Day 1: Wednesday, September 8, 2027 Depart Honolulu -

Overnight Flight It's time to live the good life and embark on a getaway to the fabulous French Riviera, or *Côte d'Azur*. Its elegant coastal resorts, superb eateries, chic boutiques, and captivating museums make it the ultimate sunny retreat for the elite. Unpack your bags just once and stay at a single hotel for your entire adventure, which begins with an overnight flight to France.

Day 2: Thursday, September 9, 2027 Overnight Flight Continue your journey to France.

Day 3: Friday, September 10, 2027 Nice (French Riviera), France

Your tour commences in the stunning city of Nice, a coastal pearl of the Mediterranean known for its legendary opulence and balmy beaches. With an average of 300 sunny days per year, Nice is a seaside paradise. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner in *Vieux Nice* featuring Mediterranean-inspired French cuisine. (D)

Day 4: Saturday, September 11, 2027 Nice Start your day immersed in French art with a visit to the Matisse Museum,* housed in a 17th-century Genoese villa surrounded by olive groves. This museum offers an extraordinary journey through the life and work of Henri Matisse, one of the 20th century's most influential artists. Later, discover Nice by meandering through the city's famed and colorful flower market. Delve into the Old Town, sampling local delicacies while on a tasting tour. The rest of the day is yours. Perhaps you'll return to your hotel and stroll along the lively seafront *Promenade des Anglais* — maybe you'll find your favorite café for the week and soak in the local life. (B, L)

Day 5: Sunday, September 12, 2027 Nice - Monaco - Monte Carlo

- Nice Upon arrival, enjoy a walking tour led by your expert Tour Manager through the charming streets of Monaco-Ville, the old town, lined with pastel-colored houses, quaint cafés, and boutiques. Learn about Monaco's rich history and royal traditions as you make your way to the Prince's Palace, the official residence of the Sovereign Prince. Here, witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard, a time-honored ritual that reflects the principality's heritage and elegance. Then, **it's your choice!** Embark on an audio-guided tour of the majestic Prince's Palace of Monaco, a grand residence steeped in history **-OR-** dive into the wonders of the Oceanographic Museum where you can explore its captivating aquarium and marvel at the fascinating collection of fossils and skeletons curated by the legendary Jacques Cousteau. Next, make your way to Monte Carlo for a quick stop to soak in breathtaking views and admire the iconic, world-famous casino. (B)

Day 6: Monday, September 13, 2027 Nice - Èze - Menton - Nice

Begin your morning in the medieval village of Èze, a quintessential Provençal hilltop town. Immerse yourself in the art of perfume-making with a hands-on workshop, where exquisite fragrances have been crafted since the 18th century. Then, wander the village's timeless cobblestone streets and visit the stunning Exotic Garden of Èze, perched high above the sea with extraordinary panoramic views. Continue your journey to Menton, a charming town celebrated for its pastel-hued façades and serene ambiance. Famous for its citrus groves and artisanal jams, Menton beautifully blends French and Italian influences. (B, D)

Day 7: Tuesday, September 14, 2027 Nice - Cannes - Ile Saint-Honorat - Nice

Journey to Cannes and sail** across the Bay of Cannes to the tiny island of Saint-Honorat, belonging to the monks of Lérins Abbey. Pause to taste the locally produced wine before returning to Cannes to perhaps rub elbows with Europe's elite. Walk in the footsteps of celebrities when you see the Film Festival Palace and the iconic red carpet featured during the Cannes Film Festival. During free time, explore the cobblestone lanes of the *Le Suquet* neighborhood or the Museum of World Exploration. (B, D)

Day 8: Wednesday, September 15, 2027 Nice - Free Day or Optional Excursion to Italy The day is yours! Enjoy your free time relaxing and taking in the laid-back atmosphere along the Riviera. Perhaps you'll join an optional excursion to Dolceacqua, a gem of the Italian Riviera nestled in the mountains, before savoring the local cuisine during an included light lunch. (B)

Day 9: Thursday, September 16, 2027 Nice - St. Paul de Vence - Nice This morning, venture to historic St. Paul de Vence, situated atop a hill overlooking the beautiful countryside of Provence. Explore this walled medieval village, soaking in its distinctive light, said to have inspired Matisse, Braque, Chagall, and other artists. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner celebrating the end of an unforgettable trip. (B, D)

