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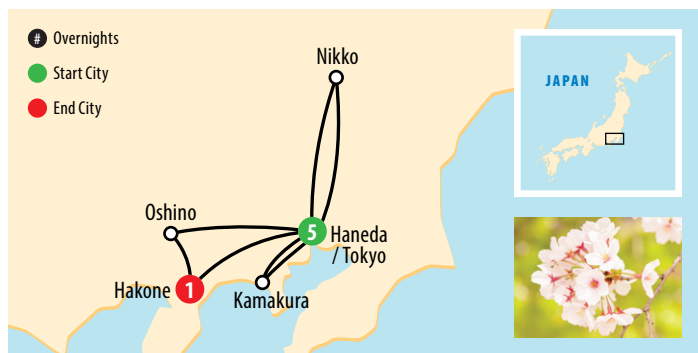
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Day 1: Sat, Mar 27 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 11:55 am.

Day 2: Sun, Mar 28 — HANEDA — TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 3:55 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel. Enjoy a buffet dinner at the hotel. KEIO PLAZA HOTEL TOKYO (5 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Mon, Mar 29 — TOKYO. Begin the day exploring **Meiji Shrine**, a Shinto shrine dedicated to the deified spirits of the Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken. Then, visit the visually stimulating **Harajuku** district, renowned as the center of Japan's youth culture and avant-garde fashion, where you can also find a three-story DAISO. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **sushi making** class, which will yield your delicious lunch. After lunch, head to the Asakusa district, where the charm of old Tokyo still lives on. Its star attraction is **Sensoji**, a beloved 7th century Buddhist temple, also known as Asakusa Kannon Temple. Leading up to the temple is **Nakamise**, a lively shopping street lined with traditional snacks and souvenirs. Next, visit **Ameyoko**, a bustling market street that features over 400 shops and stalls known for offering significant bargains on a wide variety of products. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. The Local Guide will have suggestions on various dining and shopping opportunities nearby. (B, L)

Day 4: Tue, Mar 30 — TOKYO — NIKKO — TOKYO. After a sumptuous buffet breakfast, we head north to Nikko, home to **Toshogu Shrine**, Japan's most lavishly decorated shrine and the mausoleum of Tokugawa Ieyasu. Next, explore the historic theme park **Edo Wonderland Nikko Edomura**, that recreates a 17th century Edo period Japanese village. Explore the beauty, culture, and interesting characters of the Edo period with fun activities and a variety of entertaining performances. Enjoy a BBQ lunch while here. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B, L)

Day 5: Wed, Mar 31 — TOKYO. Full day at leisure. The perfect day to relax and/or visit family and friends in Tokyo! Enjoy shopping and dining in the bustling Shinjuku area where your hotel is located, or venture out on an adventure of your own. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 6: Thur, Apr 01 — TOKYO — KAMAKURA — TOKYO. Our first stop today is the **Kamakura Daibutsu** (The Great Buddha of Kamakura), a large bronze statue of Amida Buddha on the grounds of **Kotokuin Temple**. After lunch at a local restaurant, visit **Tsurugaoka Hachimangu**, Kamakura's most important shrine dedicated to Hachiman, the patron god of samurai. Stop at **Komachi-dori**, the lively street leading to Tsurugaoka Hachimangu, for shopping at boutique fashion stores and souvenir shops. If you get tired, you can hire a rickshaw to take you around. Return to Tokyo for an evening of leisure. (B, L)

Day 7: Fri, Apr 02 — TOKYO — OSHINO — HAKONE. After breakfast, visit **Oshino Hakkai**, eight crystal-clear spring-fed ponds in the Fuji Five Lake region, formed by Mt. Fuji's snowmelt that has filtered through porous lava for decades. Cherished by locals, visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Then, continue on to Hakone, a region largely considered an active volcanic zone since its creation from Mt. Hakone about 3,000 years ago. Upon arrival at your hotel, enjoy some time at leisure before a buffet dinner. Consider taking a rejuvenating soak in the hotel's **onsen hot springs** as you gaze upon the garden and mountains of Hakone or head to the nearby Hakone Kowakien Yunessun, an all-weather onsen amusement park. Tour members can enjoy unlimited visits at no additional cost! Simply pick up your entry wristband at the hotel's front desk, which will grant you unlimited access and priority entry, even during peak times. Upon entry, receive a complimentary face towel, body towel, and lounge wear set (additional towels and lounge wear are an additional cost). 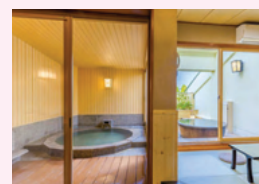
- Open until 6:00 pm on weekdays and 7:00 pm on weekends and holidays. Hours vary by season. Last entry is one hour before closing time.

- Female area exclusives: Cypress bath, collagen bath, and mist sauna that moisturizes skin and hair.

- Open until 8:00 pm daily. Hours vary by season. Reservations are required. Additional fees apply, which varies based on the room type.

Day 8: Sat, Apr 03 — HAKONE — HANEDA — HONOLULU. Before departing Hakone, visit **Owakudani** (Great Boiling Valley), the source of Hakone's onsen hot spring waters. Then, take in the view of the surrounding countryside from the **Hakone Ropeway** and enjoy a **boat ride** on the beautiful **Lake Ashi**. After lunch at a local restaurant, try your hand at **Hakone yosegi-zaiku**, a unique woodwork technique that utilizes the natural colors of the various trees in the area to create beautiful geometric patterns. Depart Hakone and transfer to the airport for the flight home. Depart Haneda International Airport via Japan Airlines flt #72 at 9:55 pm and arrive Honolulu at 10:20 am the same day.
