**Day 1: Wed, Apr 07** – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

**Day 2: Thur, Apr 08** – TOKYO, JAPAN. Arrive Tokyo. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to hotel in Tokyo. Upon arrival at the hotel, receive a boxed sandwich dinner. **KEIO PLAZA HOTEL TOKYO** (3 Nights) (D)

**Day 3: Fri, Apr 09** – TOKYO. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, take in the view of the surrounding city from the observation deck of the **Tokyo Skytree**. At just over 2,000 ft tall, it is the tallest tower in Tokyo. Rising 350m above the ground, the Tokyo Skytree Tembo Deck offers a 360 degree panoramic view of Tokyo. Enjoy lunch (on your own) at **Tokyo Solamachi**, located at the base of the Tokyo Skytree, where a variety of restaurant and food choices are available. After lunch, take on a fun-filled, hands-on activity, as you learn how to **make your own furin (Japanese wind chime)**. Start by blowing glass into a round and finish by hand painting your personal treasure. Next, explore **teamLab Borderless: MORI Building DIGITAL ART MUSEUM**, a world of artworks without boundaries. Artworks move out of rooms, relate to other works, influence each other, and at times intermingle, without boundaries, creating one continuous world without boundaries – wander, explore with intention, discover, and create a world with others in this immersive experience. Enjoy a special Yakatabune dinner before returning to the hotel for the evening. (B, D)

**Day 4: Sat, Apr 10** – TOKYO. Day at leisure. The perfect day to relax and/or visit with family and friends in Tokyo. Your local guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

**Day 5: Sun, Apr 11** – TOKYO – YOKOHAMA – EMBARK OCEANIA VISTA. After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, depart the hotel for Yokohama. Begin the day at **Shin-Yokohama Ramen Museum**, the world's first ramen-themed amusement park. Founded in 1994, it was created to be the one-stop place to enjoy the flavors of this national dish from renowned shops across Japan without having to step on a plane. Learn about the history and culture of ramen. Then take part in a **ramen making experience**, where you will make noodles using the traditional Chinese method of "green bamboo beating" and enjoy learning how flour is transformed into ramen. **Day 9: Thur, Apr 15** – MIYAKOJIMA (HIRARA), JAPAN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. This Japanese island paradise is known for its natural beauty and vibrant local culture. The Eastern Cape is a nationally-designated Place of Scenic Beauty with a spectacular view of the surrounding ocean. Stop by the beaches of Sunayama or Aragusuku for sunshine and snorkeling. A visit to the Shigira onsen hot springs will help you relax or take a ride across the expansive Ikema Bridge for a scenic drive across the beautiful blue waters. (B, L, D)



**Day 10: Fri, Apr 16** – TAIPEI (KEELUNG), TAIWAN. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. On this fascinating island visit the world's tallest building, the Chiang Kai Shek Memorial, the fabulous Palace Museum's vast collection of Chinese art and the lovely Lungshan Temple. Explore lovely Keelung's historic sites and Yeliu Park's astonishing rock formations. (B, L, D)

**Day 11: Sat, Apr 17** – KAOHSIUNG, TAIWAN. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. The canal-like Love River flows through the heart of this wonderfully modern city, and a boat ride along its shores reveals Kaohsiung's beauty. The former British Consulate, built in 1865, is a historic landmark juxtaposed with more modern sites such as the Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts, known for its contemporary sculptures. (B, L, D)

**Day 12: Sun, Apr 18** – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 13: Mon, Apr 19** – MANILA, PHILIPPINES. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Dynamic Manila never slows down, so go with the flow by delving headlong into the attractions, including the elegant Malacanang Palace, the National Museum of the Philippines, verdant Rizal Park, and the poignant American Cemetery and Memorial. The walled medieval district of Intramuros is also well worth exploring. (B, L, D)

**Day 14: Tue, Apr 20** – CORON, PHILIPPINES. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Situated in the northern region of the island province of Palawan – often billed as one of the best island destinations in the world – Coron is blessed with towering limestone karsts, gorgeous beaches, and incredible coral reefs. You can explore old-growth rainforests, snorkel in picturesque lagoons and even dive WWII wrecks. Kayangan Lake offers sweeping views of limestone towers draped in lush vegetation, and visitors are welcome to swim and snorkel in the crystal-clear waters. You'll quickly understand why this mountain lake is among the most photographed places in the Philippines. Just a short drive from the port, the mangrove-shrouded Maquinit Hot Springs is one of the few saltwater hot springs in the world and is the perfect location to take a restorative dip. (B, L, D)

**Day 15: Wed, Apr 21** – PUERTO PRINCESA, PHILIPPINES. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Founded as a Spanish naval hub in 1872, Puerto Princesa is developing a new identity as the ecotourism center of the Philippines. Marvel at the sights of the popular underground river, located in a nearby national park, or go zip-lining at Ugong Rock. In town, learn about the

**Day 16: Thur, Apr 22** – KOTA KINABALU (BORNEO), MALAYSIA. Arrive 1:00 pm. Depart 9:00 pm. Enjoy the sights in this bustling, ethnically diverse city as you see the gold-domed mosque, unique high-rise architecture, and the Heritage Village. Or venture into the interior and astonishing Kinabalu Park. Stroll past rare plants along a nature trail and through a garden of rare orchids. Or ride Borneo's last train into the lush countryside of farms, water buffalo and villages. Spend time on the glorious beaches. (B, L, D)

**Day 17: Fri, Apr 23** – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 18: Sat, Apr 24** – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

**Day 19: Sun, Apr 25** – SINGAPORE, SINGAPORE – DISEMBARK OCEANIA VISTA. Arrive 7:00 am. Upon disembarkation at the Singapore Pier, join your Local Guide and visit **Little India, Sultan Mosque, Arab Street, Merlion Park, The Arts House at The Old Parliament** (outside), **Statues of Sir Stamford Raffle**, and **Esplanade** (outside). After lunch, visit **Sentosa Island** and **Singapore Oceanarium**. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel. **MOMENTUS HOTEL ALEXANDRA** or Similar (2 Nights) (B, L, D)

**Day 20: Mon, Apr 26** – SINGAPORE. Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Start the day with a visit to the **Singapore Zoo**. After lunch, tour **Gardens by the Bay** (including entry into the Cool House). For dinner, explore a **local Hawker's Market** and have a **Crazy Rich Asians** experience of your own. Return to the hotel for the evening. (B, L)
