Day 1: Thursday, September 2, 2027 Depart Honolulu Set out to explore Scandinavia by land and experience one of the world's most incredible regions.

Day 2: Friday, September 3, 2027 Overnight Flight Continue your journey to Scandinavia.

Day 3: Saturday, September 4, 2027 Stockholm, Sweden Arrive in the beautiful city of Stockholm. With no scheduled activities during the day, take some time to venture out on your own and get to know this relatively compact city, built on 14 islands and connected by 57 bridges. Tonight, meet your fellow travelers for dinner. (D)

Day 4: Sunday, September 5, 2027 Stockholm Join a local expert to see Stockholm's greatest vistas and attractions, including Gamla Stan (Old Town), Riddarholm Church, the Royal Palace, and the Parliament, on a historic and cultural walking tour. Enjoy a visit inside Stockholm's stunning City Hall, which displays towering brick walls paired with an opulent interior. Explore the Vasa Ship Museum and learn about the vessel's shocking maiden voyage, when it sank in a single nautical mile (the perfectly preserved ship, commissioned in the 1600s by King Vasa, was raised from the bottom of the harbor 334 years later). This afternoon is yours to explore Stockholm independently, from its colorful architecture to its innovative cuisine. (B)

Day 5: Monday, September 6, 2027 Stockholm - Gothenburg Bid farewell to Stockholm and set off by train for a relaxing journey to Gothenburg, Sweden's second largest city. Upon arrival, join your Tour Manager for an orientation walk, and enjoy a private sightseeing tour from the water on board one of the city's sightseeing boats. Hear about the local history and present times as you pass the fish market, old shipyard areas, and docks along the harbor. Enjoy the remainder of the afternoon and evening to explore independently. (B)

Day 6: Tuesday, September 7, 2027 Gothenburg - Copenhagen, Denmark This morning, travel to the cosmopolitan city of Copenhagen and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before joining a local expert for an engaging three-hour walking tour of Denmark's capital city. See Nyhavn, the picturesque harbor lined with colorful façades and charming cafes, as well as Amalienborg Palace, the residence of the Danish Royal Family. Visit the famous Little Mermaid statue, and finish at Tivoli Gardens, the world's second oldest amusement park. (B, L)

Day 7: Wednesday, September 8, 2027 Copenhagen This morning, **it's your choice!** Visit the National Museum of Denmark for an audio-guided visit at your own pace **-OR-** visit the Home of Carlsberg brewery, where an exhibition takes you through the history of the Jacobsen family and how they built their empire around this iconic beer. The afternoon and evening is yours to spend how you wish. (B)

Day 8: Thursday, September 9, 2027 Copenhagen - Aarhus, Denmark Travel from Copenhagen to Aarhus this morning, enjoying a scenic coach and ferry journey across Denmark's coastline before arriving in the country's vibrant second city. Step back in time at Den Gamle By, Aarhus's immersive open-air museum featuring Danish history and daily life through centuries-old streets and buildings. This evening, join your Tour Manager for a relaxed orientation walk to get acquainted with the surrounding area. The evening is yours to enjoy. (B)

Day 9: Friday, September 10, 2027 Aarhus - Oslo, Norway

Today, travel north through Denmark by coach, taking in the changing scenery en route to the coast, where you'll board a ferry to Norway. Enjoy a relaxing midday crossing to Larvik, with time for lunch onboard and views out over the water, before continuing on to Oslo. Arrive in the early evening and transfer to your hotel, with time to settle in after a scenic day of travel across Scandinavia. (B, L)

Day 10: Saturday, September 11, 2027 Oslo This morning, join a local guide for an exploration of Oslo. By coach and on foot, discover the rich heritage of this fascinating city. The afternoon is yours to further explore independently. (B)

Day 11: Sunday, September 12, 2027 Oslo - Flåm Travel north from Norway's capital to the majestic fjord region. Visit Borgund Stave Church, the intricate structure built in dedication to the Apostle Andrew in 1180. Arrive in the quaint village of Flåm, nestled at the entrance to the stunning Aurlandsfjord, and enjoy time to explore at your leisure before settling in for the evening. (B, D)

Day 12: Monday, September 13, 2027 Flåm - Flåm Railway - Loen Embark on the renowned Flåm Railway, one of the world's steepest train rides, and ascend 3,000 feet past mighty waterfalls, towering mountains, and amazing valleys. Journey to the mountain plateau of Myrdal and cascade down to the fjord of Flåm, taking in the breathtaking views each way. Continue on to the village of Loen, for a relaxing stay in the heart for Norway's fjord region. (B, D)

Day 13: Tuesday, September 14, 2027 Loen - Fjord Cruise - Loen

An enchanting day in Norway's fjord region begins. In Geiranger, a UNESCO World Heritage site, embark on an exhilarating Geirangerfjord cruise, soaking in some of Norway's most beautiful scenery along the way. One of the most famous fjords in the world, Geirangerfjord is where you'll find Norway's mightiest waterfalls: the Seven Sisters, the Bridal Veil, and the Suitor. Marvel at homesteads along the steep sides of the mountains, where farms have been kept for centuries. The day's relaxed pace offers the opportunity to soak up the nature and stunning scenery of the region. (B, D)

Day 14: Wednesday, September 15, 2027 Loen - Bergen Be inspired by Norway's most impressive landscapes en route to Bergen – the gateway to the fjords. A visit to the Sunnfjord Folk Museum tells the story of local enterprise and community spirit. Founded with Viking roots, the Bergen of today is known for its old-world charm and scenic landscapes. (B)

Day 15: Thursday, September 16, 2027 Bergen Join a guided walking tour of Bergen and stroll along the historic and iconic harbor front, known as the Bryggen (UNESCO). Enjoy the afternoon at leisure before reuniting with your fellow travelers for an atmospheric farewell dinner in the historic Bryggen neighborhood. (B, D)

Day 16: Friday, September 17, 2027 Bergen - Tour Ends Depart for home today with incredible memories of your Scandinavian journey. (B)

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until September 30, 2026 , valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

There are numerous long touring days, with 8 hours of touring, excluding dinners.

Some of the older properties and attractions in Scandinavia may not have elevators.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Museums may close unexpectedly or for the observance of holidays.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability. Triple accommodations are not available.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.
