Day 1: Friday, August 27, 2027 Depart Honolulu - Overnight Flight You're on your way to the Mediterranean coast for a journey connecting the Spanish, French, and Italian Rivieras. From chameleonic Barcelona to sun-kissed Nice, and from the splendor of Provence to the rolling hills of the Tuscan countryside, embark on a coastal journey combining rich scenery, art, culture, food, and wine.

Day 2: Saturday, August 28, 2027 Overnight Flight Continue on your journey to Barcelona

Day 3: Sunday, August 29, 2027 Barcelona, Spain Welcome to the Mediterranean coast. Begin your journey in Barcelona, famed for its exceptional architecture and vibrant culinary scene. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. Tonight, meet your fellow travelers over a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. (D)

Day 4: Monday, August 30, 2027 Barcelona This morning, step into the shoes of a local and navigate the metro. Then, explore the ever-changing Catalan capital as it's meant to be — on foot. Stroll along the bustling *La Rambla* boulevard, famous for its street artists and performers. Wander along the Gothic Quarter's labyrinthine streets and delve into one of Barcelona's lively food markets. Enjoy free time to explore at your own pace, perhaps visiting the iconic Sagrada Família* or the colorful Park Güell.* End your day with a relaxed walking tour through Barcelona's hidden corners, discovering authentic *tapas* and savoring the city's local flavors. (B, D)

Day 5: Tuesday, August 31, 2027 Barcelona - Girona - Costa Brava, Spanish Riviera Set out for Girona, a medieval town known for its atmospheric Old Quarter. On arrival, **it's your choice!** Visit the Museum of Jewish History to uncover the legacy of Girona's Jewish community **-OR-** head uphill through the old town toward Girona Cathedral to explore the Arab Baths, a serene 12th-century bathhouse built in Romanesque style. Enjoy time for lunch on your own in Girona before heading to the Catalanian coast for a 3-night stay at a seaside hotel. Discover the allure of Costa Brava, the perfect place to spend your days relaxing in your sea-view room or exploring secluded coves and beaches. This evening, relax over dinner at your hotel. (B)

Day 6: Wednesday, September 1, 2027 Costa Brava - Figueres - Costa Brava Take in the Spanish coastline during a coastal walk between the charming villages of Calella de Palafrugell and Llafranc. Then, travel inland to the town of Figueres, the

birthplace of Salvador Dalí. Visit the extraordinary Dalí Theatre-Museum; its eccentric exterior topped with giant eggs and golden statues hints at the imaginative world inside. From dreamlike paintings to whimsical installations, explore works of one of the 20th century's most influential artists. Later, return to your hotel for a free evening. (B, D)

Day 7: Thursday, September 2, 2027 Costa Brava Today is yours to enjoy at leisure along the stunning Costa Brava. Relax at your coastal hotel, take a refreshing dip in the Mediterranean, or simply unwind on the beach with the sound of the waves as your backdrop. For those eager to explore further, consider an optional excursion to the enchanting medieval town of Besalú, and experience a taste of the region's rich winemaking heritage. (B)

Day 8: Friday, September 3, 2027 Costa Brava - Aix-en-Provence, France Bid *adiós* to the Spanish Riviera as you cross into southern France and journey into the heart of Provence. Along the way, visit Fontfroide Abbey, founded almost 10 centuries ago. Explore its tumultuous history during a guided visit that concludes with a paired lunch of its locally produced wine. Continue your journey to Aix-en-Provence, a charming town in the heart of the Provençal countryside. Known for its elegant boulevards, lively markets, and artistic heritage, Aix offers a perfect introduction to the region's timeless beauty and relaxed pace of life. (B, L)

Day 9: Saturday, September 4, 2027 Aix-en-Provence - Cassis - Aix-en-Provence Journey to the charming fishing village of Cassis, nestled between the dramatic cliffs of Cap Canaille and the rugged beauty of Calanques National Park. With its colorful waterfront, bobbing boats, and laid-back Mediterranean vibe, Cassis invites you to slow down and soak in its coastal charm. Enjoy a scenic cruise through the Calanques, where towering limestone cliffs and hidden coves create a breathtaking natural landscape. Back in Aix, walk to dinner at a nearby restaurant and savor Provençal cuisine. (B, D)

Day 10: Sunday, September 5, 2027 Aix-en-Provence - Cannes - Nice, French Riviera Travel to glamorous Cannes and soak up its star-studded atmosphere before setting sail across the Bay of Cannes to the serene island of Saint-Honorat.** For over a thousand years, the monks of Lérins Abbey have called this island home. Here, enjoy a tasting of the island's locally produced wine, crafted by the monks themselves. Return to the mainland and continue to Nice for a 2-night stay in the heart of the Côte d'Azur. (B)

Day 11: Monday, September 6, 2027 Nice The day is yours to explore Nice. Perhaps you'll stroll along the lively seafront *Promenade des Anglais* before finding your favorite café and soaking in the local life or venturing up to Castle Hill. Or take an optional journey to St. Paul de Vence, exploring this charming, walled medieval village, and then on towards Grasse, where you'll uncover the art of French perfumery in a hands-on workshop led by a master "nez." No matter how you spend your day, this evening savor a tasting menu highlighting the delights of the South of France. (B, D)

