Day 1: Tue, Jun 15 — HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu via Alaska/Hawaiian Airlines flt #863 at 12:50 pm.

Day 2: Wed, Jun 16 — HANEDA — TOKYO. Arrive at the Haneda International Airport at 5:10 pm. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to your hotel in Maihama. Enjoy a buffet dinner at the hotel. GRAND NIKKO TOKYO BAY MAIHAMA (3 Nights) (D)

Day 3: Thur, Jun 17 — TOKYO DISNEYLAND. After a sumptuous Japanese/Western buffet breakfast, enjoy a full day at **Tokyo Disneyland!** Tour members will transfer to the resort together. Tour members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort line. (B)

Day 4: Fri, Jun 18 — TOKYO DISNEYSEA. After breakfast, transfer to **Tokyo DisneySea** for a full day of fun and wonder. A unique park that's only found in Japan, Tokyo DisneySea was inspired by the myths and legends of the sea. Tour members will transfer to the resort together. Tour members will return to the hotel on their own using the Disney Resort Line. (B)

*Baggage will be sent from the Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama to the Sunshine City Prince Hotel, skipping Hakone. Prepare an overnight bag for one night.

Day 5: Sat, Jun 19 — TOKYO — OSHINO — HAKONE. After breakfast, depart Tokyo for Hakone. En route, visit **Oshino Hakkai**, a set of eight ponds fed by snowmelt from Mt. Fuji that has filtered through porous lava for 80 years, creating crystal-clear spring water cherished by locals. Visitors can drink the cool water straight from the source! Enjoy lunch here (on your own). Then, visit **Owakudani** (Great Boiling Valley), the source of Hakone's onsen hot spring waters, before transferring to your hotel in Hakone. Upon arrival, enjoy some time at leisure before a buffet dinner. Consider taking a rejuvenating soak in the hotel's **onsen hot springs** as you gaze upon the garden and mountains of Hakone, or walk to the nearby Hakone Kowakien Yunessun, an all-weather onsen amusement park. Tour members can enjoy unlimited visits at no additional cost! Simply pick up your entry wristband at the Hakone Kowakien Hotel's front desk, which will grant you unlimited access and priority entry to Yunessun. Upon entry, receive a complimentary face towel, body towel, and lounge wear set (additional towels and lounge wear are an additional cost). You can also enjoy food and beverages at Yunessun (at your own expense). HAKONE KOWAKIEN HOTEL (1 Night) (B, D)

Day 6: Sun, Jun 20 — HAKONE — TOKYO. After breakfast, begin the day with viewing the surrounding countryside from the **Hakone Ropeway**. Then, take a **boat ride** on the beautiful **Lake Ashi**. After, try your hand at **Hakone yosegi-zaiku**, a unique woodwork technique that utilizes the natural colors of the various trees in the area to create beautiful geometric patterns. A great souvenir of this trip! Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before transferring to Tokyo. Upon arrival, explore **teamLab Borderless: MORI Building DIGITAL ART MUSEUM**, a world of artworks without boundaries. Artworks move across rooms and at times intermingle, creating an immersive experience. Transfer to the Sunshine City Prince Hotel for an evening of leisure. The hotel is directly connected to Sunshine City, which offers a variety of shopping, dining, and entertainment opportunities, such as the Sunshine Aquarium and Bandai Namco Cross Store Tokyo. There is also a FamilyMart conveniently located on the first floor of the hotel (open 24 hours), perfect for those late night egg-sando (egg sandwich) and fried chicken cravings. Yunessun Area (Swimwear Area)

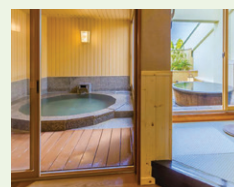
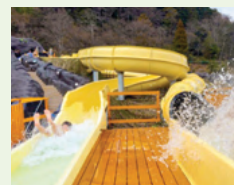
Open until 6:00 pm on weekdays and 7:00 pm on weekends and holidays, with seasonal hours and last entry one hour before closing. Tattoos are permitted if fully covered by a rash guard, tattoo cover seals, or a similar method. Enjoy the water slide, waterfall, themed pools like the coffee and wine baths in the large domed area, or relax in the 40-meter outdoor onsen surrounded by nature.

Mori no Yu Area (No Clothing Area)

Open until 8:00 pm daily, with seasonal hours and last entry 30 minutes before closing. Tattoos are allowed if fully covered by two designated tattoo cover seals (available for purchase at the facility). Enjoy the traditional onsen atmosphere, with open-air baths, picturesque views, indoor baths, jacuzzis, lie-down baths, Shigaraki stoneware pottery baths, lounges, and a massage salon. Male guests can also enjoy a waterfall shoulder massage and dry sauna, while female guests have access to a cypress bath, collagen bath, and mist sauna.

Reserved Private Room Baths

Open daily until 8:00 pm, with seasonal hours, required reservations, and additional fees that vary by room type. Tattoos are allowed. Enjoy quality time with family or friends in one of the eight private baths, each featuring a spacious room and open-air bath.



Day 7: Mon, Jun 21 — TOKYO. After breakfast, start the day at the **Warner Bros. Studio Tour Tokyo — The Making of Harry Potter**. Walk in the footsteps of Harry Potter and explore the wonders of the wizarding world. Explore the sets for The Great Hall, Forbidden Forest, Platform 9 ¾, Diagon Alley, and The Ministry of Magic. Learn about the costumes, props, creature effects, SFX, and VFX that brought the books to life. After, enjoy sweeping views of the city from **Tokyo Skytree**, the tallest tower in Tokyo at just over 2,000 feet. From the Tembo Deck, soaring 350 meters above the ground, you'll be treated to a 360° panoramic view of Tokyo. Then, spend some free time at **TOKYO Solamachi**, a large shopping, dining, and entertainment complex at the base of the Tokyo Skytree that houses over 300 diverse stores, including a Pokémon Center and DAISO. Return to the hotel for an evening of leisure. (B)

Day 8: Tue, Jun 22 — TOKYO — HANEDA — HONOLULU. After breakfast, depart the hotel for the last day of touring. First, visit **Meiji Shrine**, a prominent Shinto shrine dedicated to the deified spirits of Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken, the imperial couple who led Japan through the Meiji Restoration, a period of rapid modernization. Next, visit the visually stimulating **Harajuku** district, internationally renowned as the epicenter of youth culture and street fashion. There is a DAISO on Takeshita Street and an assortment of character goods can be found at Kiddy Land Harajuku on Omotesando avenue. Today's highlight will be a hands-on **sushi making** class, which will yield your delicious lunch. Finally, stop at **Ameyoko**, a bustling market street that features over 400 shops and stalls known for offering significant bargains on various products such as clothes, bags, cosmetics, dried seafood, spices, and more. Transfer to the Haneda International Airport for the return flight home. Depart Haneda via Alaska/Hawaiian Airlines flt #864 at 8:15 pm and in Honolulu at 8:30 am the same day.
