Day 1: Tue, May 25 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Wed, May 26 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Thur, May 27 – LONDON (SOUTHAMPTON), UNITED KINGDOM – EMBARK MARINA. Welcome to London! Transfer to the pier and embark the Marina. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Fri, May 28 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Sat, May 29 – NEWCASTLE, UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. A delightful blend of ancient and modern, Newcastle is one of the liveliest cities in northern England. Originally built in the 11th century, the Castle Keep was the “new castle” for which the city is named. Stroll along the River Tyne and marvel at the different bridges that have transformed the face of the city. Modern art is the main attraction at the BALTIC Centre for Contemporary Art, while the history of Newcastle unfolds at the Great North Museum. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Sun, May 30 – EDINBURGH (SOUTH QUEENSFERRY), UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Savor the old town’s marvelous Georgian and Victorian architecture and impressive Edinburgh Castle, high on its volcanic crag with a fabulous view. Stroll along the medieval Royal Mile to the Palace of Holyroodhouse to see the abbey and Queen Mary’s chambers. Visit St. Giles’ Cathedral where John Knox once preached. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Mon, May 31 – ABERDEEN, UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 5:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Treasure dazzling Aberdeen, where the handsome granite buildings literally sparkle due to the prominence of mica in the locally quarried stone. As you explore the compact Old Town, admire the ornate spires of the 1837 Marischal College and pause at the 17th century Mercat Cross, which is adorned with ten medallions symbolizing the Stuart monarchs. In marvelous St. Machar’s Cathedral, gaze at the timbered ceiling to appreciate the colorful heraldic symbols and, in fascinating Provost Skene’s House, wander medieval rooms appointed with period pieces. Further afield, numerous fairytale castles dot the landscape, including the British royal family’s exquisite Balmoral Castle. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Tue, Jun 01 – LERWICK (SHETLAND ISLANDS), UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Enjoy a taste of the Highlands here in the rugged landscape and heathered moors, the ruined castles, steep cliffs and sea air. Drive through beautiful valleys and flower-filled meadows with romping Shetland ponies to quaint villages like Scalloway with its ruined castle, or explore the fascinating Jarlshof prehistoric site, occupied for more than 4,000 years. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Wed, Jun 02 – KIRKWALL (ORKNEY ISLANDS), UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. This starkly beautiful island holds many ancient treasures like the enigmatic Standing Stones of Stenness and the 5,000-year-old village of Skara Brae, amazingly discovered with furniture and indoor drains preserved. Visit the imposing trio of St. Magnus Cathedral, the nearby ruins of the Earl’s Palace, and the earlier Bishop’s Palace. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Thur, Jun 03 – STORNOWAY (HEBRIDES), UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 3:00 pm. The unspoiled Outer Hebrides is a world of its own, separated from mainland Scotland by more than water. The language is Gaelic, the attitude heavily self-sufficient and the wildlife uncommon. The capital of the Outer Hebrides, Stornoway is tucked into a beautiful natural harbor on Lewis Island, which the Vikings repeatedly invaded. While renowned as a center for Harris Tweed, Stornoway is also home to the Neo-Gothic Lewis Castle, the An Lanntair arts center, and a multitude of northern birds such as the Arctic skua, golden eagle, and corncrake. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Fri, Jun 04 – BELFAST, IRELAND. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 8:00 pm. Delight in this vibrant city of ornate Victorian and Edwardian architecture, gracious gardens and friendly pubs. Thrill to the natural phenomenon of the Giants’ Causeway, a stunning geological anomaly of tightly packed, uneven basalt columns disappearing into the sea, and the enigmatic ruins of Grey Abbey. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Sat, Jun 05 – DUBLIN (DÚN LAOGHAIRE), IRELAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Considering it’s the birthplace of some of the world’s greatest literary figures – Beckett, Joyce, Shaw, Wilde, Yeats – you can’t help but wonder what it is about Dublin that so inspires. Exploring the city, you find answers. It’s the strong sense of community embodied in its pub culture, in the stunning churches seemingly on every corner, and in the sprawling parks where residents gather to commune with nature. It’s also the history preserved in the ancient books of Trinity College’s Old Library and in the story of Guinness and his iconic beer. Meanwhile, the charming seaside town of Dún Laoghaire possesses its own sense of timeless appeal, from the James Joyce Tower and Museum to the National Maritime Museum of Ireland. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Sun, Jun 06 – CORK (COBH), IRELAND. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Cheerful Cork sprawls about the River Lee in one of Ireland’s most stunning settings. Bridges crisscross the city leading to landmarks like St. Anne’s Church and the Old City Gaol, where you’ll see the 19th century prisoners’ graffiti. Make time to kiss the Blarney Stone in Blarney Castle. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Mon, Jun 07 – FALMOUTH (CORNWALL), UNITED KINGDOM. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Experience the pastoral Cornish countryside on the way to Land’s End, where starkly beautiful moors and cliffs overlook the Atlantic Ocean. Having been a church, a fortress and a private home, the mythical St. Michael’s Mount is a legendary island castle that appears to change moods with the passing clouds. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Tue, Jun 08 – LONDON (SOUTHAMPTON), UNITED KINGDOM – DISEMBARK MARINA – HONOLULU. Arrive 7:00 am. Dismark Marina. Depart London. Return flight to Honolulu. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
