Day 1: Wed, Feb 03 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Hawaiian Airlines flt #851 at 12:15 pm.

Day 2: Thur, Feb 04 — SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA. Arrive in Sydney at 7:45 pm. Welcome to the "Lucky Country" — Australia! Meet you Tour Director at the airport and transfer to the hotel. SWISSOTEL SYDNEY or Similar (3 Nights)

Day 3: Fri, Feb 05 — SYDNEY. On your morning sightseeing tour, travel to the famous Mrs. Macquarie's Chair in the city's Botanic Gardens. The sandstone rock chair was carved by convicts in 1810 and is said to be where Mrs. Macquarie would sit and watch the ships from Great Britain sail into the harbor. Next, visit the famous Sydney Opera House, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy a lunch cruise on Sydney Harbour, featuring a delicious buffet lunch menu prepared onboard and breathtaking views. Cruise past iconic landmarks such as the Opera House, Harbour Bridge, and Fort Denison, while dining in fully air-conditioned comfort. Capture stunning photos from three expansive outer decks as you sail by Sydney's famous attractions. Perfect for a memorable dining experience on the water! After the cruise transfer to China Town for time to explore and find treasures. Balance of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

Day 4: Sat, Feb 06 — SYDNEY — EXCURSION TO BLUE MOUNTAINS. Depart your hotel to commence a full day tour to explore the stunning Blue Mountains National Park, part of the Greater Blue Mountains World Heritage Area, known for its sandstone cliffs, ravines, and eucalypt forests. The first stop is Featherdale Wildlife. See kangaroos, emus, wombats, and koalas. After morning tea, ascend the mountains for breathtaking views of the Jamison Valley and a visit to the remote Eaglehawk Lookout for views and photo opportunities of the famous Three Sisters. Enjoy lunch at the Hydro Majestic, followed by visit to the Scenic Railway, Cableway and Skyway. Return to Sydney for dinner at a local restaurant. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Sun, Feb 07 — SYDNEY — EMBARK RIVIERA. This morning visit the **Rocks Markets**. Transfer to the Sydney pier for embarkation on the Oceania Riviera. Depart 5:00 pm. (B, D)

Day 6: Mon, Feb 08 - AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Tue, Feb 09 – MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Head into the scenic Dandenong Mountains and ride the Puffing Billy steam train through the forest. Meet the koalas, wallabies, and more at a wildlife park or explore local wineries. Take a walk and discover the city's marvelous architecture, chic galleries and boutiques. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Thur, Feb 11 — HOBART (TASMANIA), AUSTRALIA. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Explore quaint, historic towns; see the

exquisite countryside of apple orchards and wineries. Enjoy spectacular views from mountaintop aeries. See wombats, emus and the famed Tasmanian devil at a wildlife park or visit the historic penal colony at Port Arthur. Stroll through Hobart and its lovely botanical garden. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Sun, Feb 14 — CRUISING THE FJORDS OF MILFORD SOUND.

Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 9:00 am.

Day 13: Mon, Feb 15 – DUNEDIN, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 5:00 pm. Discover the rugged, beautiful Otago Peninsula, filled with geological wonders, and gaze in awe at the great albatross with its 10-foot wingspan. Keep an eye out for fur seals and yellow-eyed penguins sunbathing on the rocks. Enjoy the amazing views and the enchanting gardens that surround the historic 19th century Larnach Castle. Splendid Victorian and Edwardian stone buildings are a highlight of a tour of Dunedin. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Tue, Feb 16 – TIMARU, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Explore Caroline Bay, one of the largest manmade harbors and safest beaches in the world. Sailing, waterskiing, windsurfing, fishing, hiking, skiing and even golf make the island an adventurer's paradise. The Edwardian architecture, blue stone buildings, Maori rock art, museums and gardens are perfect for those who enjoy the aesthetics of life. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Wed, Feb 17 — WELLINGTON, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 10:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Stroll past Victorian Gothic buildings, visit the exquisite botanic gardens, take the cable car up the mountain for a fantastic view, or head for the city beach. Journey around the spectacular harbor with its amazing views and visit a sheep or cattle station. See some of the sites where the *Lord of the Rings* trilogy was filmed. (B. L. D)

