Day 1: Tue, Apr 20 – HONOLULU. Depart Honolulu.

Day 2: Wed, Apr 21 – HONG KONG, CHINA. Arrive in Hong Kong. After entry formalities, transfer by coach to the hotel. HARBOUR PLAZA METROPOLIS or Similar (3 Nights)

Day 3: Thur, Apr 22 – HONG KONG. After breakfast, begin the day taking in the view of the city from **Victoria Peak**, a hill on the western half of Hong Kong Island. With an elevation of 552m (1,811 ft), it is the tallest hill on Hong Kong Island, and the 29th tallest in the territory of Hong Kong. **Repulse Bay**, or Tsin Shui Wan, which is a bay in the southern part of Hong Kong Island, is one of the most expensive residential areas in the world. Next, stop for some shopping at **Stanley Market**. A typical example of a traditional old open-air market in Hong Kong and has since become a major tourist attraction, well known for its bargains. Many of the stalls or shops in Stanley Market sell Hong Kong souvenirs as well as clothing – particularly silk garments and traditional Chinese dress – toys, ornaments, luggage, souvenirs, paintings, and Chinese arts and crafts. After lunch, we visit an area called **Canal Road Flyover**, between Causeway Bay and Wan Chai which is a popular place for villain hitting. Also known as the practice of “beat your little head,” demon exorcising, or petty person beating, villain hitting is a folk sorcery popular in the Guangdong area of China and Hong Kong – primarily associated with Cantonese. Take the **city tram** to Central and **walk to the ferry pier**. Then, we ride on **Star Ferry to Kowloon**. Upon arrival, we will walk to **West Kowloon Cultural Park** along Canton Road. Lastly, get dropped off at the **Ladies’ Market** for some free time to explore and shop. Located in Mongkok, the market is always a treat to visit with the rows of open stalls as well as tiny boutiques offering a wide range of different fashions, accessories, gadgets and gimmicks. Day 4: Fri, Apr 23 – HONG KONG. Enjoy a day of leisure to explore more of Hong Kong on your own. The Local Guide will be available to assist you with your independent plans for the day. (B)

Day 5: Sat, Apr 24 – HONG KONG – EMBARK OCEANIA NAUTICA. After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a

morning of leisure. Later, transfer to the pier for embarkation on the Oceania Nautica. Depart 6:00 pm. (B, D)

Day 6: Sun, Apr 25 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Mon, Apr 26 – HANOI (HA LONG BAY), VIETNAM. Arrive 7:00 am. Overnight in port. Drink in the exquisite beauty of Ha Long Bay with its breathtaking monolithic limestone islands and famous morning mists before traveling along the Red River to Vietnam’s capital city, Hanoi. Enjoy the broad boulevards, French colonial architecture and wonderful Old Quarter. Visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum and Vuon Bach Thao park where locals practice tai chi. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Tue, Apr 27 – HANOI (HA LONG BAY), VIETNAM. Depart 3:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Wed, Apr 28 – HUE (CHAN MAY), VIETNAM. Arrive 9:00 am. Overnight in Port. Hue, the former imperial capital on the Perfume River, beckons with its lovely temples, pagodas and imposing citadel protected by a moat. Explore its many attractions, including tombs of Nguyen dynasty emperors, by boat. Visit the iconic Trang Tien Bridge, which connects the ancient citadel area with Hue across the river, and stroll among the town’s colonial-style buildings and outdoor cafés. In nearby Da Nang, visit famed China Beach and the intriguing Cham Museum, filled with fascinating artifacts of the Cham culture. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Thur, Apr 29 – HUE (CHAN MAY), VIETNAM. Depart 1:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Fri, Apr 30 – NHA TRANG, VIETNAM. Arrive 9:00 am. Depart 4:00 pm. Discover this bustling resort town, renowned for its turquoise waters and yellow sand beaches. See its grand colonial buildings and stroll across a bridge to a fishing village alive with trawlers and junks. Visit the celebrated Cham Towers of Po Nagar, a spot revered by Buddhists. In the countryside, experience rural life in Vietnam today. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Sat, May 01 – SAIGON (HO CHI MINH CITY), VIETNAM. Arrive 11:00 am. Overnight in Port. Discover the rich heritage of Saigon and the rural Mekong Delta. See the city’s lovely pagodas, colonial architecture and broad boulevards. Ride a local pedicab through the bustling streets; visit the vibrant markets, Chinatown and the fascinating

Cu Chi Tunnels. Explore the lush countryside of farms, rice paddies and villages with a cruise on the Mekong. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Sun, May 02 – SAIGON (HO CHI MINH CITY), VIETNAM. Depart 2:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Mon, May 03 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Tue, May 04 – BANGKOK (LAEM CHABANG), THAILAND. Arrive 9:00 am. Overnight in Port. Indulge your senses in the city’s fabulous golden temples and palaces, the royal barges and the Emerald Buddha. Explore the hidden city of teak mansions and lovely gardens or learn about Thai culture. The Royal Palace, familiar to many as the scene of the true story of Anna and the King of Siam, is a massive complex of carved and gilded buildings still used by the Thai Royal Family. Or visit the home of Jim Thompson, former spy and promoter of the local silk industry, who disappeared mysteriously. (B, L, D)

Day 16: Wed, May 05 – BANGKOK (LAEM CHABANG), THAILAND. Depart 2:00 pm. (B, L, D)

Day 17: Thur, May 06 – KO SAMUI, THAILAND. Arrive 8:00 am. Depart 3:00 pm. Explore this idyllic, forested island and its pristine beaches. Visit the giant Buddha at Wat Phra Yai, the elephant camp where these intelligent animals display their work skills and a plantation where monkeys harvest coconuts. Head to the interior and see majestic cascading waterfalls and how rubber trees are tapped. Enjoy the gorgeous beaches. (B, L, D)

Day 18: Fri, May 07 – AT SEA. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Sat, May 08 – SINGAPORE, SINGAPORE – DISEMBARK OCEANIA NAUTICA. Arrive 8:00 am. Upon disembarkation at the Singapore Pier, join your Local Guide visiting some of Singapore’s most popular sites: **Little India, Sultan Mosque, Arab Street, Merlion Park, The Arts House at The Old Parliament** (outside), **Statues of Sir Stamford Raffles, Esplanade** (outside), **Sentosa Island**, and **Singapore Oceanarium**. Enjoy dinner before arriving at the hotel for the evening. MOMENTUS HOTEL ALEXANDRA or similar (2 Nights) (B, L, D)

Day 20: Sun, May 09 – SINGAPORE. After breakfast at the hotel, begin the day at the **Singapore Zoo**, followed by a tour of **Gardens by the Bay** (including entry into the cool house). For dinner, explore a **local Hawker’s Market** and have a **Crazy Rich Asians** experience of your own. (B, L)

Day 21: Mon, May 10 – SINGAPORE – HONOLULU. Transfer to the airport for the flight home. Depart Singapore. Arrive Honolulu. Aloha and welcome home!
