLIAC (BORDEAUX), FRANCE. Arrive 7:00 am. Overnight in port. Picturesque Pauillac sits amid the vineyards of the Bordeaux wine region in southwest France and is renowned for its scenic landscape, local cuisine, and it's highly acclaimed wines. Cruises to Pauillac present the perfect opportunity to sample regional specialties like Château Lafite Rothschild and Château Mouton Rothschild or even to immerse yourself into the wine-making process on a vineyard tour. If you're not a wine lover, there's still plenty to enjoy in this post-card perfect corner of the French countryside. You could visit the hilltop village of Saint-Émilion, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Or take a tour to the historic city of Bordeaux, easily reachable from Pauillac by car, train, or bus. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Sun, Sept 19 – PAULLIAC (BORDEAUX), FRANCE. Depart 5:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Mon, Sept 20 – BILBAO, SPAIN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 8:00 pm. Bilbao is a charming city both modern and dynamic while at the same time, with its 700 years of history, it is quite traditional as well. Enjoy a walk around the Old Quarter, the most popular area of the city. Here

you will see the Teatro Arriaga; el Arenal, the old stevedoring port and today one of the favorite promenades of the citizens of Bilbao; the San Nicholas Church; and the Cathedral of Santiago along with its cloister, Plaza Nueva. No visit to Bilbao would be complete without a visit to the architecturally stunning Guggenheim Museum, which is in and of itself a work of art. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Tue, Sept 21 – GIJON, SPAIN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. While tourists and locals alike flock to the beautiful beaches of Gijon, there is plenty to do in and around the city as well. There are several uniquely themed museums, including the Campo Valdes Roman Baths, considered one of the most important Roman remains in northern Spain. Visit the aquarium, the botanical gardens or simply stroll through the streets of Cimavilla, the oldest part of Gijon. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Wed, Sept 22 – LA CORUNA, SPAIN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. See the famed Tower of Hercules, the still working 2nd century Roman lighthouse, and wander through this historic town of fine churches, old palaces, cobbled streets, and unique fishermen's houses. Or spend the day in beautiful Santiago de Compostela, an important pilgrimage site renowned for its magnificent cathedral and superb architectural and cultural heritage. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Thur, Sept 23 – SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (VIGO), SPAIN. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. This Galician capital is most famous for the magnificent Cathedral de Santiago de Compostela, which for over 1,000 years has been the destination of the religious pilgrimage known as the Way of St. James. Before visiting the shrine to the Apostle James, stroll through the city's charming Old Town, designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Fri, Sept 24 – OPORTO, PORTUGAL. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Explore picturesque, historic Oporto and the Vila Nova de Gaia quarter, home of its famed port wine industry. Or discover Portugal's scenic countryside and visit Guimaraes with its impressive medieval castle and beautiful Braga with its Bom Jesus Shrine and superb cathedral. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Sat, Sept 25 – LISBON, PORTUGAL – DISEMBARK OCEANIA SONATA – HONOLULU. Arrive 7:00 am. Disembark Sonata. Depart Lisbon. Return flight to Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
