OVERVIEW: The Tokaido (Eastern Sea Road) was the most important of the Five Routes of the Edo period. It connected Kyoto to Edo (modern-day Tokyo), traveling along the sea coast of eastern Honshu (the largest of Japan's four main islands), hence the route's name.

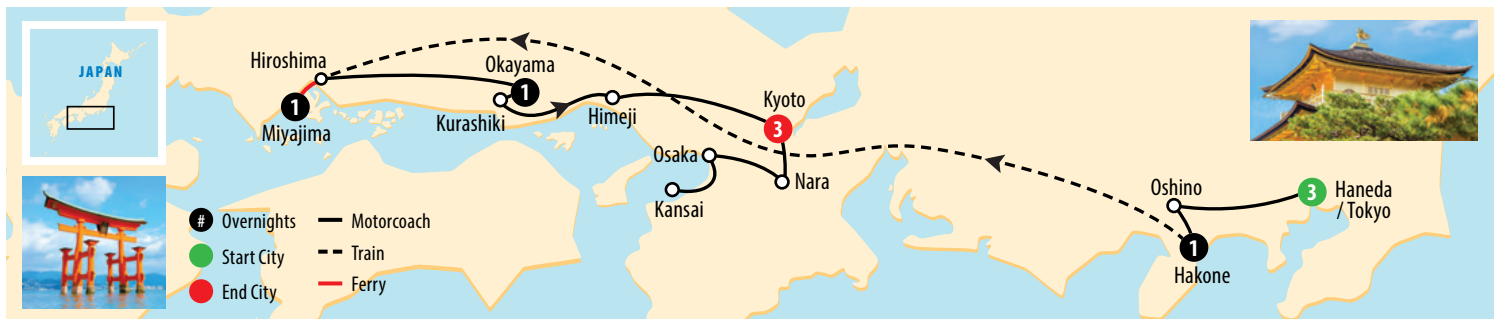

Day 1: Mon, Mar 15 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 12:05 pm.

Day 2: Tue, Mar 16 – HANEDA – TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 4:05 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Tokyo. The evening is at your leisure to explore the area around the hotel, which is filled with various dining and shopping opportunities. KEIO PLAZA HOTEL TOKYO (3 Nights)

Day 3: Wed, Mar 17 – TOKYO. Begin the day exploring the Asakusa district, where the charm of old Tokyo still lives on. Its star attraction is **Sensoji**, a beloved 7th century Buddhist temple, also known as Asakusa Kannon Temple. Leading up to the temple is **Nakamise**, a lively shopping street lined with traditional snacks and souvenirs. Next, visit **Ameyoko**, a bustling market street that features over 400 shops and stalls known for offering significant bargains on various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, dried seafood, spices, and more. Today's highlight is a hands-on **sushi making** class, which will yield your delicious lunch. Then, explore **teamLab Borderless: MORI Building DIGITAL ART MUSEUM**, a world of artworks without boundaries. Artworks move across rooms and at times intermingle, creating one continuous world without boundaries in this immersive experience. Return to the hotel for a buffet dinner. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Thur, Mar 18 – TOKYO. Full day at leisure. The perfect day to relax and/or visit family and friends in Tokyo! Enjoy shopping and dining in the bustling Shinjuku area where your hotel is located, or venture out on an adventure of your own. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 5: Fri, Mar 19 – TOKYO – OSHINO – HAKONE. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Hakone. En route, visit **Oshino Hakkai**, a eight spring-fed ponds in the Fuji Five Lake region. For decades, Mt. Fuji's snowmelt has filtered through porous lava to create crystal-clear water cherished by locals, and visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Continue on to Hakone, a region largely considered an active volcanic zone since its creation from Mt. Hakone about 3,000 years ago. Visit **Owakudani** (Great Boiling Valley), the source of Hakone's onsen hot spring waters. Then, view the surrounding countryside from the **Hakone Ropeway**. Finally, enjoy a **boat ride** on the beautiful **Lake Ashi**, before transferring to the hotel for a buffet dinner. Be sure to have a relaxing soak in the **onsen hot springs**, which are divided for men and women, can be enjoyed indoors or outdoors. The high-quality service and facilities are sure to become some of your fondest memories of your visit to Japan. HAKONE KOWAKIEN HOTEL (1 Night) (B, L, D)

*Baggage will be sent from Hakone to Okayama, skipping Miyajima. Prepare an overnight bag for one night.

