**Day 1: Sat, Nov 27** – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

**Day 2: Sun, Nov 28** – SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA. Welcome to Australia! After completing arrival formalities, transfer by coach to the hotel. Enjoy dinner at the hotel before retiring for the evening. PULLMAN SYDNEY AIRPORT. (1 Night) (D)

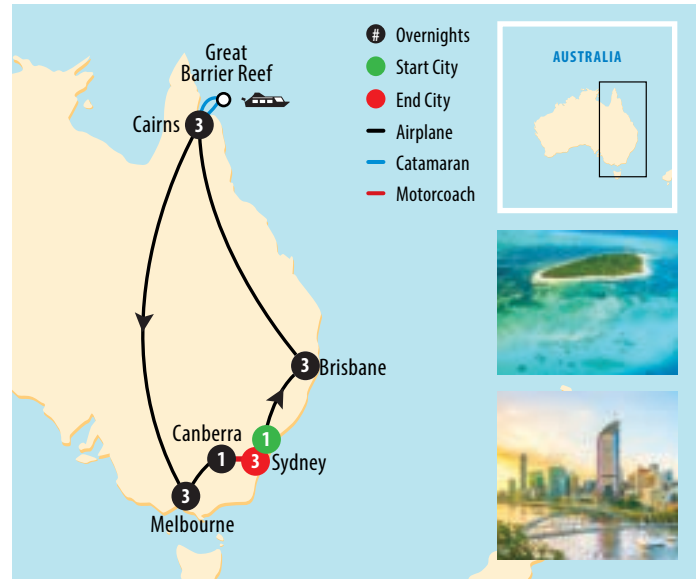
**Day 4: Tue, Nov 30** – BRISBANE. Enjoy an orientation tour of Brisbane, including the historical buildings and modern high-rises. Learn about the city's convict past along with its modern cosmopolitan culture. Travel to the Nyanda Waterhole Reserve where you'll be welcomed to the country by traditional owners of the land and learn about their culture. Later, visit the Lone Pine Koala Sanctuary. Founded in 1927, it is the oldest and largest koala sanctuary in the world. Return to Brisbane where the evening is at leisure. (B, L)

**Day 5: Wed, Dec 01** – BRISBANE. A full day to explore more of vibrant Brisbane. (B)

**Day 6: Thur, Dec 02** – BRISBANE – CAIRNS. Fly to Cairns, the "Gateway to the Great Barrier Reef." Upon arrival, enjoy an orientation tour of Cairns followed by a visit to the Cairns Aquarium. Dinner tonight is at a local restaurant. PULLMAN CAIRNS INTERNATIONAL or Similar (3 Nights) (B, D)

**Day 7: Fri, Dec 03** – CAIRNS – EXCURSION TO THE OUTER GREAT BARRIER REEF. Prepare for the experience of a lifetime when you board a catamaran and cruise to the Outer Great Barrier Reef, one of the Seven National Wonders of the World. Explore this underwater world that is dazzling kaleidoscope of dazzling hues. Return to Cairns this afternoon. Your evening is at leisure. (B, L)

**Day 8: Sat, Dec 04** – CAIRNS. Enjoy a full day at leisure to explore more of Cairns. (B)



**Day 9: Sun, Dec 05** – CAIRNS – MELBOURNE. Touch down today in one of Australia's most well-known cities. Upon arrival, enjoy an orientation tour before arriving at your hotel. VIBE MELBOURNE or Similar (3 Nights) (B)

**Day 10: Mon, Dec 06** – MELBOURNE. Today's sightseeing tour includes landmarks such as the Parliament House and the Shrine of Remembrance, a tribute to Australia's war heroes. **Day 11: Tue, Dec 07** – MELBOURNE. Enjoy a full day at leisure to explore this multicultural and cosmopolitan city. (B)

**Day 12: Wed, Dec 08** – MELBOURNE – CANBERRA. Fly to Canberra, Australia's capital city. Upon arrival, visit the Australian War Memorial. The evening is yours to explore the city's vibrant dining scene. HOTEL KURRAJONG CANBERRA or Similar (1 Night) (B)

**Day 13: Thur, Dec 09** – CANBERRA – SYDNEY. This morning, visit the Parliament House, where some of Australia's finest architecture and contemporary art are on display. **Day 14: Fri, Dec 10** – SYDNEY. On your morning sightseeing tour, travel to the famous Mrs. Macquarie's Chair in the city's Botanic Gardens. The sandstone rock chair was carved by convicts in 1810 and is said to be where Mrs. Macquaire would sit and watch the ships from Great Britain sail into the harbor. Next, visit the famous Sydney Opera House, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

**Day 15: Sat, Dec 11** – SYDNEY. A full day for you to explore Sydney. Tonight, join your Tour Director and travel companions for a special farewell dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)