Day 12: Tuesday, September 7, 2027 Nice - Monaco - Arenzano, Italy Bid *au revoir* to France this morning as you head to Monaco, the second smallest country in the world. Witness the changing of the guard at the Prince's Palace and step inside the Cathedral of Monaco, the final resting place of Prince Rainier III and Princess Grace. Then, take time to explore the charm and elegance of this tiny, yet iconic, nation at your own pace. Take in the coastal views as you cross into Italy during an afternoon-long transfer to Arenzano, a picturesque seaside town on the Ligurian Riviera, offering a blend of coastal charm, historic elegance, and lush natural surroundings. Settle into your hotel for a 2-night stay on the Italian Riviera. (B)

Day 13: Wednesday, September 8, 2027 Arenzano - Santa Margherita - Portofino - Arenzano Start your day with a peaceful morning in Arenzano — perhaps take a stroll along the seaside promenade. Then, set off on a picturesque drive to the sophisticated town of Santa Margherita Ligure, situated along the stunning Ligurian Coast. Later this afternoon, board a boat*** to one of the most glamorous spots on the Italian Riviera, Portofino. Take in its colorful harbor, dotted with fishing boats and yachts, set against a backdrop of pastel-colored buildings. (B)

Day 14: Thursday, September 9, 2027 Arenzano - Carrara - Tuscan Countryside Venture beyond the usual tourist routes to discover one of Italy's most impressive natural landmarks: the marble quarries of Carrara. Embark on an off-road journey through the rugged Apuane Mountains, tracing the paths carved out by quarrymen. Carrara marble has long been revered for its beauty and was famously used by Michelangelo for masterpieces such as the *Pietà* in St. Peter's Basilica and the iconic *David*. Your day continues through Tuscany's gentle hills. After tasting some traditional bites paired with olive oil, arrive for a relaxing stay in the Tuscan countryside. (B, D)

Day 15: Friday, September 10, 2027 Tuscan Countryside - Florence - Tuscan Countryside Today is dedicated to Florence, the "Cradle of the Renaissance". Join a local expert for a walking tour through the city's heart. Marvel at Ghiberti's gilded "Gates of Paradise" and Brunelleschi's imposing dome at the Santa Maria del Fiore cathedral complex. Stand before the Palazzo Vecchio, a symbol of the Medici dynasty's power, and end your guided walk in the expansive Piazza Santa Croce. (B)

Day 16: Saturday, September 11, 2027 Tuscan Countryside - San Gimignano - Tuscan Countryside Enjoy a memorable epicurean adventure with a truffle hunt,**** led by a local expert and trained, truffle-sniffing dogs. Set out on foot through rolling hills and silvery olive groves in search of the elusive tuber-shaped fungi

before sampling the results for lunch. Then, spend time in San Gimignano, whose slender medieval towers stand tall over the surrounding vineyards. As the sun begins to set, gather with your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner at your hotel. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Sunday, September 12, 2027 Tuscan Countryside - Tour Ends Say *arrivederci* to Italy as your journey along the Mediterranean coast comes to an end today. (B)

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until July 31, 2026, valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 16 people (maximum of 24).

You should expect large crowds in Barcelona, Portofino, and Florence, which requires a minimum of 2.5 miles of walking over flat, but cobblestone, streets with narrow sidewalks.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

****The truffle hunting activity takes place in the countryside on unpaved paths and in wooded areas. To participate, you must wear comfortable, sturdy walking or hiking shoes. Waterproof shoes are recommended, as mud and puddles are common in the area.

This comprehensive, fast-paced tour takes you through four countries and over 800 miles in under two weeks. You'll change hotels every 2-3 nights and have two longer travel days, with scenic coach rides of about 4-5 hours, plus included experiences. (Costa Brava to Aix-en-Provence: 4.5 hours; Arenzano to the Tuscan Countryside: 5 hours)

Some of the most unique sightseeing requires accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic areas such as Barcelona, Aix-en-Provence, Monaco, Arenzano, Portofino, Florence, and San Gimignano.

***The ferry to Portofino operates on a weather-permitting basis between March and early November. When the weather is uncooperative, you will still visit Portofino, but you will travel there by public bus.

**Saint Honorat Island is only available from April to October. If you travel at a different time of the year, the visit and wine tasting will not be included, but you will spend more time enjoying Cannes and visiting a local museum.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected by the observance of religious or local holidays. In France and Italy, most museums are closed on Mondays or Tuesdays.

*Reservations for major attractions, such as the Sagrada Familia or Parc Güell, are strongly recommended, ideally three months in advance. Even with pre-booked tickets, anticipate long lines and mandatory security checks, which may extend the total time needed to visit these iconic sites.

Dining hours in Spain are much later than in North America and the South Pacific. Restaurants typically serve lunch around 1:00 p.m. and dinner around 8:30 p.m.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

When reserving single accommodations, please be advised that single rooms in Spain, France, and Italy are often smaller in size.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Increasingly strict coach restrictions mean that public transportation, such as the metro, ferry, or tram, may be used. Public transportation can involve waiting in lines and traveling in crowded conditions.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Our air travelers will arrive into Barcelona airport and depart from Florence airport. All departure transfers will depart from your Tuscan countryside hotel to Florence airport.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passport numbers are required in advance. Please provide this information at time of booking.

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.

Here, discover the secrets of perfume-making during a hands-on workshop led by an expert perfumer, affectionately referred to as a "nez" (nose). *Duration: Approximately 9 hours.* Please note a minimum of 4 passengers is required.
