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Day 1: Thur, Jun 17 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 12:45 pm.

Day 2: Fri, Jun 18 – HANEDA. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 3:55 pm. After entry formalities, walk to your hotel connected to the airport terminal and enjoy a buffet dinner there. HOTEL VILLA FONTAINE GRAND HANEDA AIRPORT (1 Night) (D)

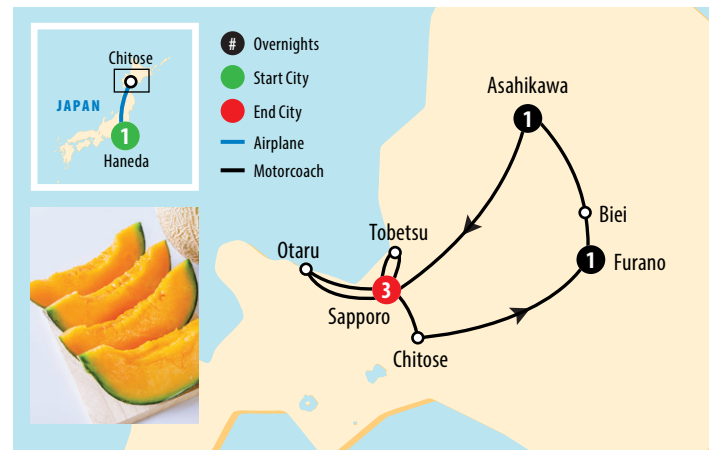
Day 3: Sat, Jun 19 – HANEDA – CHITOSE – FURANO. After a breakfast buffet at your hotel, transfer back to the airport. Enjoy a bento box lunch at the domestic departure gate. Depart Haneda Domestic Airport via Japan Airlines flt #513 at 11:25 am and arrive at the Chitose Domestic Airport at 1:05 pm. Depart the airport for the hotel in Furano. En route, enjoy an **all-you-can-eat** session of **melons**! Continue to your hotel for dinner, and don't forget to unwind in the hotel's **onsen hot springs**. SHIN FURANO PRINCE HOTEL (1 Night) (B, L, D)

Day 4: Sun, Jun 20 – FURANO – BIEI – ASAHIKAWA. Begin the day **making ice cream**, a refreshing treat on a hot summer day! Then, visit **Farm Tomita**, Japan's most famous lavender farm and one of the best places to enjoy seasonal flowers in bloom. After lunch at a local restaurant, continue to the renowned **Blue Pond**, famed for its shifting turquoise and cobalt waters and surreal submerged trees, followed by the nearby **Shirahige Falls**, a rare subaqueous waterfall where water seeps through rock layers before plunging into the river. Finally, drive by **Roller Coaster Road**, also known as Jet Coaster Road, a scenic route known for its dramatic elevation changes and sweeping views of the Tokachi mountain range and surrounding countryside. Tonight, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. JR INN ASAHIKAWA (1 Night) (B, L, D)

Day 5: Mon, Jun 21 – ASAHIKAWA – SAPPORO – TOBETSU – SAPPORO. After a sumptuous breakfast buffet, stop by the **Sunagawa Highway Oasis**, a shopper's paradise offering a variety of food and souvenirs. For lunch, we head to Kitano Gourmet Tei, where you will **pick out "LIVE" crabs** from the tanks to enjoy along with a special kaisendon (fresh seafood over rice). Afterwards, visit **ROYCE' CACAO AND CHOCOLATE TOWN** to learn how the famous ROYCE' treats are made and receive a complimentary sample at the end of the museum tour. Upon arrival in Sapporo, take a **brief orientation tour of the city**, which will include the Sapporo TV Tower, Sapporo Clock Tower, Red Brick Office (Former Hokkaido Government Office Building), and Odori Park. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before arriving at the hotel. KEIO PLAZA HOTEL SAPPORO (3 Nights) (B, L, D)

Day 6: Tue, Jun 22 – SAPPORO – OTARU – SAPPORO. Start the day **picking fruit** at the peak of ripeness, a sweet treat to enjoy before lunch at a local restaurant. After, travel to Otaru, once a major trade and fishing port, and stroll along the charming **Otaru Canal**, explore the **Music Box**



Museum, and visit the **Kitaichi Glass Company**, where beautiful glass creations are sure to delight. Non-drip or color changing shoyu bottles are a favorite omiyage gift to bring home from Otaru. Then, visit the **Tanaka Sake Brewery** to learn how sake is made. Return to the hotel in Sapporo, where the remainder of the day is at your leisure. (B, L)

Day 7: Wed, Jun 23 – SAPPORO. Full day at leisure. The perfect day to fulfill your shopping list or explore more of Hokkaido on your own. The hotel is approximately a five-minute walk from JR Sapporo Station and close to other stations and department stores. Looking for more shopping opportunities? MEGA Don Quijote Sapporo Tanukikoji Honten, open 24 hours, is a short walk from your hotel, and is located in the Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade, the city's largest and oldest covered shopping street, with more than 200 shops! Your Local Guide will be available to assist as needed. (B)

Day 8: Thur, Jun 24 – SAPPORO – CHITOSE – HANEDA – HONOLULU. After breakfast, make a stop at an **AEON MALL**, with leisure time for shopping and lunch (on your own). Upon arrival at Chitose Airport, explore the **shopping mall located within the Domestic Terminal**, where four floors of restaurants, shops, and attractions offer something for everyone. Those with a sweet tooth will enjoy the Sweets Zone, where you can enjoy Hokkaido sweets in a spacious and relaxing setting, and the ROYCE' Chocolate World (factory, museum, shop, and bakery) and LeTAO Chocolatier. The kids (and those young at heart) will enjoy the Doraemon Sky Park and Hello Kitty Happy Flight, which have an activity area, shop, and café (fees may apply) or the Pokémon store. There are also more than two dozen shops at the airport that specialize in various fresh, frozen or dried seafood that can be eaten there or packed for you to bring home. Or you can relax in the airport onsen or movie theater (for a fee). Depart Chitose via Japan Airlines flt #518 at 5:00 pm and arrive at Haneda Domestic Airport at 6:45 pm. Depart Haneda International Airport via Japan Airlines flt #72 at 9:55 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 10:35 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
