**Day 1: Wed, Aug 11** – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

**Day 2: Thur, Aug 12** – SEATTLE, WASHINGTON – EMBARK RIVIERA. Arrive in Seattle. Transfer to pier and embark the Riviera. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

**Day 3: Fri, Aug 13** – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 4: Sat, Aug 14** – KETCHIKAN, ALASKA. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Totem poles are one of Ketchikan's chief attractions, and the best places to view them are Saxman Village and Totem Bight State Park. Drop by the Southeast Alaska Discovery Center to learn about the local cultures and ecosystems. (B, L, D)

**Day 5: Sun, Aug 15** – SITKA, ALASKA. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Called "Shee Atika" by the Tlingit Indians, then "New Archangel" by the Russians who ousted them, Sitka boasts a multicultural heritage. Two dozen of its attractions are on the National Register of Historic Places, including Castle Hill and Building 29, a structure built by the Russians in 1835. The Sheldon Jackson Museum exhibits one of Alaska's oldest native culture collections. (B, L, D)

**Day 6: Mon, Aug 16** – CRUISING HOLKHAM BAY GLACIER FJORDS. From 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

**Day 7: Tue, Aug 17** – SKAGWAY, ALASKA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Skagway's spectacular natural setting encourages a walking tour of this well-preserved gold rush town. See the Moore House, built in 1897, a year before the gold rush, and the Gold Rush Cemetery, where famed Old West desperado Soapy Smith is buried. Visit the Trail of '98 Museum for a more in-depth look at Skagway's freewheeling history. Or take a ride on the White Pass and Yukon Route Railroad and see the trail the gold rushers etched into the high mountain pass. (B, L, D)

**Day 8: Wed, Aug 18** – JUNEAU, ALASKA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. For a state capital, Juneau maintains a surprising small-town charm, in part because it can only be reached by sea or

air due to the surrounding wilderness. Collections from the indigenous people are displayed in the Alaska State Museum. Visit Mendenhall Glacier for outdoor adventure. (B, L, D)

**Day 9: Thur, Aug 19** – KLAWOCK, ALASKA. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. As a town of less than 1,000 residents, idyllic Klawock is emblematic of a true Alaska pioneer town and Oceania Cruises will be the very first cruise line to call on it. Untouched and full of wildlife, this is the Alaska seasoned travelers yearn to experience. Supported by logging, fishing and canning, Klawock is the site of the first cannery in Alaska. The town has also been a native Tlingit village for thousands of years and features one of the most extensive collections of totems in the world. Located on the west coast of Prince of Wales Island, Klawock is surrounded by the temperate rainforest typical of the Inside Passage and you'll be treated to scenic views of lush archipelagos and soaring mountains as you sail in and out of port. It is a natural sanctuary for marine birds and home to dense population of bears due to the abundance of salmon, all of which make it one of the premier birding and wildlife sites in North America. **Day 10: Fri, Aug 20** – WRANGELL, ALASKA. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Once a Tlingit Indian stronghold, then a Russian outpost, and finally an American settlement in 1867, Wrangell has endured dramatic change and honors it. See a preserved tribal house on Chief Shakes Island. Learn about the three gold rushes that transformed the area in the Wrangell Museum. Behold the ancient petroglyphs carved into the rocks on the nearby beaches. (B, L, D)

**Day 11: Sat, Aug 21** – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 12: Sun, Aug 22** – VICTORIA, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA. Arrive 1:00 pm. Depart 9:00 pm. Western Canada's oldest city, Victoria proudly displays its British heritage. Explore lavish Craigdarroch Castle, built in the late 1800s for a Scottish coal baron. Trace the area's early British seafarers in the Marine Museum of British Columbia. There's even a Royal London Wax Museum with likenesses of King Henry VIII and Winston Churchill. (B, L, D)

**Day 13: Mon, Aug 23** – VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA – DISEMBARK RIVIERA – HONOLULU. Arrive 7:00 am. Disembark Riviera. Depart Vancouver. Return flight to Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
