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Day 1: Tue, Jun 08 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Japan Airlines flt #73 at 12:45 pm.

Day 2: Wed, Jun 09 – HANEDA – TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 3:55 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel. Enjoy a buffet dinner at the hotel. GRAND NIKKO TOKYO BAY MAIHAMA (3 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Thur, Jun 10 – TOKYO DISNEYLAND. After a sumptuous Japanese/Western buffet breakfast, enjoy a full day at **Tokyo Disneyland!** Tour members will transfer to the resort together. Tour members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort line. (B)

Day 4: Fri, Jun 11 – TOKYO DISNEYSEA. After breakfast, transfer to **Tokyo DisneySea** for a full day of fun and wonder. A unique park that's only found in Japan, Tokyo DisneySea was inspired by the myths and legends of the sea. Tour members will transfer to the resort together. Tour members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort Line. (B)

*Baggage will be sent from Tokyo to Osaka, skipping Hakone. Prepare an overnight bag for one night.

Day 5: Sat, Jun 12 – TOKYO – OSHINO – HAKONE. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Hakone. En route, stop at a local restaurant for lunch. After, make a stop at **Oshino Hakkai**, a set of eight ponds located in the Fuji Five Lake Region. The ponds are fed by snowmelt from Mt. Fuji that has filtered through porous lava for 80 years, creating crystal-clear spring water cherished by locals. Visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source! Continue on to Hakone, a region largely considered an active volcanic zone since its creation from Mt. Hakone about 3,000 years ago. Enjoy a **boat ride** on the beautiful **Lake Ashi**. Transfer to the hotel for a buffet dinner. Don't miss out on the chance to soak in the hotel's **onsen hot springs** tonight! The onsens, which are divided for men and women, can be enjoyed indoors or outdoors. The high-quality service and facilities are sure to become some of your fondest memories of your visit to Japan. HAKONE KOWAKIEN HOTEL (1 Night) (B, L, D)

Day 6: Sun, Jun 13 – HAKONE – KYOTO – OSAKA. After breakfast, board your waiting coach and travel the Odawara Station. Pick up a bento to enjoy for lunch onboard the train. Depart via a shinkansen bullet train to Kyoto. Upon arrival in Kyoto, transfer to the **Uzumasa Kyoto Village** (also known as Kyoto Studio Park). It is Japan's first and only movie theme park that allows visitors to freely explore the actual filming sets of jidaigeki (period drama) films and tv dramas that are set during the Edo period. The park has recently undergone renewal to offer a historically immersive experience, centered on the concept of "Losing Yourself in Kyoto of the Edo Era." While here, you'll have the chance to **paint your own fox mask**. The fox mask represents the mythical kitsune (fox spirit), a symbol of intelligence, cunningness, wisdom, and transformation. Rooted in Shinto tradition as messengers of the deity Inari, these masks denote protection against evil, prosperity, and the duality of fox spirits as either mischievous tricksters or benevolent guardians. Traditional masks feature red, black, and gold markings on a white mask. The white represents purity and divinity, while the red markings – usually placed around the eyes and ears – are meant to protect against demons. Don't stick to the traditional colors and let your imagination run wild! Next, visit the famous **Kinkakuji (Temple of the Golden Pavilion)**, a Zen Temple whose top two floors are completely covered in gold leaf. Continue to the hotel in Osaka. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure. The Local Guide will have suggestions for nearby dining and shopping opportunities. THE PARK FRONT HOTEL AT UNIVERSAL STUDIOS JAPAN (2 Nights) (B, L)

Day 7: Mon, Jun 14 – OSAKA. After breakfast, walk to **Universal Studios Japan** (approximately four minutes). Enjoy a full day of attractions and entertainment including The Wizarding World of Harry Potter and Super Nintendo World! With the hotel located conveniently near the park, you can maximize your time and stay the entire day if you wish. You can check the waiting time for



attractions before entering the park to make the most of your time there. Or spend some time at Universal CityWalk Osaka, an entertainment and shopping complex jam-packed with unique and fascinating restaurants and stores, located outside Universal Studios Japan. Return to the hotel at your leisure. (B)

Day 8: Tue, Jun 15 – OSAKA – KANSAI – HONOLULU. After breakfast, begin your day with a visit to **Kuromon Ichiba Market**, a lively covered market stretching 580 meters through Osaka's Chuo Ward. The market is famous for its fresh seafood, fruits and vegetables, meats, dried fish, pickles, and confectionery. Many stalls will prepare, cook and serve their food to you right on the spot! Next, visit Dotonbori and Shinsaibashi, a couple of interconnected districts known as one of Osaka's most popular tourist destinations. **Dotonbori** is a popular shopping and entertainment district that runs parallel to Dotonbori Canal, and is also known as a food destination with a wide variety of street food. At approximately 600 meters long (about one third of a mile), **Shinsaibashi** and the surrounding area is Osaka's premier shopping center. The unique area combines chain retail stores and trendy boutiques with department stores and top designer fashion labels. Enjoy lunch in the area (on your own). Finally, get some last minute shopping done at an **AEON MALL** before transferring to the Kansai International Airport for your return flight home. Depart the Kansai via Japan Airlines flt #790 at 10:00 pm and arrive in Honolulu at 11:00 am the same day. Aloha and welcome home! (B)
