Day 1: Wed, Nov 24 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Thur, Nov 25 – IN TRANSIT.

Day 3: Fri, Nov 26 – ROME (CIVITAVECCHIA), ITALY – EMBARK OCEANIA ALLURA. Arrive in Rome. Transfer to pier and embark the Allura. Depart 5:00 pm. (D)

Day 4: Sat, Nov 27 – PALERMO (SICILY), ITALY. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Immerse yourself in the glorious history of this ancient city and its magnificent monuments, like the imposing Norman cathedral and the majestic 9th century Arab palace and its breathtaking Palatine Chapel. Admire the marvelous opera house and the artifacts in the archaeological museum. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Sun, Nov 28 – CATANIA, ITALY. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 2:00 pm. Destroyed by an earthquake in the 17th century, Catania has been beautifully restored and offers ancient churches, castles and amphitheatres, lush gardens, and lovely palazzos to explore. Tour the 13th century Ursino Castle, which was situated along the coast until earthquakes and volcanic eruptions transformed the landscape. Drive inland through picturesque villages and explore Villa Romana del Casale, a 4th century villa and UNESCO World Heritage Site containing a complex collection of Roman mosaics considered one of the finest in the Roman world. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Mon, Nov 29 – KATAKOLON, GREECE. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Visit ancient Olympia, where the Olympic Games began in 776 B.C. and stroll around this deserted sanctuary, admiring the temples, altars and treasures, and stand on the ground where ancient athletes practiced before competing. Or enjoy a pleasant drive through the countryside past quaint villages to a local vineyard and sample the wines, local cheeses, and other foods. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Tue, Nov 30 – HERAKLION (CRETE), GREECE. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Visit the great Minoan ruins of the Palace of Knossos, famous as the home of the labyrinth where the Minotaur roamed, and the archaeological museum that houses many superb artifacts from the complex. Explore the stunning, mountain-fringed Lassithi plateau with its orchards, 7,000 windmills, and ancient villages. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Wed, Dec 01 – RHODES, GREECE. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Enjoy a walking tour of the old fortified city and stand in awe of the impressive Grand Master's Palace. See where the Colossus of Rhodes once stood and savor the charm of this remarkable walled town. Or drive along the scenic coast to Lindos. Enjoy the whitewashed little town and climb to the ancient acropolis, its temples, and wonderful views. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Thur, Dec 02 – LIMASSOL, CYPRUS. Arrive 11:00 am. Depart 7:00 pm. Limassol is the jumping off point to explore the ancient riches of Cyprus. See ruins, majestic mountains and scenery,

stunning beaches, and vast groves of lemons, oranges, and olives. Visit Lemesos Castle, where Richard the Lionheart married Berengaria of Navarre, and its fascinating museum. Or stroll through ancient Curium and admire its stunning mosaics, theater, basilica, and panoramic views over the sea. Venture inland to Nicosia and its wonders like the Cathedral of St. John, the Venetian fortifications, a restored old town and mosque, and the Cyprus Museum. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Fri, Dec 03 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Sat, Dec 04 – ALEXANDRIA, EGYPT. Arrive 5:00 am. Overnight in port. One of the greatest cities of antiquity, Alexandria boasts the magnificent new Library of Alexandria as well as the Alexandria National Museum. With an atmosphere that is decidedly more Mediterranean than Egyptian, it is a city of wonderful contrasts. Explore the sights ranging from the beautiful beaches along the bustling waterfront to serene gardens and palaces. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Sun, Dec 05 – ALEXANDRIA, EGYPT. Depart 8:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Mon, Dec 06 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Tue, Dec 07 – EPHEBUS (KUSADASI), TURKEY. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Meander through the ruins of ancient Ephesus and marvel at the famed Library of Celsus, the huge amphitheater, the marble roads with their chariot marks, the amazing mosaic sidewalks and the superb, rarely opened Terrace Houses. Or journey to three monumental cities of antiquity – Priene, Miletus, and Didyma – renowned for their majestic temples and impressive, beautifully preserved stadiums. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Wed, Dec 08 – ATHENS (PIRAEUS), GREECE – DISEMBARK OCEANIA ALLURA – HONOLULU. Arrive 5:00 am. Disembark Allura. Depart Athens. Return flight to Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
