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Day 1: Sun, Mar 14 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 12:05 pm.

Day 2: Mon, Mar 15 — HANEDA — TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 4:05 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Maihama. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner at the hotel. GRAND NIKKO TOKYO BAY MAIHAMA (3 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Tue, Mar 16 — TOKYO DISNEYLAND. After a sumptuous Japanese/Western buffet breakfast, enjoy a full day at **Tokyo Disneyland!** Group members will transfer to the resort together. Group members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort line. (B)

Day 4: Wed, Mar 17 — TOKYO DISNEYSEA. After breakfast, transfer to **Tokyo DisneySea** for a full day of fun and wonder. A unique park that's only found in Japan, Tokyo DisneySea was inspired by the myths and legends of the sea. Group members will transfer to the resort together. Group members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort Line. (B)

*Baggage will be sent from the Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama to the Sunshine City Prince Hotel, skipping Hakone. Prepare an overnight bag for one night.

Day 5: Thur, Mar 18 — TOKYO — OSHINO — HAKONE. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Hakone. En route, visit **Oshino Hakkai**, a set of eight ponds located in the Fuji Five Lake Region. The ponds are fed by snowmelt from Mt. Fuji that has filtered through porous lava for 80 years, creating crystal-clear spring water cherished by locals. Visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source. Enjoy lunch here (on your own). Upon arrival at your hotel in Hakone, enjoy some time at leisure before a buffet dinner. Consider taking a rejuvenating soak in the hotel's **onsen hot springs** as you gaze upon the garden and mountains of Hakone or head to the nearby Hakone Kowakien Yunessun, an all-weather onsen amusement park. Tour members can enjoy unlimited visits at no additional cost! Simply pick up your entry wristband at the hotel's front desk, which will grant you unlimited access and priority entry, even during peak times. Upon entry, receive a complimentary face towel, body towel, and lounge wear set (additional towels and lounge wear are an additional cost). You can enjoy food and beverages at Yunessun (at your own expense). HAKONE HOTEL KOWAKIEN (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 6: Fri, Mar 19 — HAKONE — TOKYO. After breakfast, begin the day with a visit to **Owakudani** (Great Boiling Valley), the source of Hakone's onsen hot spring waters. View the surrounding countryside from the **Hakone Ropeway**. Then, take a **boat ride** on the beautiful **Lake Ashi**. After lunch at a local restaurant, try your hand at **Hakone yosegi-zaiku**, a unique woodwork technique that utilizes the natural colors of the various trees in the area to create beautiful geometric patterns. A great souvenir of this trip! Depart Hakone for Tokyo. Upon arrival in Tokyo, explore **teamLab Borderless: MORI Building DIGITAL ART MUSEUM**, a world of artworks without boundaries. Artworks move across rooms and at times intermingle, creating one continuous world without boundaries in this immersive experience. Transfer to the Sunshine City Prince Hotel for an evening of leisure. The hotel is directly connected to Sunshine City, which offers a variety of shopping, dining, and entertainment opportunities, such as the Sunshine Aquarium and Bandai Namco Cross Store Tokyo. There is also a FamilyMart conveniently located on the first floor of the hotel (open 24 hours), perfect for those late night egg-sando (egg sandwich), fried chicken, and musubi cravings. Day 7: Sat, Mar 20 — TOKYO. After breakfast, start the day at the **Warner Bros. Studio Tour Tokyo — The Making of Harry Potter**. Walk in the footsteps of Harry Potter and explore the

Yunessun Area (Swimwear Area)

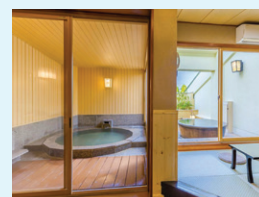
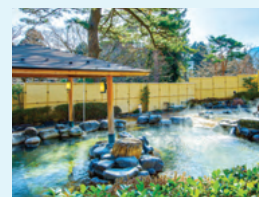
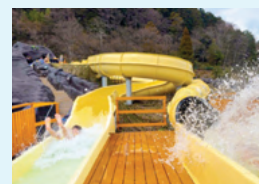
- Open until 6:00 pm on weekdays and 7:00 pm on weekends and holidays. Hours vary by season. Last entry is one hour before closing time.
- Tattoos are allowed as long as they are completely covered by a rash guard, tattoo cover seals, or similar.
- Experience the thrill of the exciting water slide and splash in the waterfall. Enjoy various themed pools — such as a coffee bath and wine bath — in the large domed area, or simply relax in the 40 meter outdoor onsen hot spring surrounded by nature and soak up the beautiful scenery.

Mori no Yu Area (No Clothing Area)

- Open until 8:00 pm daily. Hours vary by season. Last entry is 30 minutes before closing time.
- Tattoos are allowed as long as they are completely covered by two of the designated tattoo cover seals that are available for purchase at the facility.
- Soak up the traditional atmosphere of an onsen hot spring bath — both male and female areas feature open-air baths with picturesque views, indoor baths, jacuzzis, lie down baths, and Shigaraki stoneware pottery baths. Lounges and a massage salon are also available.
 - Male area exclusives: Waterfall shoulder massage and dry sauna that invokes heavy sweating.
 - Female area exclusives: Cypress bath, collagen bath, and mist sauna that moisturizes skin and hair.

Reserved Private Room with Baths

- Open until 8:00 pm daily. Hours vary by season. Reservations are required. Additional fees apply, which varies based on the room type.

- Relish quality time along with your family and/or friends in one of the eight private baths that features a spacious room and open-air bath.



wonders of the wizarding world. Explore the sets for Platform 9 ¾, Diagon Alley, The Great Hall, The Ministry of Magic, and the Forbidden Forest. Learn about the creature effects, costumes, SFX, VFX, and props that brought the books to life. In the afternoon, enjoy sweeping views of the city from **Tokyo Skytree**, the tallest tower in Tokyo at just over 2,000 feet. From the Tembo Deck, soaring 350 meters above the ground, you'll be treated to a 360° panoramic view of Tokyo. Next, spend some free time at **TOKYO Solamachi**, a large shopping, dining, and entertainment complex at the base of the Tokyo Skytree that houses over 300 diverse stores, including a Pokémon Center and DAISO. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 8: Sun, Mar 21 — TOKYO — HANEDA — HONOLULU. After breakfast, depart the hotel for the last day of touring. First, visit **Meiji Shrine**, the Shinto shrine dedicated to the deified spirits of the Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken. Next, tour the visually stimulating **Harajuku** district, internationally renowned as the epicenter of youth culture and street fashion. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **sushi making** class, which will yield your delicious lunch. Then, visit **Ameyoko**, a bustling market street that features over 400 shops and stalls known for offering significant bargains on various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, dried seafood, spices, and more. Transfer to the Haneda International Airport for the return flight home. Depart Haneda via Japan Airlines flt #74 at 9:00 pm and in Honolulu at 9:00 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B, L)