Day 10: Friday, September 17, 2027 Nice (French Riviera) - Paris Head to the airport for your flight to the French capital. In under two hours, you'll be in Paris, the "City of Light." Depending on your arrival time, you may get a chance to explore your hotel's neighborhood with your Tour Manager and learn how to use the city's famed underground transport system, *Le Métro*, like a local. You might even end your walk soaking in the breathtaking views from the emblematic Arc de Triomphe. Ease into the rhythm of Paris as you explore nearby streets and settle in for an evening at leisure. (B)

Day 11: Saturday, September 18, 2027 Paris This morning, join your local expert and head back to *Le Métro* to get to the hip neighborhood of Montmartre. Blending artistic roots and quirky modernity, the 18th *arrondissement* is home to classical painters and cultural provocateurs. Later, head to the historic Latin Quarter, where you'll have free time to wander near the iconic Notre-Dame Cathedral and soak in the charm of one of Paris's most renowned districts. Your day continues with a visit to an interactive cheese museum, where you'll delve into French cheesemaking traditions. Take advantage of free time this

afternoon to explore on your own. Perhaps you'll browse the shops of the *Opéra* district or take a stroll down the Champs-Élysées. Spend your evening at leisure or join an optional dinner at the Paradis Latin* for a can-can kicking, music-driven night at the cabaret. (B)

Day 12: Sunday, September 19, 2027 Paris This morning, begin with a visit to the Suresnes American Cemetery and Memorial, a solemn site honoring more than 1500 American servicemen and women who gave their lives in both World Wars. After this poignant experience, continue to unwind along the Seine before enjoying the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. You may choose to ascend the iconic Eiffel Tower** or visit the Louvre** to admire world-renowned masterpieces such as the *Mona Lisa*. Prefer a slower pace? Settle into a charming Parisian café and watch the city drift by as you soak in *la vie parisienne*. However you decide to spend your afternoon, conclude the day by raising a glass in celebration as you toast the end of your unforgettable tour. (B)

Day 13: Monday, September 20, 2027 Paris - Extension Ends Say *au revoir* to Paris as your extension comes to an end. (B)

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until July 31, 2026 , valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 4. This means you can handle longer walking tours (more than 90 minutes), traversing dusty or uneven terrain, standing for periods of time, varying altitudes and temperatures, and don't mind being on the go with some early starts, late-night experiences, and full days. Unfortunately, this level is not appropriate for individuals who use wheelchairs or walkers.

Some of the most unique sightseeing can mean accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic areas such as the Old Town of Nice, Monaco, Saint-Honorat Island, Eze, and St. Paul de Vence. If you require a walker or wheelchair, or have difficulty walking, you may not be

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able to access some of these areas and may want to consider an alternate tour with us. Our Client Care Agents can provide additional information or assistance to help you determine the perfect trip for you.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Your visits to Monaco and St. Paul de Vence village involve negotiating some steep inclines over cobblestones, gravel, or multiple flights of steps.

*In the unlikely event that the Matisse Museum is unavailable, the visit will be substituted with the Chagall Museum or another alternative.

**The Saint-Honorat Island cruise operates weather permitting, depending on sea conditions, and if not available, it will be replaced by Le Musée des Explorations du Monde in Cannes.

*Paradis Latin may be considered unsuitable for children - consult your Tour Manager.

**Reservations for major attractions such as the Eiffel Tower, the Louvre Museum, and the Musée d'Orsay are strongly recommended, ideally three months in advance. Even with pre-booked tickets, please anticipate long lines and mandatory security checks, which may extend the total time needed to visit these iconic sites.

Breakfast is not provided on the last morning for travelers leaving before the hotel breakfast room opens.

Due to fair periods in Paris, the rate of this extension may be higher on certain dates. Please inquire about rates and availability at time of booking.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.



IMPORTANT: We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Collette will provide all necessary information, updates, and supporting documents for your travel requirements, including visa and Electronic Travel Authorizations (ETAs), if required, approximately 60-90 days prior to your departure.
