Day 1: Tue, Nov 16 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Wed, Nov 17 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Thur, Nov 18 – BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA. Welcome to Buenos Aires, Argentina, the Paris of South America! Meet your Globus Tour Director at the International Airport. Upon arrival to the hotel, you will take a **walking orientation tour** to get to know the area. Lunch in a typical Argentine restaurant. Leisure time this afternoon. Dinner at your hotel this evening. HOTEL LOI SUITES RECOLETA or Similar (3 Nights) (L, D)

Day 4: Fri, Nov 19 – BUENOS AIRES – EXCURSION TO AN ESTANCIA (ARGENTINE RANCH). In Argentina, ranches dedicated to cattle breeding and to growing grains are called estancias. Today, enjoy a **complete day at an estancia** in the pampas, where Buenos Aires ends and the home of the gauchos (cowboys) begins! This full-day excursion is an ideal opportunity to absorb the atmosphere of rural life and a colorful feast in the heart of the pampas. Lunch includes world-renowned Argentine beef and live **entertainment by gauchos** in their native costumes. After, the **folklore show** will begin with its music and dances. The day will end with **demonstration of typical activities** at an estancia: regional games on horseback such as the carrera de sortijas, where two teams gallop at full tilt under a wooden arch and try to pass a pin through a small ring hanging from the arch. Day 5: Sat, Nov 20 – BUENOS AIRES – EXCURSION TO TIGRE. Leave Buenos Aires and drive to **Tigre**, located about 19 miles from the capital. Pass by the northern suburbs and along Libertador Avenue, where you can see the residential government house in Olivos. Then, stop in **San Isidro** to see the historical center, beautiful square, and the stunning Cathedral. Continue your drive to Tigre, a popular weekend getaway for many porteños (Buenos Aires residents) that boasts many summer homes, as well as yacht and rowing clubs. Take a one-hour boat excursion along the Paraná Delta and its channels, rivers, streams, and numerous islands. Appreciate the lush vegetation with views of Buenos Aires on the horizon. A tango show is a must when you are visiting Buenos Aires. Tonight, you will enjoy dinner followed by a traditional **Argentinian tango show**. You will be enthralled by the professional tango dancers as they perform their sensuous and passionate dances to the Porteno love songs. (B,D)

Day 6: Sun, Nov 21 – BUENOS AIRES – EMBARK MAJESTIC PRINCESS. Visit **La Boca**, a vibrant district and site of the city's first port. Take a short **walking tour** of this unique enclave and then on to **San Telmo**, famous for its late-colonial buildings and a popular gathering spot for artists. At **Plaza de Mayo**, see **La Casa Rosada** (the President's Pink House). Drive past the ornate **Teatro Colón Opera House** before reaching **Recoleta Cemetery**, burial site of Eva Perón. Transfer to the pier to embark the luxurious Majestic Princess. (B, D)

Day 7: Mon, Nov 22 – BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA. Depart at 6:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Tue, Nov 23 – MONTEVIDEO, URUGUAY. 7:00 am – 4:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 21: Mon, Dec 06 – SAN ANTONIO (SANTIAGO), CHILE – DISEMBARK MAJESTIC PRINCESS – EXCURSION TO VALPARAISO AND VIÑA DEL MAR – SANTIAGO. Meet your Globus Tour Director as you disembark the Majestic Princess. Travel north for a full-day excursion to Valparaíso and Viña del Mar. Port cities always have a very special charm, and this is especially true for **Valparaíso**. Like a huge amphitheater, the city is nestled on 42 hills on the wide bay. Your city tour will take you first to **Plaza Sotomayor**, the most important square in the center of Valparaíso with a monument honoring the 1879 Naval Battle of Iquique. You will continue to the southern part of the city to see the famous **old inclined elevators**. 15 of them have been rattling up Valparaíso's hill on black rails since the mid-19th century. Enjoy sights from different viewpoints of the hills and appreciate the colorful art and graffiti on its walls and streets, declared Patrimony of the Humanity by the UNESCO. Then, visit **La Sebastiana**, one of Pablo Neruda's houses that now operates as a museum, to learn more about this poet and Nobel Prize winner, all this with the seacoast always having protagonism. While there, you'll be treated to an impressive views of the harbor and bay. Along the coastal road, you'll make your way to neighboring **Viña del Mar**, the country's most popular seaside resort. The city owes its nickname "Garden City" to its many well-kept parks and private gardens. The town is best known for its casino and floral carpet with a clock motif. Drive through Viña del Mar via the residential district and visit the **Vergara marketplace** and **shopping street**, before traveling to Santiago. Dinner at a local restaurant. Start at **La Moneda** (the official Government Palace) before heading to the **Plaza de Armas**, the main square, with a visit to the 18th century **Santiago Metropolitan Cathedral**. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to explore more of the city on your own. (B)

Day 23: Wed, Dec 08 – SANTIAGO – HONOLULU. Enjoy a guided tour of **Club Hipico Equestrian Club and Racetrack**, with an included lunch. Transfer to the Santiago Airport for the flight home. Depart Santiago. Arrive in Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B, L)