Day 16: Thur, Feb 18 — NAPIER, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 6:00 pm. Spend time admiring the marvelous Art Deco architecture for which Napier is known. Enjoy the picturesque countryside, tour superb area vineyards and sample the vintages. Visit a huge nesting colony of gannets near the spot where Captain Cook landed. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Fri, Feb 19 — GISBORNE, NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 7:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Named in honor of the crew member on Captain James Cook's ship Endeavour who first sighted land in the area in 1769, this thriving seaside community is wedded to the sea and its vibrant Maori heritage and culture. Often called the "Chardonnay Capital of New Zealand," Gisborne has a splendid array of boutique wineries. For a taste of Gisborne's history and art, the Tairawhiti Museum is an essential destination in this city of warm smiles and even warmer hearts. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Sat, Feb 20 — ROTORUA (TAURANGA), NEW ZEALAND. Arrive 6:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Discover Tauranga's lovely parks and history or head to Rotorua with its fabulous geysers, hot springs and Maori culture. Explore the Rangitaiki River and its amazing scenery. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Sun, Feb 21 — AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND — DISEMBARK RIVIERA — WAITOMO — MATAMATA — ROTORUA. Your Tour Director will greet you upon disembarkation at the Port of Auckland. Depart Auckland and travel through the green pastoral region of Waikato to the famous **Waitomo Glowworm Caves**. Experience a guided tour through the limestone chambers and passages of the cavern. Take a silent boat trip through **Glowworm Grotto** as you glide quietly beneath the lights of thousands of glowworms suspended from the cave ceiling. Next, stop at a picturesque farm near Matamata, which was transformed into the **Hobbiton movie set** of the *Lord of the Rings* films. Continue on to Rotorua for a two night stay. Dinner at a local restaurant. NOVOTEL LAKESIDE ROTORUA (2 Nights) (B, D)

Day 20: Mon, Feb 22 — ROTORUA. This morning visit Te Puia, Rotorua's most prominent thermal area with New Zealand's largest geyser, boiling mud pools, and silica terraces. Next, visit Agrodome to experience New Zealand's sheep industry. There's time to watch a sheep shearing demonstration, visit the farmyard nursery, and see the remarkable farm dogs as they demonstrate their ability to respond to commands and keep the sheep in line. This evening, enjoy a traditional Hangi dinner and concert. (B, D)

Day 21: Tue, Feb 23 — ROTORUA — AUCKLAND. This morning enjoy one of the local **Geothermal Hot Springs**. Lunch at a local restaurant. Continue to Auckland. Tonight, enjoy **360-degree views of Auckland** below as you **dine atop SkyCity at the Orbit Restaurant**. SKYTOWER (2 Night) (B, L, D)

Day 22: Wed, Feb 24 — AUCKLAND. Enjoy a full day of leisure. Your Globus Tour Director will be available to assist you with any help you may need in planning your day. (B)

Day 23: Thur, Feb 25 — AUCKLAND — HONOLULU. Visit the city's oldest park, Auckland Domain. Here experience the War Memorial Museum, as well as the Māori Cultural Center. Enjoy the unique Auckland landscape on magnificent Waitemata Harbour. Soak up the city atmosphere and sights of the iconic Harbour Bridge, Sky Tower, and Mount Eden from the peace of the water. You'll also be served a picnic lunch and a hot drink. At Kelly Tarlton's experience 30 live animal exhibits in spectacular habitat displays, including the world's largest Antarctic penguin colony exhibit and amazing underwater viewing tunnels. Come within inches of huge sharks, rays, and penguins; step way back in time to the age of the dinosaurs at Jurassic Seas; and see a whole host of other incredible marine animals found in the oceans around New Zealand and beyond. Transfer to the Auckland airport for the flight home. Depart via Hawaiian Airlines flt #846 at 11:30 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 9:10 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B, L)
