Day 3: Mon – ZURICH, SWITZERLAND. Welcome to Zurich! After completing arrival formalities meet the transfer to the hotel. Your hotel rooms will not be available until the afternoon. The day is yours to relax after the long flight, before your upcoming cruise adventure. RADISSON BLU ZURICH AIRPORT or Similar (1 Night)