Day 6: Sat, Mar 20 – HAKONE – HIROSHIMA – MIYAJIMA. After breakfast, transfer to Odawara Train Station, where you will have the chance to purchase an ekiben (a type of bento boxed meal sold at train stations) to eat onboard the Shinkansen Bullet Train ride to Hiroshima. Transfer to Miyajima-guchi Station by motorcoach. Take a short ferry ride to the island of Miyajima, which is considered sacred by many. Walk through the small town to the hotel. This evening, soak in the relaxing atmosphere of the **onsen hot spring baths**. For dinner, enjoy a traditional, multi-course **Kaiseki Dinner** featuring Hiroshima's local and seasonal ingredients including fresh seafood from the Seto Inland Sea. IWASO INN (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 7: Sun, Mar 21 – MIYAJIMA – HIROSHIMA – OKAYAMA. After breakfast, begin the morning exploring **Itsukushima Shrine**. At high tide, the vermilion torii gate looks like it's floating in the middle of the sea. The shrine complex is designated as one of Japan's Three Most Scenic Places. Take the ferry back to Hiroshima. After lunch, visit the **Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park**, **Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum**, **Atomic Bomb Dome**, and **Children's Memorial**. Upon arrival in

Okayama, enjoy an evening of shopping and dining (on your own) at the **AEON MALL Okayama**. HOTEL GRANVIA OKAYAMA (1 Night) (B, L)

Day 8: Mon, Mar 22 – OKAYAMA – KURASHIKI – HIMEJI – KYOTO. After breakfast, transfer to **Kurashiki** and begin exploring it's beautiful **Bikan area**. In merchant days, this scenic town thrived as a port for rice shipments. Several old rice granaries and examples of historic architecture still remain in addition to the stone lined canal. Upon arrival in Himeji, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before visiting **Himeji Castle**, the largest and most visited castle in Japan. A short walk from the castle's main gate is **Koko-en Garden**. This Japanese-style garden consists of nine separate walled gardens designed in various styles of the Edo period, such as a pond with a waterfall, a tea garden, a pine tree garden, a bamboo garden, and a flower garden. Upon arrival in Kyoto, enjoy a buffet dinner at the hotel. DOUBLETREE BY HILTON KYOTO STATION (3 Nights) (B, L, D)

Day 9: Tue, Mar 23 – KYOTO. After breakfast, experience a **Japanese tea ceremony**. Then, enjoy a visit to the iconic **Kinkakuji (Temple of the Golden Pavilion)**, a Zen temple whose top two floors are completely covered in gold leaf. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Today's hands-on experience is **yuzen dyeing**, one of Kyoto's traditional craft techniques. Since patterns are dyed by placing a stencil over a piece of fabric, such as a tote bag, you can make an authentic piece, even if this is your first time. A great souvenir of this tour! Lastly, explore the **Heian Jingu**, which has a relatively short history, dating back just over a hundred years. The shrine is dedicated to the spirits of the first and last emperors who ruled the city, Emperor Kammu and Emperor Komei. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. The Local Guide will have suggestions for nearby dining and shopping opportunities. (B, L)

Day 10: Wed, Mar 24 – KYOTO. Full day at leisure. A perfect day to fulfill your shopping list! Your hotel is just a five-minute walk from the JR Kyoto Station, which is packed with shopping and dining options. There are also numerous shops and restaurants nearby. Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 11: Thur, Mar 25 – KYOTO – NARA – OSAKA – KANSAI – HONOLULU. Start the day at **Sanjusangendo**, a Buddhist temple famous for its 1,001 statues of Kannon, the goddess of compassion. After lunch at a local restaurant, visit **Todaiji**, the largest wooden building in Japan, which houses a 16.3-meter-high bronze statue of Buddha, the largest in the country. Then, visit the surrounding **Nara Deer Park**, which is inhabited by over 1,000 deer. Finally, enjoy some free time at an **AEON MALL**, before departing for the Kansai International Airport and checking in for the flight home. Depart Kansai via Japan Airlines flt #790 at 10:10 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 10:25 am on the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B, L)
